4.1. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:

Closing date for entries: Monday, July 11, 2022 at 17:00.

Closing date for entries with increased fee: Friday, July 15, 2022 at 17:00.

4.2. ENTRY PROCEDURE

Competitors must complete electronic entry form on www.autorally.lt. Entry form must reach the Organiser until terms specified in Art. 4.1. of these Regulations. Entry form is considered accepted only when it is fully completed and when the entry fee is paid in full. Fully filled and signed entry form must be provided to the Organiser during Administrative Checks. Co-driver details may be specified during Administrative Checking.

IMPORTANT: In order to avoid crowding at Administrative checking and to speed up the checking procedure entrants must send scanned or photographed documents, needed at Administrative checking – licenses, drivers licenses, medical certificates– via e-mail: ralisvieksniuose@gmail.com.

4.3. NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CLASSES

Supplementary Regulations - "ORLEN Lietuva Rally 2022"

- 4.3.1. Maximum number. Total maximum number of the crews 70. The priority of entry will be reserved to participants of LARC, who submitted entry form and paid the entry fee on time. The number of participants in Shakedown is limited to 30 crews.
- 4.3.2. Cars eligible to enter the event

Cars complying with LARC Regulations Art.4.1 - 4.2 are eligible to enter LARC.

Other cars complying with FIA Appendix J 2022 are eligible to enter "ORLEN Lietuva Rally 2022" Overall and 2WD classifications.

- 4.4.1. Entry fee for the winners of the 2021 Lithuanian Automobile Rally Sprint Championship (LARSC), who have not previously participated in the LARC is Eur 250. The winners are the 1st and 2nd drivers, who took the first place in the LARSC standings. If these I and II drivers start in different crews in 2022 LARC, the reduced entry fee applies to both crews. The reduced start for the Junior standings applies only to the first driver, i.e. his crew.
- 4.4.2. LARC Team entry fee must reach Organizer by 22-07-2022 (Friday) 18:30.
- 4.4.3. "0" crews must pay a deposit of Eur 250 to the Organizer (details for payment art. 4.5), which will be returned only after the discussion of the competition in the Rally Committee and confirmation that the "0" crew has performed its functions properly.

4.6. REFUNDS

Entry fee will be refunded:

- In case rally does not take place due to fault of the Organizer 100%;
- To candidates whose entry has not been accept– 100%;
- In case of the rally does not take place due to force majeure 50 %;
- If the crew is unable to take part for serious reasons recognized by the Organizer 50%.

V. INSURANCE

5.1. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE ORGANISER

5.1.1. Organiser's Liability Insurance

Organiser insures participants with insurance covering damage caused to a third party during the competition from start up to the finish or the moment when competitor withdraws or is disqualified from the event. Insurance is valid from the start of the Test stage.

5.1.2. Damage Caused to the Third Party

A part of insurance contract is coverage for damages caused to the third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by contract.

5.2. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS

All drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. By the fact of signing entry form, competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensation of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN and Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers.

Drivers and co-drivers from non-EU countries have to have valid travel insurance contracts with active recreational risks included.

5.3. DAMAGE REPORTING

Crews are obliged to notify Organiser about any damage caused on track by their car by the end of event the latest. Failure to do so may inflict 100 EUR penalty.

5.4. INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

Auxiliary vehicles, reconnaissance cars and vehicles with special stickers issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured Organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

5.5. DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

The Organiser refuses any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unfair action – either regarding rally regulations or these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident neither a service car, reconnaissance car nor official's car with rally markings are considered as crew of the competition. In these cases only a car owner third-person liability insurance policies are valid.

VI. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Prior to the pre-start scrutineering starting numbers, rally plates and Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to Appendix 4.

6.2. LOSS OR REMOVAL OF COMPETITION NUMERS AND ADVERTISING

Any failure with rules regarding start numbers and advertising will be reported to the Stewards.

VII. TYRES

7.1. NUMBER OF TYRES AND ELIGIBLE TYRES

- 7.1.1. Number of tyres. The number of tyres for LARC competitors 10. The number of tyres for other participants is not limited. Tyres used during SS 0 (Shakedown) will not be counted towards the maximum number.
- 7.1.2. Eligible tyres. Only gravel sports tires may be used during the rally. For LARC competitors tyres must comply with Appendix 13 of LARC Regulations.

