KENYA GOVERNMENT – MANDATORY WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS IN INDOOR SETTINGS

The Kenyan Government has reinstated the mandatory wearing of face coverings in indoor settings as a containment measure to curb the spread of COVID-19 in the country with immediate effect.

The directive from the Kenyan Government is as below:

1. With regard to wearing face masks, the wearing of face mask in open public spaces where one is not in close proximity with another remains optional. However, one is required to wear a mask when in contact with other people in closed/confined spaces such as in PSVs, Aircrafts, Offices (Government/Private), Supermarkets, Market places and places of worship.
2. All in person indoor meetings to continue at full capacity of the venue as long as all the participants are fully vaccinated. All attendees are required to wear a facemask at their meeting venues. All participants in in-person meetings are required to show proof of vaccination.
