1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 GENERAL

The rally will be run in compliance with FIA International Sporting Code, Estonian Rally General Prescriptions (ERGP), Terminal Oil Estonian Rally Championship Regulations (EC), these Supplementary Regulations and their Appendices.

Changes to the Supplementary Regulations will be announced to all crews by numbered and dated bulletins issued by the Organiser or the Stewards.

Rally Estonia 2022 is a national rally. Participation of foreign competitors is authorised by EASU. The Supplementary Regulations are published in Estonian and English. In case of any dispute about interpretation of these regulations the Estonian text will be binding.

FIA International Sporting Code is published on <u>www.fia.com</u>. The Estonian Rally General Prescriptions, Estonian Rally Championship Regulations and Technical Regulations and their Appendices are published on <u>uus.autosport.ee</u>.

The competition is held in accordance with the COVID-19 restrictions in Estonia.

4 ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS / ENTRIES

4.1 ENTRY PROCEDURE

Participants fill in the entry form on the website:

www.rallyestonia.com/en/competitors/estonian-championship-event/entry-form/

The form will be signed by the crew at the Administrative Checks.

NB! Crews who take part in the Estonian Championship event, but also participate at the WRC event, do not have to enter to the national event separately.

Competitors must confirm their preferred Administrative Checks time on website <u>broneerimine.autosport.ee</u> starting from July 4, 2022 at 19:00 until July 10, 2022 at 21:00.

The schedule for Administrative Checks will be published on the website <u>www.rallyestonia.com</u> and Sportity app in a Bulletin.

The following documents must be presented at the Administrative Checks:

- Valid driver's and co-driver's driving licenses;
- Valid driver's and co-driver's passport or ID card (mandatory for all foreign competitors);
- Valid competitor's license;
- Valid driver's and co-driver's competition licenses;
- ASN authorisation (mandatory for all foreign competitors);
- Valid personal accident insurance (for non-EU drivers);
- Details of the recce car (model, color, registration no.);
- Contact phone number;
- Payment proof for the entry fee

Details concerning the co-driver can be specified until the end of the Administrative Checks.

By signing the entry form the participant allows to publish the information mentioned in this entry application in media.

Only participants licensed by EASU and other ASN-s are allowed to start in the Rally.

A participant who has sent an entry form to the Organiser but will not participate in the rally must inform the Organiser by Monday, July 11, 2022. Otherwise, it will be reported to the Rally Commission or EASU for application of penalties.

NB! Correct and valid e-mail address is mandatory!





4.2 ENTRANTS

4.2.1 Number of entrants

Maximum number of entries is 70. The Clerk of the Course may increase the number of cars permitted to start. Upon reaching the specified number of entries, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries will be accepted.

4.2.2 Participation of rally cars

Eligible classes for participating at Rally Estonia 2022 and Estonian Rally Championship are according to Articles 2.1 and 2.2 of the Terminal Oil Estonian Rally Championship Regulations 2022.

Competitors who refuse to carry Organiser's optional advertising (see Appendix 4) must pay doubled amount of the entry fee. Advertising on the rally plate and starting numbers is compulsory and cannot be refused. Reconnaissance only up to 18 years old juninors according to ERC championship regulations art. 7.3.

4.4 PAYMENT DETAILS

Entries will be accepted only after receipt of the total amount of the entry fee. Competitors who wish to receive an invoice for the entry fee, should notify this on the entry form.

4.5 REFUNDS

Entry fees will be refunded:

- In case the rally does not take place due to fault of the Organiser 100% refund;
- In case the rally does not take place due to Force Majeure 75% refund;
- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted 100% refund;
- To Competitors who for reasons of Force Majeure (duly accepted by their ASN) are unable to start the rally – 25% refund.

5 INSURANCE

5.1 INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE ORGANISER

5.1.1 Organiser's liability insurance

EASU visa includes liability insurance covering damage caused to a third party during the competition up to 500.000 EUR.

Deductible is 1 000 EUR. Insurer: AB "Lietuvos draudimas" Estonian branch Insurance period: 01.02.2022 kuni 31.01.2023 Policy No: 4234391811

5.1.2 Damage caused to a third party

A part of the insurance with AB "Lietuvos Draudimas", Policy No 4234391811 is coverage for damages caused to a third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by this contract. During the competition, the Estonian Traffic Insurance Act applies outside of special stages.