7.2. TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Only E- or DOT-approved road homologated tyres are allowed. Retreated tyres with sport tread pattern are forbidden during reconnaissance. Any treatment (incl. removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is prohibited.

VIII. FUFL

8.1. FUEL RESTRICTIONS

E85 fuel (bioethanol), which is commercially available at retail dealers, is permitted.

8.2. REFUELING

- 8.2.1. All Competitors may only refuel in a Refueling Zone (RZ). There will be a Refueling Zone marked in the Road Book after the exit TC from the Service Zone in Viekšniai.
- 8.2.2. Remote refueling. There will be two Remote refuel zones

After SS4 - "Orlen" petrol station, Skuodo str. 14, Mažeikiai. Coordinates: 56.3144 22.3106

After SS10 - Svirkančiai buss stop. Coordinates: 56.1827, 22.5241

8.2.3. Refueling procedure. The cars can be filled rom barrels/canisters with fuel which available at commercial gas stations. Only two team members with permissions can enter the refuel zone and help with the procedure.

Only crew members and their support staff are responsible for complying with fire safety regulations during filling. A liquid-tight mat must be used. Refueling is carried out in accordance with T-2022 Art.61.2. Non-compliance with rules will be penalized by decision of Stewards.

IX. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION

Reconnaissance registration will take place at the same time with administrative checks as follows:

22-07-2022 (Friday) 7:00 – 8:00 – for competitors participating in Shakedown;

8:00 – 9:30 – for competitors not participating in Shakedown.

9.1.1. Checking of Reconnaissance cars

Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of T-2022. If, for any reason, the crew has to change the reconnaissance car, they must inform Rally secretariat (phone: +370-618-76683) about the data of the new reconnaissance car.

9.2. SPEED LIMITS

9.2.1 Town/Village 50 km/h

Non residence: Gravel roads: 70 km/h

Asphalt roads: 90 km/h Motorways: 120 km/h Highways: 130 km/h

9.2.2. Speed during reconnaissance

During reconnaissance it is necessary to drive at a safe speed in accordance with the rules in force in the Republic of Lithuania. The maximum permitted speed on the speed stages during reconnaissance is 70 km/h, except in areas with road signs or other speed limits marked in the road book. Violations of traffic rules and speed on public roads

will also be recorded and fined by police officers in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Lithuania. GPS data will also be tracked in road sections.

9.3. GPS SPEED CONTROL CHECKING DEVICES

9.3.1. GPS speed control devices will be issued during the Administrative checking as follows:

22-07-2022 (Friday) 7:00 – 8:00 – for competitors participating in Shakedown;

8:00 – 9:30 – for competitors not participating in Shakedown.

9.3.2. Rally Safety Tracking system. Organizer provides a rally safety tracking system, which has to be used during reconnaissance. If the system is not used, it is a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. The process of reconnaissance will be monitored via GPS system by Rally officials. GPS data will be monitored also in the road sections. The evaluation of GPS data is the responsibility of the Clerk of the Course. If reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with a tracking device, the crew will be penalized by Stewards. After reconnaissance, crews have to reinstall the tracking device into the rally car.

9.3.3. Principles on Security and Tracking. Each unit has a unique serial number that is assigned to the crew. During the race, the rally headquarters tracks the position and speed of each crew. The GPS tracking device is connected to a tracking center that collects all incoming data. All data is stored on the same device. The device has an autonomous voltage source operating throughout the rally. The device has SOS and OK buttons. By pressing the SOS button, crew members report about the accident and request immediate assistance. In this case, it is necessary to report the accident via the telephone number indicated on the sticker of the GPS device. When the car stops in the speed stage due to an accident or technical problems, by pressing the OK button, the crew members inform the rally staff about the car stopping for more than 30 seconds and also announce that emergency assistance is not required.

