Ref: Mull Closed Road Rally 2022 – Motor Sport Permit

I write to confirm receipt of your communications notifying Police Scotland that Mull Car Club has applied for a Motor Sport Permit to organise and promote a Road Rally on roads closed for the purpose under the powers provided for in the Road Traffic Act 1988 Section 12(1A)(b).

I can confirm Police Scotland have fully engaged in consultation meetings for your event and will continue to support the planning, in conjunction with members of the Safety Advisory Group.

I acknowledge Motorsport UK's requirement to consult with Police Scotland as the Police Authority, in accordance with Section 3(2)(c) of The Motor Sport on Public Roads (Scotland) Regulations 2019. I note that the Event Safety Plan is still in draft form. On this basis and on behalf of the Chief Constable, Police Scotland have no objections to the permit being issued at this time but reserve the right to raise any safety concerns subsequent to the plan being finalised and the permit being issued.