5.2 INTERNATIONAL GREEN CARD

All crews must hand in a compulsory motor vehicle insurance policy or International Green Card for their car at the pre-rally Scrutineering. Without these cards, the crew won't be permitted to start.





5.3 INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS

All the drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at the Administrative Checks. By signing the entry form, the competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensations of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN, and the Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers.

5.4 DAMAGE REPORTING

The crews are obliged to notify the Organiser (e-mail: info@rallyestonia.ee) about any damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty will cause the competitor and involved crew to be summoned to a disciplinary committee of the EASU.

5.5 INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

Auxiliary vehicles, cars dedicated to reconnaissance rides and vehicles with special plates issued by the Organiser, as well as vehicles with the markings of Organiser's officials, are not covered by the provided rally insurance (except for insured Organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

5.6 DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

The Organiser refuses from any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unsportsmanlike behaviour regarding rally regulations and these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident involving a service car, a reconnaissance car or an official's car with rally plates only car owner's third-person's liability insurance policies are valid.

6 IDENTIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

6.1 COMPETITION NUMBERS

Competition numbers, rally plate and the Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to the Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations prior to pre-start Scrutineering.

6.2 LOSS OR REMOVAL OF ADVERTISING / COMPETITION NUMBER

A crew will be penalised with refusal to start at the rally if Article 6.1 of these Supplementary Regulations will have been violated. If it is ascertained at any point during the rally that an advertisement or sticker supplied by the Organiser is missing from a car, then the crew shall be penalised with a fine of 100 EUR for each missing or modified advertisement or if the advertisement is not affixed according to Appendix 4 of the SR. Competitor must affix advertising and identifications on the car must according to regulations.

6.3 COMPETITION NUMBERS AND RALLY PLATES

Competition numbers and rally plates supplied by the Organiser must appear on both front doors of the car during the whole rally according to the Article 27 of Estonian Rally General Prescriptions. If it is ascertained at any time during the rally that:

- a competition number or one rally plate is missing, this will be penalised by 300 EUR;

- both competition numbers or both rally plates are missing, this will be reported to the Stewards.

7 TYRES

7.1 ELIGIBLE TYRES DURING THE EVENT

The number of tyres for the competition is not limited. All tyres used during the rally must be readily commercially available and must comply with Estonian Rally General Prescriptions standards. Any infringement to this rule will be reported to the Stewards. **Only gravel tires are allowed. Using of tarmac tyres is not allowed!**

7.2 PERMITTED RIMS

The number of rims is not limited. The use of rims larger than 15" is prohibited.

7.3 TYRES USED FOR RECCONNAISSANCE

Tyres used for recconnaissance must be in conformity with Estonian Traffic Act. Sports tyres, racing tyres and studded tyres are prohibited. Any infringements will be reported to the Stewards and will result in penalty up to exclusion from the competition.

8 FUEL

8.1 FUEL RESTRICTIONS

Fuel must comply with FIA specifications (J 252 Art 9). Bioethanol E85 is allowed only in national E2WD and 4WD classes. Rally cars must be marked with blue E85 sticker.

8.2 REFUELLING

Refuelling is permitted only in the Refuelling Zone by the Organiser in the Road Book. Passing through all the remote refuelling zones is not obligatory. Only actions inside a Refuelling Zone directly involved in the refuelling of the competing vehicle are permitted. Any other activity performed with the rally car is prohibited (Parc Fermé regulations apply).

8.3 REFUELLING PROCEDURE

During refuelling a liquid proof mat must be used.

During refueling, only crew members and support staff (up to 2 people per car) are responsible for fire safety. All refueling crew members must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least long trousers, a long-sleeved shirt, closed shoes, gloves and balaclavas.

Competitors must be out of the race car during refueling.

Violation of the refueling rules will result in a fine of EUR 100 for each mistake.

9 RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 RECONNAISSANCE REGISTRATION

Registration of reconnaissance cars is mandatory, the registration can be done at <u>broneerimine.autosport.ee/recce/</u> starting from July 4, 2022 at 19:00 until July 10, 2022 at 21:00. During the reconnaissance the registered reconnaissance car will be checked.

If during the reconnaissance the team changes the reconnaissance car for any reason, it must inform the secretary of the competition (phone: +372 56 966 698) and provide information about the new reconnaissance car.

The crew will receive identification for their car (3 number stickers). The number stickers must be affixed on the windscreen and both rear side windows during reconnaissance at all times.

