1. Introduction

1.1. The Ojibwe Forests Rally will take place on Friday, August 19 and Saturday, August 20 2022. The rally will consist of testing, recce, forest stages and closed venue stages.

The final details of the route, as well as time controls, regrouping points, and route controls are described on the time schedule contained in the Route Book. The Route Book and the final itinerary will be issued digitally prior to the event and in print at the event.

The Ojibwe Forests Rally has been part of rally in the United States for over 40 years. The 2022 event is the seventh rally in the national American Rally Association championship.

1.2. The Ojibwe Forests Rally will be held under the General Competition Rules, Rally Technical Rules, and Rally Competition Rules of the American Rally Association (ARA). Modifications, amendments and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated Bulletins posted to the online notice board.

1.3. The Ojibwe Forest Rally stages are gravel with a sandy base. They are tighter forest roads lined by trees and can be easily rutted with rain or multiple passes of rally cars.

4. Entries

4.1. Entry and payment must be paid online at <http://rallylicense.com>. ARA will send an email blast to ARA license holders announcing the opening of online entries. Contact ara@ara-rally.com with issues with the online entry process.

Rally participants must have an ARA license (competitors, service and volunteer) available on the ARA website.

4.2. The Ojibwe Forests Rally is limited to 75 cars. If more than 75 entries are received a waitlist will be used with priority based on time and date of entry and payment received. Initially, 70 entries will be accepted with the last five spots held until July 22, 2022 for the top five national teams from the 2022 ARA Championship. Wait listed entries not accepted will receive a full refund.

The first 10 paid National and Regional teams competing in a Subaru vehicle are eligible for discounts. Discount codes are:

4.4.

Entry fee includes recce participation, one service route book, single service spot and competitor route book. All competitors will receive printed and bound copies of all information necessary to complete the rally or follow the service route successfully. Printed materials can be picked up at event check in. All race documents will also be provided as a digital download once finalized.

4.6. Refund Policy

An entry may be withdrawn:

- without penalty, before August 5, 2022;
- with \$100 in penalty, between August 6, 2022 and the start of check-in/registration
- with up to 100% of the entry fee in penalty after check-in has started (percentage at the organizer's discretion).

Refunds will not be issued once competition has started the event.

5. Insurance

- 5.1. Third party liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage, effective during the competition, will be provided by a policy secured by USAC and displayed on the Official Notice Board.
- 5.2. Competitors must provide documentation showing Bodily Injury and Property Damage liability in amounts equal to or exceeding limits as stated in the current ARA rules for both the rally car and any service vehicles.
- 5.3. Competitors, service crews members and all event participants including officials, marshals, staff, stewards and all other volunteers who have obtained an ARA license, signed an ARA waiver and have been issued and are in possession of an event wristband confirming the signature of the waiver will be covered by a secondary USAC participant accident insurance policy which covers excess medical expenses to their primary medical insurance provider.

6. Advertising and Identification

- 6.1. The Ojibwe Forests Rally may use the event sponsor advertising space allowed by ARA rules. If this decal is provided during check-in it must be installed prior to scrutineering. Competitors choosing not to install the event sponsor decal must pay the event promoter (Rally Minnesota LLC) the \$1,000 fee. The fee must be paid before the vehicle will pass scrutineering.

7. Fuel

- 7.1. Competitors are required to supply/purchase their own fuel and must be in compliance with the ARA fuel requirements noted in the ARA RTR.
- 7.2. VP Fuel will be available for pre-purchase and delivered to the event. It must be ordered at least two weeks prior to the rally. Details are available at <https://www.americanrallyassociation.org/contingency> Pick up will be at the Friday service location at Gladen Construction . The Ojibwe Forests Rally and Rally Minnesota LLC is not responsible for fuel not picked up before Saturday, August 20, 2022 as Gladen Construction is actively using the site.

8. Reconnaissance (Recce)

- 8.1. Drivers and co-drivers must check in at the scheduled registration/check-in times prior to participating in recce.
- 8.2. Recce Details
 - 8.2.1. Recce will be open. Competitors may make as many passes as the time and recce speed limit allows. Recce is open from 7am until 7pm, Thursday, August 18, 2022.
 - 8.2.2. Speed limit during recce is 30mph. Speeds will be monitored with the 2022 ARA RSLite. Speeding penalties will be assessed per ARA RCR 1.2.1.g
 - 8.2.3. Recce roads are open to the public. Teams must drive responsibly and stay on the proper side of the road.
 - 8.2.4. The Soo Pass Ranch stages may be driven for Recce on either Wednesday, August 17 or Thursday, August 18. Crews planning to recce the Soo Pass Ranch stages must have completed check-in prior to driving the course. Wednesday, August 17 recce is available between 5 and 8pm.
 - 8.2.5. Street vehicles must be used during recce. No lettering, advertising or livery can be on the vehicles. No prepared rally cars are allowed.

