3. ORGANISER

The organiser is Lahti Historic Rally ry.

This rally competition will be held under the National Sporting regulations of AKK-Motorsport, Historic Rally Trophy 2021 series regulations, Finnish Rally Championship regulations and these Top Building rally regulations which are approved by the AKK Motorsport in ASN Visa number 20/R/21.

4. DESCRIPTION

Historic Rally Trophy Finland event

Total distance of the rally is 678,58km, including 12 special stages and total special stage distance is 146,09km.

If a competitor or someone on behalf of competitor is found in Sysmä, Hartola, Hollola, Padasjoki or Pälkäne municipality and Hämeenlinna city region roads marked in yellow, grey, black on the road map of Finland or non-marked roads before competitors starting time their right to participate to the rally is denied. This won't rule out possible sanction from National Sporting organization AKK-Motorsport ry. (Exception section 11. Reconnaissance)

Finnish Rally Championship

Total distance of the rally is 566,19 km, including 9 special stages and total special stage distance is 110,45 km.

Leg 1 (Friday 13.08.2021) the total distance is 235,18 km; including 3 special stages, special stage distance 35,64 km.

Leg 2 (Saturday 14.08.2021) the total distance is 331,01 km; including 6 special stages, special stage distance 74,81 km.

If a competitor or someone on behalf of competitor is found in Sysmä, Hartola, Hollola, Padasjoki or Pälkäne municipality and Hämeenlinna city region roads marked in yellow, grey, black on the road map of Finland or non-marked roads before competitors starting time their right to participate to the rally is denied.

This won't rule out possible sanction from National Sporting organization AKK-Motorsport ry.
(Exception section 11. Reconnaissance)

International timecard is used in the competition. In the timecard there is a column for competitors own markings.

Protest against results must be made 30 mins after provisional results are published.

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

In Top Building rally in Historic Rally Trophy classes, you can use FIA standard seats and seat belts which validity dates aren't ruling. Seats and seat belts have to be in prime condition, and they are checked in the scrutineering. (Rally regulations 2021, section 16.)

Classes are not combined.

Finnish Rally Championship

Competitor must report the fuel they are using when making the entry to the competition.

All competitors who enter by the rules to the competition are accepted.

6.1. Competitor information used by the organisation

When entering to the competition, a competitor accepts their personal data handled by the organizer and the specific information (name, club...) published in the participation list, results for example.

8. COMPETITOR MATERIAL AND DOCUMENT INSPECTION

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

Foreign competitors must send their information to rally organisation (contact information, information for announcer etc.) advised by the Rally Secretary.

Competition material is collected from the Rally HQ; classes 29-33 starting Wednesday 11.08.2021 at 07.30 and classes 34-38 starting on Friday 13.08.2021 at 07.00.

Only one competitor to the collecting of the materials, personal identity is checked!

Competitors receive their timecards from the time control station at the rally start.

Finnish Rally Championship

Every competitor receives the competitor material; roadbooks which contains the route followed through competition and two (2) road maps on Wednesday 11.08.2021 between 16.00 to 18.00 or on Thursday 12.08.2021 between 06.30-12.00 from Rally HQ (Lahti urheilu- ja messukeskus, Salpausselänkatu 7, 15210 Lahti.)

The competitors must send the documents found in KITI-kisapalvelu (<https://akk.autourheilu.fi/Public/Kiti/Competition/CompetitionOpen.aspx?id=12721&edit=0>) at latest 09.08.2021.

Only one competitor to the collecting of the materials, personal identity is checked, so take driver license, passport or identity card with you!



9. SERVICES

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

On Friday 13.08.2021 before start and at the evening before overnight the service is in Lahti, Salpausselänkatu 7, 15210 Lahti and after SS 3 area located in Sysmä, Vaihkyläntie 9, 19700 Sysmä.

On Saturday 14.08.2021 after SS 9 service area is located Tuulos, Lahden valtatie 206, 14810 Hämeenlinna. Service is only allowed in these areas.

There are so called Flexi services used in the competition.

Service A (Friday 13.08.2021) and Service C (Saturday 14.08.2021).

Service A (Friday 13.08.2021)

At Service TC in (Service In TC 3 A) the competitor is given the start time for the service (A4 size paper, which must be placed to the rally car in visible location at the service spot) and the ideal time for the TC 3 B (Service Out).

Service C (Saturday 14.08.2021)

At Service TC in (Service In TC 9 A) the competitor is given the start time for the service (A4 size paper, which must be placed to the rally car in visible location at the service spot) and the ideal time for the TC 9 B (Service Out).

This way the regroupings are carried out flexibly before service breaks.

Service B (Friday 13.08.2021)

Arriving to the Service B in (TC 6 A) and Service B Out (TC 6 B) are early check-in permitted.