9.2 SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

For speed monitoring and security purposes, competitors must use the RallySafe Recce Lite mobile app during recce. The app uses the competitors' mobile phones connection to the GSM network as well as the GPS location of the phones to accurately track the movements of the vehicles and speed. Competitors must ensure that a mobile phone with Android or iOS operating system is present in the reconnaissance car and that its battery lasts during





the reconnaissance. More detailed information on downloading and using the tracking system will be provided to registered competitors.

If the tracking system app is not used during reconnaissance of Special Stages and road sections, it will be considered a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. Evaluation of the data is within the competence of Clerk of the Course. If it will be observed that the reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with the tracking app, the crew will be penalized according to the Stewards decision.

9.3 RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE

Reconnaissance Time Schedule can be found in Appendix 2.

9.4 RECONNAISSANCE RULES

9.4.1 Reconnaissance

The crews are obliged to follow all reconnaissance rules specified in the Estonian Rally General Prescriptions, Terminal Oil Estonian Rally Championship 2022 Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations. Reconnaissance will be organised in compliance with art. 35. of the ERGP and only series production cars conforming to art. 35.1.2. of FIA RRSR may be used. The car may be painted in multiple colours.

Anti-cutting markers will be place on the Specia Stages in order to avoid cutting. These markers will be in place before the reconnaissance.

9.4.2 Speed limit

The maximum speed set for reconnaissance at the Special Stages is 80 km/h, unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic signs, marked in the Road Book or additional speed limiting signs placed by the Organiser. Breaking the rules and exceeding the speed limits on public roads will also be detected and fined by the Estonian Police according to Estonian Traffic Act.

9.4.3 Direction

Each crew may drive the special stages only in the direction of the rally. The crews must always enter the special stages through the start control and leave the special stages through the stop control.

NB! After reconnaissance on SSS1, car must drive back to the start in the direction of the Terminal gas station (follow the map).

9.4.4 Restriction of reconnaissance

Drivers, entrants and their representatives are strictly forbidden to visit any road which is used as a Special Stage after publishing of Supplementary Regulations. Failure to respect this rule shall result in the driver being reported to the Stewards.

NB! Entering the Special Stages not included in the Estonian Championship event is prohibited at all times. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

9.4.5 Number of passages

Recce is permitted maximum 2 passages on each Special Stage. Drivers below the age of 18 are allowed 3 passages on each Special Stage.

9.4.6 Number of persons on board

During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons (the crew) are permitted in the car.

9.4.7 Speeding

Speeding will be penalized by Clerk of the Course according to Art. 34.3.4* of ERGP as follows – per km per hour over the speed limit: all drivers 25 EUR.

9.4.8 Radar detection equipment

The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during reconnaissance is not permitted.





9.4.9 Penalties for violating recconnaissance rules

Violation of the recconnaissance rules may be penalised by the Clerk of the Course or Stewards with a fine or refusal to start.

10 SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

10.1 SCRUTINEERING

The competitors must confirm their preferred Scrutineering time on website <u>broneerimine.autosport.ee</u> starting from July 4, 2022, at 19:00 until July 10, 2022, at 21:00.

The detailed schedule for pre-rally Scrutineering will be published on the website www.rallyestonia.com and Sportity app in a Bulletin.

Any crew taking part in the rally, or their representative must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the schedule to be issued in a Bulletin.

10.2 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED AT SCRUTINEERING.

- Vehicle's registration documents;
- Vehicle's traffic insurance Policy or Green Card;
- Vehicle's ASN technical passport and homologation books with extensions for cars in groups A, R and N;
- Safety equipment declaration (available at www.rallyestonia.com)

10.2.1 Technical card

The technical card of the car will be deposited at the scrutineering and will be returned in Parc Fermé at the end of the rally. The card is kept by the scrutineers. A competitor who retires and will not present the car to the scrutineers (Estonian Rally General Prescriptions Art. 53.3.7^{1*}) concerning the display of the car will receive their technical card from the ASN after specifying the circumstances of the interruption and imposing a possible penalty. No duplicate card will be issued to them.

10.3 MARKING AND SEALING

Marking of turbochargers will be done during the Scrutineering.

10.4 MUD FLAPS

Transversal mud flaps are mandatory and must comply with Appendix J Article 252.7.7.

10.5 WINDOWS

The use of silver or tinted films is allowed only on rear side windows and rear window and must comply with Appendix J Article 253.11.1.1.