Attention! If the crew has stopped in the speed stage for a period longer than 30 seconds, even if the crew tries to continue the race, it is necessary to send an "OK" message. The crew's mobile phones must be switched on (or switched on within 60 seconds) so that the Rally HQ can inquire about the current situation. If the crew receives an electronic red flag alarm (an audible signal and the yellow light switches), the OK button must be held down for 1 second to acknowledge receipt of the message to the rally control centre. The crew must immediately reduce speed and follow the marshals' instructions. Failure to comply with these requirements will be penalized by decision of Stewards.

9.3.4. Returning of GPS devices. The equipment must be dismantled from the car and returned after the TC13A next the Rally Headquarters. If the damaged device is returned or not returned at all, the crew will have to pay a fee of EUR 200 for the value of the device. Unfinished crews must deliver the equipment to the Rally HQ till 20:00 on Saturday, July 22, 2022.

9.4. RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE

Reconnaissance time schedule is given in Appendix 2.

9.5. RECONNAISSANCE RULES

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of T-2022 and these Regulations.

- 9.5.1 Restrictions of Reconnaissance. After publication of Supplementary Regulations, any driver, or co-driver, or any other entrant's team member participating LARC or intends to participate only in "ORLEN Lietuva Rally 2022" and wants to drive/ cross the roads belonging to the Prohibited roads' area of the Rally, must obtain permission from the Organizer. This rule does not apply to persons residing in prohibited places. All fixed violations will be reported to the Stewards and national ASN.
- 9.5.2. Number of persons on board. During reconnaissance maximum 2 persons are permitted in the car. 3rd person may be in the car during reconnaissance only with the permit from the Clerk of the Course and has to have a valid annual license issued by LASF or other ASN.
- 9.5.3. Number of passages. Maximum 2 passages over each Special stage is permitted during reconnaissance. Special stages, which runing twice, are considered as one Special stage.
- 9.5.4. Speeding. Exceeding speed during reconnaissance will be penalized in accordance with T-2022 Art. 34.2.2. Exceeding speed during the race will be penalized in accordance with T-2022 Art. 34.3.

If the rally car and/or service cars exceed the speed limit in the Service zone, a fine of Eur 25 will be imposed for each exceeded kilometer per hour (T-2022 Art.57.4).

X. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

During Administrative Checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

Driver and Co-driver competition licences;

Driver and Co-driver valid driving licences;

ASN authorisation, when it's applicable;

Addition of fully information into the entry form;

Medical certificate of aptitude F 068/a or "Medical certificate of aptitude" FIA appendix L, cause 1.8.

Valid travel insurance for non - EU drivers.

Note: For crews who submit the required documents in electronic form, the documents will not be checked, but the crew must submit the original signed and fully completed entry form.

10.2. LOCATION AND SCHEDULE

Administrative checks will take place at the same time with Reconnaissance registration as follows:

22-07-2022 (Friday) 7:00 – 8:00 – for competitors participating in Shakedown;

8:00 – 9:30 – for competitors not participating in Shakedown.

The exact schedule will be published on www.autorally.lt. Delays to administrative checking will be penalized with a fine of Eur 30 for every 10 minutes delay. At least one crew member must attend an administrative check.

XI. SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

11.1. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Valid vehicle insurance policy ("Green card");

Vehicle registration documents;

Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it's applicable;

11.2.LOCATION AND SCHEDULE

Date: 22-07-2022 (Friday) 10:00 – 13:00 – for competitors participating in Shakedown;

14:00 – 18:30 – for competitors not participating in Shakedown

Place: Company "UNO Transport", Laižuvos str. 18, Viekšniai, Coordinates: 56.2381, 22.5083

The exact schedule will be published on www.autorally.lt. The crew or the crew representative must come to the technical srutineering and present the car for inspection according to the published schedule. Delays in the prestart scrutineering will be penalized with a fine of Eur 30 for every 10 minutes delay. 1st and 2nd drivers are not required to take part in the scrutineering.

11.3. MUDGUARDS

Transversal mudguards are not mandatory.

11.4. WINDOWS

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorized on side windows and rear windows only (in conformity with FIA Appendix J art. 253-11).