9. Registration/Check-in

- 9.1. All team members attending the event must check in during the times available in the event schedule. Check-in will be at the Soo Pass Ranch, Except by appointment on Friday, August 19. Waivers must be completed online as part of the licensing process.
- 9.2. All participants (competitors and crew) must have completed the licensing process online.
- 9.3. The following items will be verified by the event registrar at event check-in. Please have these available for the registrar to verify.
 - 9.3.1. Driver and Co-driver ARA competition licenses
 - 9.3.2. Driver and Co-driver drivers licenses
 - 9.3.3. Competition vehicle registration and insurance
 - 9.3.4. Service crew ARA licenses
 - 9.3.5. Service crew vehicle registration and insurance

10. Scrutineering

- 10.1. Scrutineering will be held at the Soo Pass Ranch. The exact location for scrutineering will be determined and announced in early August. Communication on the location will be in an official Bulletin.
- 10.2. Scrutineering times will be scheduled by the Chief of Scrutineering. The times will be communicated to the teams and posted on Sportity.
- 10.3. Per ARA rules all decals and identification must be on the car prior to arriving at scrutineering. ARA door panels, windshield banners and number packages can be purchased online in advance.
- 10.4. Competition vehicles must be clean (washed) inside and out when presented for scrutineering. Vehicles not adequately clean will be refused inspection until they are clean.

11. Service

- 11.1. The 2022 Ojibwe Forests Rally will have two service locations.

 - 11.1.2. Service spaces will be assigned by the Chief of Service. For any special needs regarding service and placement contact the Chief of Service.
- 11.2. Service will open:
 - Friday
8AM

 - Saturday
730AM

- 11.3. The standard Service space will be 20 ft. X 60 ft., with entrance only via one 20 ft. side. If you need more room, you must register for additional space(s) of 20 ft. X 60 ft as needed. There will be a \$200 charge for each additional space needed. You must be able to place your vehicle(s), trailer(s) and service equipment all within the space(s) assigned to you.
- 11.4. No alcohol use will be permitted in any service area. This includes everyone in the Service area, no matter what their connection to the rally - all teams, crews, guests, and volunteers.
- 11.5. Vehicles not officially registered with a team as a service vehicle will be not allowed in the service area. All officially registered vehicles must display registration cards with prominent car number on their dash at all times. Vehicles without cards will be considered spectator vehicles and not permitted into the service area for any reason. Limited parking will be available outside the service area.
- 11.6. Tarps/spill cloths must be placed under cars for all servicing operations. Service areas not cleaned will be subject to \$150 fine.
- 11.7. No on-ground grills, or disposing of any charcoal, briquettes, etc., are permitted. Any non-gas grill ignition sources must be completely COLD or removed in a fire-proof container.
- 11.8. **Service crews must notify the Chief of Service when they leave the service area to retrieve a car.**
- 11.9. Purchasing fuel from commercial gas stations located along transit sections of the route is permitted. All work involved in adding such fluids must be performed by the driver and/or co-driver if outside of the service area. No added allowance is included in transit times for such fueling.
- 11.10. Follow the direction of the Rally volunteer staff when parking your service vehicle at all service locations. Teams will have an assigned location based on running order and space requirements.

12. Testing Stage

- 12.1. A testing stage will be provided on Wednesday, August 17 from 8AM – 4PM. Testing will be available in two hour time blocks. Each block will have a maximum of four teams at \$250 each.

- 12.3. Practice or testing on any road in the Paul Bunyan, Two Inlets and White Earth State Forests is forbidden, without consent of the Clerk of the Course, 90 days prior and 30 days following the Ojibwe Forest Rally.

Teams found in violation will be barred from starting or excluded from finishing the Ojibwe Forests Rally. Their entry fee will not be refunded. The Clerk of the Course will be the sole arbiter of any potential violation.

- 12.4. Any practice or testing on a private road or facility within the areas listed above during the dates stated in section 12.3 must be conducted with the written permission of the property owner. The Clerk of the Course must be given at least 48 hours advance notice of any such arrangements, including a copy of the permission and contact information for the property owner.

13. Features of the Rally

- 13.1. There will be no Parc Expose at the rally. Competitors are expected to line up ten minutes prior to the first MTC each day.
- 13.2. The rally will start from the Friday service location at Gladen Construction.
 - 13.2.1. The official start order will be posted on Sportity
- 13.3. As the Ojibwe Forests Rally has done for last few years an advance digital packet will be sent to all registered teams prior to the event, on or around the first week in August.
- 13.4. The 2022 power stage will be Stage 13; Otterkill
- 13.5. Rejoining the event after retirement
 - 13.5.1. Teams unable to complete all stages prior to service may be allowed to rejoin the rally, to run for fun. This must be approved by the Chief Scrutineer and Clerk of the Course. Competitors rejoining will be placed in the running order accordingly.
- 13.6. The official finish will be at the rally Headquarters; Soo Pass Ranch in Detroit Lakes, MN
- 13.7. Soo Pass Ranch will be used for many activities during the event week. Please follow signage, volunteers and directions.

14. Awards

- 14.1.1. Regional rallies awards points to Overall, Limited 4WD, NA4WD, Open 2WD and Limited 2WD. The Ojibwe Forests Rally Officials will award trophies in all classes with more than two finishers.
- 14.1.2. A volunteer banquet will be held on Saturday evening at Soo Pass Ranch.

15. Sanction Exemptions

- 15.1.1. The final section of the event is 95.95 total miles with 26.85 stage miles. ARA granted an exemption to RCR 1.5. If there are concerns about making this distance, please contact the Clerk of the Course.







Schedule Route Book, Competitor Edition Area Map: Saturday Stages