10.6 SAFETY EQUIPMENT OF CREWS

Safety equipment of crews has to comply with FIA regulations. Additional exemptions resulting from technical regulations are allowed in EMV5 and EMV9 classes.





10.7 NATIONAL REGULATIONS

Competing vehicles must be equipped with A3 size SOS/OK sign, first aid kit, a reflective triangle and a reflective vest.

10.8 NOISE LEVEL

The maximum noise level permitted is 103 dBA. Cars not complying with this rule will not be allowed to start. The noise will be measured with a sonometer set to "A" and "SLOW", placed at an angle of 45 degrees to and at a distance of 50 cm from the exhaust outlet, with the car's engine running at 3500 rpm.

10.9 CAR LIGHTING

On road sections cars are allowed to use only the originally fitted headlamps with E-homologation. Headlamps without homologation must not be used during road sections. Complying with this provision will be checked by judges of fact. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

11 GPS SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

11.1 GPS SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

All competitors must make provision in their cars for the installation of the Safety Tracking System, managed by Status Awareness Systems (SAS). The device will be handed out after the Administrative Checks. Installation isntructions are in Appendix 5 of the Supplementary Regulations. More information will be provided upon receipt of the device and at the Drivers' Safety Briefing.

All drivers and co-drivers are required to attend a safety briefing on Wednesday, July 13 at 20:00 hrs via video conference. A link to the meeting will be sent to the participants. The organiser will check the participation of all drivers and co-drivers. Any missing participants will be reported to the Stewards.

The GPS device must be installed before the car is brought to Scrutineering. Competitors are responsible for installation of the device. Organiser's representatives will check proper installation. Competition cars not equipped with the GPS monitoring device will not be allowed to start. Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the competition car or any device that hinders the tracking recording by external interference will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

The GPS-tracking-system must be returned correctly after entering the Parc Fermé after finish or after retirement to the HQ.

11.2 PRINCIPLES ON SECURITY AND TRACKING

Security and tracking devices are connected to a monitoring centre in the Race Control. During the event the Race Control will monitor the location and speed of each crew.

11.3 "SOS" AND "OK" SIGNALLING PRINCIPLES

The device has "SOS" and "OK" buttons.

NB! If a car stops during a stage for longer than 3 seconds, the unit will automatically transmit a HAZARD notification; this can either upgraded to OK or downgraded to SOS by pressing the corresponding button to the text. A timer counts up to 60 seconds as an indication to press either the OK or SOS button.

By pressing the "SOS" button a crew reports an accident and requests immediate assistance. If the SOS button is pressed, it must be confirmed as either a fire or medical SOS by pressing one of the two middle buttons. An "SOS" sign has to be shown to following competing cars.

In case of an accident or technical problems at a Special Stage, by pressing the "OK" button a crew informs of stopping for more than 30 seconds and that immediate assistance is not required (even if a crew is trying to continue the rally).

The crew's mobile phone must be switched on (or turned on within 60 seconds), so that the Race Control can reach the crew. Incorrect "SOS" and "OK" signal transmission will be penalised.

In the case of an accident where urgent medical attention is required, when possible, the red "SOS" sign should immediately be displayed to the following cars attempting to assist (General Prescriptions Art 53.3.1.)

12 SHAKEDOWN

No shakedown will be held.

13 RUNNING OF THE RALLY

13.1 START PROCEDURE AND ORDER

13.1.1 Start of the rally

The Starting order for the Ceremonial start will be published on Thursday, 14 July at 18:30.

The Ceremonial Start will take place on Thursday, July 14 at 20:30 on the Podium at Tartu Town Hall Square. All crews must attend the Ceremonial Start wearing overalls.

Before the start, the Organiser will assemble all the competing cars in a Holding Area a before the podium. All competition cars must arrive at the Holding Area at 19:30-20:00. The orders of the marshals have to be followed at Holding Area.

After the Ceremonial Start cars must follow the Road Book to Service Park.

13.1.2 Start order and intervals

The competitors will start in reverse order of the speed table to all competition days: the 2WD cars will be followed by the 4WD cars. The start order is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

The Clerk of the Course may, for safety reasons and with the knowledge of the Stewards, reposition drivers or change the time interval between cars. The start orders will be published at <u>www.rallyestonia.com</u> and Sportity.

Start interval for Leg 1 will be 1 minute for all cars. The start interval for Leg 2 and 3 will be published in a Bulletin.