11.5. DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

During scrutineering all items of protective clothing are going to be checked, including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR). Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

11.6. NOISE LEVEL

The maximum noise level must not exceed 103 dB for an engine rotation speed of 3500 rpm.

11.7. INSTALATION OF SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

11.7.1. All competitors must make provision for the installation of the Safety Tracking System in their cars. Systems will be issued during Administrative Checks. All other information will be provided to each crew separately at the time of issuing of the device.

11.7.2. Competitors must have installed the speed control and safety tracking devices in their recce cars before reconnaissance starts. The system must be re-installed to the rally cars and must be shown to the Scrutineers before the TCO area.

11.7.3. Any attempts of the crew to suppress or affect the signals or operation of the GPS safety and monitoring equipment during reconnaissance and/or the race will be reported to the Stewards, who will impose fines or decide to disqualify the crew.

XII. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1. RALLY OPENING PROCEDURE AND ORDER

The sports part of the Rally begins from TCO. The crews starts from pre-start area following the published start order.

12.2. FINISH PROCEDURE

After the last speed stage, participants must get a mark at TC13A next to the Rally Headquarters and return the GPS device. After the mark TC13B crews drive through the rally finish arch to the Park Ferme, Vytauto str. 1, near Viekšniai summer stage, coordinates: 56.2358, 22.5101. For the final technical inspection the cars will be delivered after the finish podium. The cars may be taken from the Park Fermé only with the permit of Stewards. If Rally Itinerary goes as planned Park Fermé will be open at 20:50.

12.3. PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN

Crews are authorised to check-in early without time penalty at:

- TC 1A (finish of the 1st Rally section).
- TC 7B (entrance to Regroup);
- TC 13A (entrance to GPS dismantling zone);
- TC 13B (entrance to Finish Park Ferme).

12.4. START PROCEDURE IN SPECIAL STAGES

Start procedure for special Stages will be as follows:

- On the start position crew stops when instructed by marshals;
- When the start marshal confirms that the car is on the right start position 50 cm before electronically controlled start line the car must stay immovable till start moment and the crew must visually follow the time and lights on the monitor.
- 30 seconds before start marshal hands the Time Card to the Co-driver;
- The last five seconds are marked by 5 red lights and a green light. The first red light lights up on 55th second, second on 56th second and so on. On the time of exact minute red light go out and green light lights up.
- If the car crosses the beam before the green light lights up "FALSE" will be shown automatically on the monitor. False-start will be penalized according T-2022 Art.48.6.
- The start marshal makes the final decision about false-start and notes this in the start report.
- In case of start system malfunction the start will be given by marshals according to T-2022 Art.48.3.

Upon retiring, the crews must hand in its time card either at the nearest control post or to the sweeping car.

12.6. OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

During the rally official time is considered the Eastern European summer time (CET +2, UTC+3)

12.7. REGROUPING

12.7.1 After SS 1- without start positions' change. New start time TC 2.

12.7.2 After SS 7 - with start positions' change according SS1-SS7 results. New start time TC 7C.

12.8. RETIRING BECAUSE OF AN ACCIDENT

The crews retired after an accident, must submit their cars to the Chief Scrutineer for inspection of damage. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in a fine of Eur 150. The crews participating in LARC no later than 1 working day must present the car for LASF technical inspection.

12.9. RE - START / RALLY 2

Re-start after the retirement (Rally 2) is possible after the 2nd rally section (TC 7C) in comply with T-2022 Art. 7.6 requirements.