Organization reserves for every competitor 6 x 8 m size service area. Special request and joint service need please contact organization by email kari.kukkamaki@gmail.com no later than 30.7.2021 at 23.59. After that the organization takes 150 € fee for changes in the service area. Organization keeps the right to decline the special requests.

Service vehicles must carry a fire-extinguisher for every competitor and oil absorbent mat ready to use. There must be also a tarpaulin at least the size of the rally car underneath it.

Finnish Rally Championship

Organization reserves for every competitor 6 x 8 m size service area. Special request and joint service needed please contact organization by email kari.kukkamaki@gmail.com no later than 30.07.2021 at 23.59. After that the organization takes 150 € fee for changes in the service area. Organization keeps the right to decline the special requests. There can be only one service car for every competitor, and it is marked with a sign when entering the service area first time.

Service vehicles must carry one at least 6kg fire-extinguisher for liquid fires and oil absorbent mat ready to use. There must be also a tarpaulin at least the size of the rally car underneath it. Service vehicles must have also a tarpaulin under the engine bay during the whole time at the service area during the whole time at the service area which prevents oil and fuel leaks to the soil. There must be tarpaulin under internal combustion engine generator, heaters and other fuel containers. If you neglect any of these regulations the Clerk of the Course has right to exclude the competitor from the event.

Flexi service (Service A) Lahti 13.08.2021 on Friday evening, Jalkarannantie 23, 15900 Lahti

When competitor enters the service TC 6 A (Service A In), competitor may start the service at the time they choose, and they mark the start time to the timecard and place the timecard to visible location at the windscreen and the service tent/area outline A4 size paper the same start time which is shown to the road of the service area. You are not allowed to do any markings to the timecard before the service time has ended (arriving to the service + 40min). The organization observes the used service time, and the officers must have free entry to the competitors service area and has to have a clear visual contact to the rally car in service. Service time is 40min and rally car must service before time check station TC 6 B (Service A Out) closes at 24.00.

Arriving to the TC 6 B (Service A Out) after 24.00 is seen as a late arriving no matter how long the competitor spends at the service and therefore Rally Regulation section 20.4. takes place.

TC 6 A (Service A in) and TC 6 B (Service A Out) are early check-in permitted, so you don't have to use all the service time marked in the timecard. Also someone else than a crew member can drive the rally car from the service (TC 6 B, Service Out) to Parc Fermé (TC 6 C Parc Fermé In).

Regroup and service at Tuulos on Saturday 14.08.2021, Tuuloksentie 1, 14810 Tuulos

When competitor enters the TC 9 A (Regroup / Service B In) competitor is given to the timecard the service starting time (regroup is done by this operation before service) and also is given the ideal arriving time to TC 9 B (Service B Out). Competitor is given a A4 size paper which has the service starting time and competitor must locate the paper to the service place/tent, so the time is shown to the rest of the service area. Organization observes the service all the time.

9.1. Penalty for the infractions in the service area:

1st violation 300 €

2nd violation 800 €

3rd violation leads to the exclusion from the competition by the Clerk of the Course decision.

10. REFUEL

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

Refueling is allowed at the fuel stations marked in the roadbook at pump areas or nearby the fuel stations in separate areas from their own cans.

Finnish Rally Championship

Refueling is only allowed at the fuel stations marked in the roadbook or separately marked refuel areas according to Finnish National Rally Championship regulations.

When making the entry to the competition competitor must report which fuel they are using and what kind of fueling they are going to use (pump or cans). The distances for refueling and the places are given in the Rally Guide.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

Reconnaissance classes 29-33

Classes 29-33 competitors may collect the reconnaissance material from the Rally HQ from 11.08.2021 07.30. When receiving and signing the reconnaissance material the competitor must give to the organizer information about the recce car and their phone number during the reconnaissance. The two (2) recce car signs which organizer hands to you must be attached to the recce car. One to the top center of the windscreen and one to the right rear window. These signs must be visible for the whole reconnaissance time.

The maximum speed limit is 80 km/h during reconnaissance on all special stages unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organiser. The competitor must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Driving against the direction of the rally is prohibited.

The organizer will control speeds as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. Also, the police will make checks along the route and will penalize for traffic infringements according to Finnish Traffic Law. If you neglect the organisers' official request to stop, the organiser has right to deny competitors start permission.

Reconnaissance is on Wednesday 11.08.2021 from 08.30 to 17.30 and on Thursday 12.8.2021 from 07.00 to 16.00.

Classes 11-28 and 34-38 are not allowed to reconnaissance.

Finnish Rally Championship

Competitors may collect the reconnaissance material from the Rally HQ on Wednesday 11.8.2021 between 16.00-18.30 and on Thursday 12.8.2021 between 06.30-12.00 (only one competitor to the collecting).