13.1.3 Start procedure for special stages:

The electronic start procedure shall be clearly visible to the crew from the start line and is displayed as a countdown clock.

The Time Card procedures are carried out according to Art. 13.3 of the Supplementary Regulations.

Countdown:

- 30 seconds to GO red zone and red light
- 10 seconds to GO 1 (short) beep + red zone and red light
- 5 seconds to GO 1 (short) beep every sec + yellow zone and yellow light flashing
- "GO" Signal: Green light + Start beep
- After "GO" Signal: 20 seconds free start + green zone and green light.

13.2 RESTART AFTER RETIREMENT

Any crew which has failed to complete Leg 1 or Leg 2 can re-start the rally from the start of the following Leg only if they confirm their intention to the Clerk of the Course at least one hour prior to the publication of the start list of that Leg. For all crews which re-start, a time penalty of 5 minutes will be applied for every stage missed. Should the retirement occur after the last special stage before the overnight regroup, time penalty of 5 minutes will be added to the time of their last special stage.

The car may be repaired at the competitor's discretion, but the car must retain its original body shell and engine block as marked at pre-rally scrutineering.

The car must report to for re-scrutineering in their own service bay on Friday, July 15 at 09:15-09:45 and Saturday, July 16 at 08:45-09:15. The competitor or driver must be present at the re-scrutineering.





13.3 CONTROL PROCEDURES AND TIME CARD HANDLING

GENERAL

a) The following procedures apply and have priority over all the related provisions in the 2022 Estonian Rally General Prescriptions as far as they are in conflict. Some of the conflicting article numbers are quoted below, but without claiming to be exhaustive.

b) Any irregularity or discrepancies regarding the below procedures will result in the application of Art. 19.3.4 and 44.2.12 of the ERGP. It is to be noted that, as a principle, the entries recorded on the timing marshals' check-sheets shall be decisive.

c) The complete set of Time Cards for the whole rally will be delivered with the rally materials at administrative checks. It is imperative for all crews to carry all the Time Card sets for a whole day inside the car.

TIME CONTROLS

a) The check-in procedure begins at the moment as stipulated in Art. 44.2.1 of the ERGP.

b) The check-in time corresponds to the moment at which the co-driver shows their Time card to the timekeeper through the side window (ERGP Art. 44.1 and Art. 44.2.4).

c) The appropriate timekeeper will then enter the actual time at which the card was shown on the timing tablet and write it on the check sheet (ERGP Art. 44.2.5).

d) They will then show the recorded check-in time and, in case of a Time Control followed by a special stage, the provisional special stage start time to the co-driver. The co-driver shall then enter this time on their time card (ERGP Art. 44.2.5).

SPECIAL STAGE START

a) At the start line, the co-driver shows the timekeeper the time card through the side window. The timekeeper then either confirms this provisional start time or shows a different start time on his checksheet.

b) This new time, if any, shall then be recorded as actual start time on the time card by the co-driver (ERGP Art. 48.2.3).

SPECIAL STAGE STOP POINT

a) The timekeeper at the stop point will show the finish time (time of the day: hour, minute, second, tenth of a second) and the calculated stage time to the crew (co-driver).

b) The co-driver shall record this time on their time card.

REGROUPING CONTROLS (ERGP Art. 46)

a) There is no need to hand in the Time Card used for the Section concerned.

b) In case of an overnight regroup, the crew shall themselves record their re-start time of the following day on their time card, following the publication of the start list for the section after the overnight regroup.
c) Early check-in allowed to TC 1A, 5C and 13E.

13.4 RETIREMENT PROCEDURE

If a crew retires, they must indicate the reason of retirement to the form in Road Book and return it with the Time Card to the closing car "Green Light" which is equipped with blinking green signal lights and follows the last competitor. In a case of an accident or technical failure at the Special Stage when the competing vehicle stays on the road or less than 3 m from the road the drivers must warn other competitors by placing the reflective triangle not less than 50m from the accident place in a visible place on the same side of the road where the car is located. **Retired crew must immediately inform Rally HQ (phone +372 51 86 248) of their retirement reasons.**





13.5 FINISH PROCEDURE

The competitive part of the rally ends with entering Parc Fermé at TC 13A.

The Parc Fermé regulations will be in force until the opening of Parc Fermé, afterwhich the competitors are obliged to remove their cars from the Parc Fermé. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards.

The price-giving takes place on the podium at Tartu Town Hall square on Saturday, July 16 starting from 21:30.