12.10. SERVICE ZONE

- 12.10.1. Service zone will be located on Mažeikiai polytechnic school, Viekšniai branch, Mažeikių str. 80, Viekšniai. Coordinates: 56.2394, 22.4979. Surface: asphalt. Time: from 22-07-2022 10:00 till 23-07-2022 21:00 hrs. Service regulations in accordance with T-2022. There will not be remote Service zone.
- 12.10.2. Service areas are allocated by the Organizer, in compliance with the information in entry form. Service Areas will be reserved for all competitors free of charge: up to 80 m². The crews, in agreement with the Organizer, and paying an additional fee of 15 Eur/m², can reserve places of larger area till 15-07-2022 (Friday). After this term the Organizer will reserve Service areas at his own discretion. In case the entrant has several competing cars, which are serviced together in the Service zone, the request for joining Service areas has to reach the Organiser before 17:00 on 15-07-2022 (Friday).
- 12.10.3. In Service zone all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service zone have to be avoided. Teams must bring weights for fixing their tents. The Service zone must be left tidy after the rally. Crews are responsible for removing debris and liquids. Each Entrant must compensate the Organizer for the damage caused to the service location assigned to them and cover the costs of environmental management.
- 12.10.4. Only one service vehicle without trailer per one competitor is allowed enter to Service zone. "Service" sticker issued by the Organizer must be affixed on the windscreen of Service vehicle. Recce cars and team representative vehicles are not allowed to enter Service zone. Please, leave Your trailers on the Organizers' mentioned place. The crews who fail to comply with Service rules will be fined.

12.11. CHICANES

Chicanes will be set on Special stages for safety reasons, in order to reduce maximum speed. Where it is possible chicanes will be set before reconnaissance and will stay unhindered during whole rally. In places, where such action is impossible, the place of the chicane will be marked on the road surface. Marshals of the fact will observe the correct passage through the chicane. Incorrect passage through the chicane or pushing retarder's out of the perimeter will result 20 seconds penalty.

12.12. TEST STAGE (SHAKEDOWN)

The crews wishing to participate in the Test stage must provide in entry form www.autorally.lt no later than 15-07-2022 (Friday) at 17:00. The Test stage fee is 150 Eur, payable till 17:00 on Monday, 11 July, 2022. Later this fee will be increased to 200 Eur. The maximum number of participants is 30 crews, so registration in the Test stage may be suspended earlier. Except in cases of force majeure, the entry fee will not be refunded for those who have registered but did not participate in the Test stage. Test stage will be carried out on 22-07-2022 (Friday) from 12:00 till 14:00 hrs. The length of the section is 4,25 km. Each crew is allowed to pass this stage no more than 3 times. The cars participating in the Test stage must undergo a pre-start technical inspection, start numbers, rally and advertising stickers issued by the Organizer must be affixed on the cars, and a GPS Safety and Control Device must be installed. During the Test stage, any person in the car performing the duties of the second driver who is not a participant in the rally must sign the consent form provided by the Organizer. During the Test stage, all persons in the car must wear safety helmets, clothing and other safety equipment.

XIV. PRIZES

14.1. ORGANIZER PRIZES

14.1.1. Special prizes. The list of special prizes will be published on the official notice board before the start of the Rally.

14.2. PRIZE-GIVING

- 14.2.1. Prize-giving will take place on 23-07-2022 (Saturday) starting from 21:00 at the Viekšniai summer stage, Vytauto str.1, Viekšniai. All prizes will be given on the stage. In case the Prize-Giving will take part before the Official Results, the ownership of prizes handed to the winners will be confirmed after the Official Final Classification.
- 14.2.2. Winners of 1-3 places in LARC classifications for 1st and 2nd drivers must wear overalls during the awards ceremony as specified in 2022 item 11.1.3 of the LARC Regulations. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in fines by decision of the LASF Rally Committee.
- 14.2.3. The crews who do not take part in awards will be fined and will lose their rights to the prizes.

XV. PROCEDURES AFTER FINISH

15.1. FINAL CHECKS

Date: 23-07-2022 (Saturday), just after the finish of the Rally.

The crews who will be selected for the final Scrutineering (Stewards' decision) are requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and mechanics at the Final Scrutineering venue.

Each car will be driven to Final Scrutineering by a designated member of the team (who must be present at the finish), and accompanied by Rally Official.

15.2. PROTEST DEPOSIT FEE

Protests have to be lodged in accordance with LASC Art. 13

The protest deposit for LARC is Eur 150 (LARC Regulations Art. 10.2). The protest fee is paid directly to the LASF current account, proof of payment must be submitted to the Stewards together with the protest.

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit in accordance with LARC Regulations Art. 10.4

15.3. APPEAL DEPOSIT FEE

Appeals have to be submitted in accordance with LASC Art. 15.

The sum for a national appeal deposit (ASN) is Eur 1000.
