

Accreditation Process

- Competitor fills in the application for the rally and book hotel following RDRC COVID protocol's instruction:
- After confirmation of participation, link with password will be send to the competitor. Competitor should register Driver/Codriver and team member using the electronic form. At the end of the registration will receive a confirmation email with an electronic pass. The pass together with a wrist band will be checked every time you enter in HAD. Competitor will also receive the Attendee List.

ATTENDEE LIST,

where information must be filled by the team manager.

The form includes questions about each team member who will attend the rally (including crew, team management, technical staff, etc.). The form must be submitted to the organiser by 15.07.2021.

The form must include Team's Covid-19 delegate. Link to the form will be sent to team manager;

• All attendees must have a negative Covid-19 test (PCR) result no older than 96 hours before entering the venue;

ENTRY IN ITALY

• Entry from the countries of the European Union and the Schengen Area, Japan, Canada and the United States of America

By <u>ordinance of 18 June 2021</u>, the Minister of Health, Roberto Speranza, has provided for the use of the Covid-19 Green Certificate for entry into Italy from countries of the European Union and from Japan, Canada and the United States of America. UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN and NORTHERN IRELAND

For those arriving from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, a 5-day quarantine with mandatory swab testing was introduced by ordinance of 18 June 2021. Go to the relevant section: United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

INDIA, BANGLADESH AND SRI LANKA

The new ordinance extended to **30 July 2021** the measures in force for entry to Italy for people coming from India, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka, or who have been in the countries in the preceding fourteen days. Go to the section on <u>India</u>, <u>Bangladesh</u>, <u>and Sri Lanka</u>.

The <u>Ordinance of April 2, 2021</u> provided for some reclassifications on the lists of countries in <u>Annex 20 of the Dpcm of March 2, 2021</u>

- <u>List B</u> The States and territories with low epidemiological risk will be identified, among those in List C, by the Ordinance. At present, no State is included on this list.
- <u>List C</u> Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark (including the Faroe Islands and Greenland), Estonia, Finland, France (including Guadeloupe, Martinique, Guyana, Reunion, Mayotte and excluding other territories outside the European



mainland), Germany, Greece, Ireland, Israel, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands (excluding territories outside the European mainland), Poland, Portugal (including the Azores and Madeira), Czech Republic, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Hungary, Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, Andorra, Principality of Monaco. Special rules applying to those who have stayed or transited in United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

- <u>List D</u> Australia, New Zealand, Rwanda, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Thailand, Japan, Canada and United States and the States and territories with low epidemiological risk will be identified, among those in List E, by the Ordinance adopted pursuant to article 6, subparagraph 2.
 - Special rules applying to those who have stayed or transited in: <u>Japan, Canada and United</u> States of America
- <u>List E</u> Rest of the world (all States and Territories not specifically referred to in any other list).

- o India, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka

If attendee can present a valid EU Digital Covid Certificate for Vaccination or Recovery a person still is required to present a negative PCR COVID-19 test result no older than 96 hours before entering the venue to comply with FIA ISC Appendix S requirements.

SERVICE

Everyone entering the service area will have their body temperature measured with a scanner (airport Style).

If the temperature is above 37.5C, the person must step aside and wait for around 10 minutes to have the temperature measured again. If the repeated measurement also shows high temperature, the person will not be allowed inside the service area, and this person must immediately contact their team manager, which contacts rally medical personnel, which makes the decision about the further steps.

If temperature is lower than 37.5C the person can proceed towards SP entrance were his personal pass will be scanned and his wrist band will be checked. Entrance will be granted only to persons with both wrist band and digital pass.

Face mask must be used while in Service park.

There are hand sanitizers available at the entrance of service zone.

Service area contains recycling bins.

No public allowed, service area will be closed for spectators – entry will be allowed only to competitors, officials, and the priority media.

TESTS BEFORE THE EVENT

Team members must wear face masks while working.

RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance takes place with the crew being in one car.

When visiting local stores or catering facilities wear a face mask.

ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS / RECEIVING DOCUMENTATION / GPS TRACKING DEVICES

Before entering the area, every visitor will have their temperature measured with a scanner thermometer (airport Style).

Competitors can only enter the area with a face mask.

All visitors and competitors must maintain a 1 metre distance.

Organiser can limit each team (Crew) number of representatives inside the administrative checking to 2 persons.

Hand sanitizer must be used by anyone entering the area.

Crews must provide the organiser with as much information as possible beforehand, so that the administrative check time is as short as possible.

It is forbidden to have unauthorized persons in the area.



QUALIFYING STAGE BEFORE THE EVENT

Competitors are asked to maintain 1 meter social distancing before the start and after the finish and to wear a mask during interview.

TECHNICAL (CAR, EQUIPMENT) SCRUTINEERING

No more than 3 crew representatives can be in the scrutineering area.

Crew members, when entering the area, must be wearing face masks.

When entering the area, crew members must use the hand-sanitizer.

Scrutineering area is closed for spectators, entrance is only allowed for competitors.

Media is not allowed in the scrutineering area.

All people inside the area must maintain a 1 meter distance from each other.

TIME CONTROLS / MARSHALS

For ERC crews time cards must be shown to rally officials.

If competitors exit their vehicle in time control points – the balaclava must be used to cover mouth/ nose or face mask must be used, the same rules are a must for other team members in those zones.

OPENING CEREMONY

One-meter distance must be respected and face mask must be worn at opening ceremony.

STARTING POSITION SELECTION

One-meter distance must be respected and face mask must be worn at start position selection.

PRESS CONFERENCES

Pre-event press conference will take place in an open area outside the HQ. After event press conference will be held on the podium.