13.6 SERVICE PROCEDURES

Only Service cars (TEAM) and reconnaissance cars are allowed to enter the Service Park of the Estonian Championship event. Restrictions on servicing, refuelling or changing of mechanical parts are listed in FIA RRSR and these comply with Art. 56, 57, 58 and 61 of Estonian Rally General Prescriptions 2022.

13.6.1 Layout of Service Park

Each team is allocated a service bay of the following size in the Service Park:

- Team entries 8x9 m (72 m²),
- Private entries 6x8 m (48 m²).

It is possible to buy extra service space for 20 EUR/m²+VAT by filling out the Service Park order form at <u>www.rallyestonia.ee</u> by June 14.

13.6.2 Speed limit in Service Park

Maximum speed in the Service Park may not exceed 20 km/h. Speeding will result in a penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course according to Art. 57.4 of Estonian Rally General Prescriptions 2022.

13.6.3 Behaviour in the Service Park

A liquid-proof tarp of at least 3x5 meters must be used under the rally car while servicing In Service Park. One service vehicle and recce car per each rally car is allowed to enter into Service Park. The service vehicle must be clearly identified by a "Service" plate issued by the Organiser and affixed on the upper part of the front windscreen. Damages (nails, screws and other fittings) to the surface of the Service Park are forbidden. The crew is responsible for damages to their service zone and must avoid causing them. Refuelling is permitted only in refuelling areas. Two fire extinguishers minimum 6kg must be present at each service zone. It is strictly forbidden to use open fire at the service zone (charcoal grill, firewood, etc.). After the rally the service zone has to be handed over in tidy condition. Crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage.

13.7 CHICANES

Due to safety reasons, barriers will be positioned on the rally route to reduce speed of rally cars. Judges of fact will monitor the right passage of barriers. The list of judges of fact will be published on the Official Notice Board in compliance with ISC Art. 11.16.7.

According to Terminal Oil Estonian Rally Championship 2022 Regulations Art.9.2 failure to pass the barriers in a correct manner will be penalised by the Stewards with 1-minute time penalty for each infringement.

13.8 OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

Official time throughout the rally is the one of GPS, timezone CET +1.

13.9 ENTRANCE TO THE REGROUPING AREA AND PARC FERMÉ

GPS tracking officers are allowed to enter the regrouping area and Parc Fermé in order to maintain or repair the GPS tracking systems installed in the rally cars. They must be accompanied by scrutineers and team representatives (driver, co-driver or competitor).

14.1 ORGANISER'S AWARDS

Best three crews in each Estonian Rally Championship class will be awarded. The Organiser and sponsors have a right to present special awards that will be announced separately.

The ceremony will be held without the competition cars. The attending crews are required to wear their competition overalls at the ceremony.

If any of the crews has received the prize but is not entitled to it according to a subsequent Stewards decision, the crew is obligated to return the prize to the Organiser.

15 FINAL CHECKS, PROTESTS AND APPEALS

15.1 FINAL SCRUTINEERING OF DEFINED VEHICLES

Place: Scrutineering tent, Raadi airfield

Date: July 16, 2022

Time: Immediately after entering Parc Fermé after the finish

All teams required to complete a final sqrutineering must immediately follow the instructions of the officals in charge, even if this means not passing one or more Time Control Points (TC). The final sqrutineering must be prepared for the submission of the necessary certificates. The representative of the competitor and the mechanics with the necessary tools must be present at the final sqrutineering.

15.2 PROTEST DEPOSIT

Amount of the protest deposit - 1650 EUR.

If a protest is about another competitor's car, then according to Estonian Open Rally Championship Regulations Art.11.2 an extra has to be paid:

700 EUR for a protest involving the whole car

350 EUR for a protest involving only a clearly defined part of the car.

15.3 APPEAL DEPOSIT

APPENDIX 2 – RECONNAISSANCE SCHEDULE

Recce is allowed according to the recce schedule. The three identification numbers provided at the administrative checks must be affixed to the car (at the top corner of co-driver's side of the windscreen and both rear side windows) and must be kept visible throughout the reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance Road Books A and B will be supplied. Following the Reconnaissance Road Book is recommended however individual route may be followed within the foreseen date and time schedule.

NB! Entering the Special Stages not included in the Estonian Championship event is prohibited at all times. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

Recce is permitted maximum 2 passages on each Special Stage. Drivers below the age of 18 are allowed 3 passages on each Special Stage.