The two (2) recce car signs which organizer hands to you must be attached to the recce car. One to the top center of the windscreen and one to the right rear window. These signs must be visible for the whole reconnaissance time.

The maximum speed limit is 80 km/h during reconnaissance on all special stages unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organizer.

The competitor must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Driving against the direction of the rally is prohibited.

The organizer will control speeds as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. Also, the police will make checks along the route and will penalize for traffic infringements according to Finnish Traffic Law.

GPS tracking device is handed to competitors when collecting the documents and you must keep that device on during the whole reconnaissance. Competitor must make sure that the recce car has got USB power socket for the GPS tracking device and the device must be attached to the socket all the time. Every special stage is allowed to reconnaissance two (2) times, also the ones that are driven two times. SS 7 and SS 10 are driven mainly the same road sections and both special stages are allowed to reconnaissance two (2) times. Organization supervises the reconnaissance and speed limits via GPS tacking system.

Competitor is obliged to move the GPS tracking device to the rally car before their starting time to the Leg 1.

If you neglect the organizers official with organizer tags request to stop the organizer has right to deny competitors start permission.

Specific reconnaissance schedule is given in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the competition regulations.

11.1 Penalty for the infractions during the reconnaissance:

If during the reconnaissance organizer or police notices speeding or other traffic violation can the Clerk of the Course give a fine to the competitor.

1st violation Warning

2nd violation 90 €

3rd violation 200€

3rd violation leads to the exclusion from the competition by the Clerk of the Course decision.

Fine must be paid to the Rally HQ 30 minutes before competitors starting time, otherwise the competitors' right to start is denied.

11.2. Penalty for speeding during the competition

During the competition if organizer or police notices with a speed camera or from the GPS tracking device any speeding on the liaison or in the service area or if the competitor shuts off the GPS tracking device the Clerk of the Course can give a following penalty:

1st violation Written warning and 90€ fine. If the infraction is more than 30 km/h can the Clerk of the Course exclude the competitor from the competition.

2nd violation The Clerk of the Course decides the fine, which can be up to 500 € or exclude the competitor from the competition.

12. Scrutineering

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

Scrutineering is on Friday 13.08.2021 starting at 08.30 at Autosalpa Oy, Vanhanradankatu 2, 15520 Lahti.

Scrutineering schedule and other instructions for the scrutineering are given in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the regulations.

Scrutineering ends 10 min after the scheduled time for the last competitor.

Competitors' document check up

Competitor must send to the organizer the following documents no later than 09.08.2021 at 22.00.

Documents:

- rally car insurance/registration document
- rally car scrutineering document or certificate or an approval of yearly road inspection
- rally car homologation document/passport first page (V1600, N-Lite)
- roll cage homologation document/certificate, 1st page
- catalytic converter certificate, 1st page

Scrutineering is located at Volvo Truck Center, Jatkokatu 1, 15230 Lahti.

Scrutineering starts on Thursday 12.08.2021 at 14.00.

Scrutineering schedule is informed in the Rally Guide.

Every competitor must book their own scrutineering time between 04.08.2021 at 08.00 and 09.08.2021 at 22.00 from the Slotti system: <https://slotti.fi/booking/rallism>

A competitor must book available time for the basic or turbo scrutineering and fill the forms at the web side. Basic scrutineering is for cars without turbo. If competitor wants to change the scrutineering time after the system is closed the organizer takes 50 € payment for the extra work. Also, the same payment is taken if the competitor doesn't book a scrutineering time or is late from the scrutineering. The 50 € must be paid 1 h 30 mins before the competitor start time. Scrutineering ends 10 min after the scheduled time for the last competitor.

Competitor or someone on behalf of competitor (max. 2 persons) must sign up to the scrutineering office (Volvo Truck Center) 10 min before their scrutineering time.

Sealing

Parts to be sealed and registered for the competition are checked and sealed, if necessary, on Thursday 12.08.2021 in the scrutineering. Specific instructions are given in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the regulations.

Rally series organisation and the competition organisation reserve the following places for the competition numbers and ads.

- Back side windows 20cm high competition number sticker and competitors names according to Finnish Rally Regulations, 16.8. regulation.
- Serie wind screen advert according to the Serie regulations.

You receive the ads from Rally HQ when collecting the competition documents and the ads and numbers must be attached when arriving to the scrutineering. Competitor is responsible for the ads and numbers sticking on the rally car.

14. The progress of the competition

Start list to the rally is published according to the programme on the Official Notice Board on Sportity App. Competitors receive their timecard from start (TC 0) at Lahti harbor.

All Top Building rally competitors use international timecards. The organizer publishes an info about the international timecard use at the Official Notice Board.

Competition starts to the Leg 1: classes 11-38 (Friday 13.08.2021) after last EM Lahti Historic Rally competitor from Lahti harbor at 1-minute interval. (EM Lahti Historic Rally 1st competitor starts at 09.31) Time is informed later in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the regulations.

For the Leg 2 (Saturday 14.08.2021) classes 11-38 start from the Parc Fermé Hansatalo parking hall after the last Lahti Historic Rally competitor. (Lahti Historic Rally 1st competitor starts at 07.51) Estimated start time is informed later in the Rally Guide which for that part is part of the regulations. Official start times are announced in the Official Notice Board.

If competitor neglects to follow the route given in the roadbook the Clerk of the Course excludes the competitor from the competition.

Super Rally

Competitor who is retired from the Leg 1 is allowed to join for the Leg 2.

The special stages which competitor didn't finish is given the fastest time +5min. For the competitor who retired on the Leg 1 last liaison is given 5min time penalty.

Competitor must inform their willingness to continue the competition to the Clerk of the Course no later than 13.8.2021 at 23.00. After repairs the rally car must be in Parc Fermé on Saturday 14.8.2021 morning at the latest one hour before first HRT-competitor starting time. The Stewarts or the Clerk of the Course can order a re-scrutineering for the rally car. The start order for the restarters decides the Clerk of the Course.

Leg 1

Competitors starting times are informed by the programme on the Official Notice Board.

Competitors must collect the time control device from the Rally HQ, Lahti sporting hall, Salpausselänkatu 7, 15210 Lahti, no earlier than one hour before their starting time and attach it to the rally car.

Competitors receive their timecard from start (TC 0) at Lahti harbor.

Start takes place approx. 15.30 from Lahti harbor with 1 minute interval.

Finnish Rally Championship competitors move from the competition start (TC 0) to SS4 (TC 4).

Early check-in permitted TC stations

On Friday 13.08.2021 TC 6 A (Service A In), TC 6 B (Service A Out) and TC 6 C (Parc Fermé In) and on Saturday 14.08.2021 TC 12 A (Ceremonial Finish) are early check-in permitted, which competitor is allowed to arrive before their due time without time penalty.

Super Rally

Competitor who is retired from the Leg 1 is allowed to join for the Leg 2.

The special stages which competitor didn't finish is given the fastest time + 5 min. For the competitor who retired on the Leg 1 last liaison is given 5 min time penalty.

Competitor must inform their willingness to continue the competition to the Clerk of the Course no later than 13.08.2021 at 23.00. After repairs the rally car must be in Parc Fermé on Saturday 14.08.2021 morning at the latest one hour before first competitor starting time.

Overnight - Parc Fermé

The competition has a Parc Fermé area at P Hansa parking hall, Kauppakatu 10, 15140 Lahti.

Leg 2

Competition start list is determined by the Leg 1 start list. The retired competitors from the Leg 1 who inform the want to continue the competition, are followed by the same start list from Leg 1. Some changes can be made to the start list because of the retired competitors. Every competitor must check their probably changed start time from updated start list on the Official Notice Board on Saturday 14.08.2021 at 09.00.

Leg 2 timecard is given at the time control station (TC 6 D) leaving the Parc Fermé.

If competitor does not follow the route given in the roadbook the Clerk of the Course excludes the competitor from the competition.



15. COMPETITION BREAKS

Historic Rally Trophy Finland

On Friday 13.08.2021 there is one (1) service break (Service A) at Sysmä. Service A is 40 min (+ regroup 3-15 min before service). In addition, before overnight at Lahti there is 40 min service break (Service B).

On Saturday 14.08.2021 there is possibility to make some service actions (Lahti sporting center service area) on the first liaison section from the Parc Fermé to the SS 7. PLEASE NOTE! Service is included to the liaison time from Parc Fermé to TC 7.

There is also one (1) service break (Service C) on Saturday 14.08.2021 in Tuulos. Time for the service break is 65 min (+ regroup 3-15 min before service).

Finnish Rally Championship

On Friday 13.08.2021 there is service break at Lahti before Parc Fermé (40 min) and on Saturday 14.08.2021 in Tuulos service break (65 min) and before that regroup (3-15 min).

16. TYRES – Finnish Rally Championship

Competition total special stage distance is 110,45 km. It is permitted to use 8 tyres that comply with Finnish Rally Championship Series Regulations 2021, Chapter 16; Tyre Regulations. The checkups and markings take place by that rule.

18. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The number of rewarded by class is published in the Official Notice Board.

Both drivers will be rewarded at the podium according to provisional results at Lahti harbor. If the results change after the prize giving ceremony the competition is responsible to return the reward. The schedule for the prize giving ceremony is published in the Rally Guide. All competitors must participate in the ceremony. In case of force majeure permission for absence may be granted only by the Clerk of the Course.
