Art. 1.1 Preamble

This rally will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) including appendices, the FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations including appendices, the WADA/NADA Codes, the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, the FRAS CNRB, CNRVIB and CNR2B Rally Regulations as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins. All FIA regulations can be found at https://www.fia.com/. FRAS regulations can be found on www.fras.ro. The various documents will be written in English and Romanian. In case of any discrepancy the Romanian text will be binding.

4. Entries

Art. 4.1 Closing date for entries

Art. 4.2 Entry procedure

Entries must be submitted in accordance with the provisions of Art. 22 - Art. 24 of the CNRB Regulations. See also CIS FIA Art. 3.8 - Art. 3.20.

The entry form only in electronic format (Internet) will be available on the platform https://inscrieri.racing. An entry application (also made electronically) will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fees. The entry fee must be credited in full to the organiser's bank account.

Art. 4.3 Number of competitors accepted and vehicle classes

Art. 4.3.1 The number of competitors shall be limited to: 75.

Art. 4.3.2 If the maximum number of entrants is exceeded, the last crews who have entered and paid the entry fee will be placed on a waiting list and not on the official registration list. The organizer reserves the right to decide which of the non-priority entrants will be accepted.

Art. 4.7 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry application is rejected

The organiser may partially refund entry fees, if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure.

5. Insurance Cover

Art. 5.1 The insurance fee included in the registration fee guarantees competitors coverage for any civil damages against third parties. The competitors will be insured on all special stages in the amount of 100,000 RON. Art. 5.2 This insurance will include all people within the rally organization (especially Officials) and co-drivers (on all Special Stages), accredited journalists / photographers and drivers with a foreign drivers' license, demanding that there is no other casualty insurance concluded by a local or foreign insurance company. Art. 5.3 Legal liability insurance is compulsory for all cars participating in the rally. This has to be contracted by the owner of the car. The legal liability insurance has to cover all damages on all routes excepting the Special Stages and the Shakedown. The existence of this legal liability insurance has to be proved at the administrative checks.

Art. 5.4 Service, reconnaissance and auxiliary cars are excluded from this organization liability cover insurance. In case of any accident with only material and no human damages, the competitor has the absolute obligation to report such damages immediately at the following Time Control Point. A detailed written report at the end of the Leg must be filled in at the Rally HQ. Furthermore, in case of physical damage, the driver must immediately inform the Rally HQ.

Art. 6.3 Advertising for the partners of the participating crews at Sibiu Rally 2022

All crews registered for the Sibiu Rally 2022 will be able to organize sports advertising activities (tents, branding, sampling, hostess, autograph sessions, etc.) only in the area allocated within the service park.

Rally locations: start / finish area, awards ceremony, press conference room, VIP area, superspecial stage start are exclusive locations for the organizer's partners. Crews may organize sports advertising activities in these areas only with the written consent of the organizer (by contract). Otherwise, the organizer will sanction the crew with a fine of 2500 Lei.

The promotion of the crew partner in the form of commercial advertising (direct promotion of product, services, offers) without the written consent of the organizer (by contract), is interpreted as prohibited advertising and will be sanctioned by the organizer with a fine of 5000 Lei.

7. Tyres

CNRB, CNRB / Gravel - According CNRB Regulations - Art. 13;

CNRVIB - According CNRVIB Regulations - Art. 60;

CNR2B - According CNR2B Regulations - Art. 4.6.

*The tyres used during Shakedown will not be marked or accounted in any way.

Art. 8 GPS Requirements

Inside each racing car, in the co-driver's area, 2 +/- cables must be prepared to power the GPS. On these wires, the scutineers will mount a plug to connect the GPS system. GPS power MUST be permanent, even if the engine is turned off or the master ignition is OFF.

This feature will have to remain operational for all the rallies of CNRB 2022.

9. Fuel

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (RRSR Art. 62). Also, see:

10. Reconnaissance of Special Stages

Reconnaissance will be according to FIA RRSR Art. 35 and Art. 35 of the 2022 CNRB Regulations. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in Appendix II of these supplementary regulations.

Reconnaissance for the superspecial stage will be done without restrictions. Competitors are required to use the GPS system. Failure to comply with the provisions of this aligned is sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course as follows: the first offense with a fine of 250 RON, the second offense with a fine of 1250 RON, the third offense with the refusal to start.

Any involvement of a crew in a road event or accident during reconnaissance will be reported immediately to the official Competitor's Relations Officer or to the emergency phone and may be sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course with a fine, disqualification or proposal to suspend the license.

Art. 10.1 Registration procedure

All competitors who wish to run the reconnaissance must specify in the entry form the identification of the car to be used during reconnaissance.

Each car must be identified with a number of reconnaissance provided by the organizer. Cars used in the rally cannot be used for reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance numbers to be fixed on the right side - front of the windshield and on the rear window. **It is not allowed to detach these numbers during reconnaissance.** Competitors are required to immediately notify the secretariat of the competition in case of change of the reconnaissance car.

Art. 10.2 Specific regulations

During reconnaissance, all national traffic rules must be followed, including but not limited to speed limits. Please note that Special Stages will not be closed to traffic during reconnaissance.

The maximum speed allowed for the reconnaissance of special stages is according to the Romanian Road Code (for National Roads and County Roads the speed limit is **50 km / h**, except in cases in which speed restrictions are imposed on the road. These restrictions determine the maximum speed allowed. A competitor will be penalised for crossing the speed limit on the special stages if the device records a minimum speed of **56 km/h during a period longer than 10 seconds.** Special restrictions of maximum **40 km/h** will be applied on the liaison connecting



SS 7 / 9 to Start SS 5 (Santa by night). Additional limitations may be marked in the Road Book.

It is strictly forbidden to return on the special stages!

Exceeding the speed limit during the reconnaissance for the special stages and for Shakedown will lead to the application of a fine by the Clerk of the Course as follows: 50 Lei for each kilometre per hour above the speed limit. The fine applies when the speeding has been for more than 10 seconds (in the case of GPS system measurements). Fines are paid to FRAS until the first Stewards meeting, under the sanction of refusal to start.

Any other violation of the provisions of the Traffic Code during the reconnaissance will attract a penalty from the Sports Commissioners, according to CNRB Regulation - Art. 34.3.4.

The amount of the fines will not change in the case of any other fine imposed by the police. The amount of the fine will be doubled if the offense is repeated during the same rally.

In the event of a breach of traffic law committed by a crew participating in the rally, the police officers or officers who found the breach must inform the offender accordingly, in the same way as for road users. ordinary.

If the police or officials decide not to stop the offender, they may request the application of the sanctions provided for in the legislation, provided that:

- The notification of the offense is received officially and in writing before the publication of the provisional ranking.
- The minutes shall be sufficiently detailed so that the identity of the
 offending pilot is indisputably established, with the exact specification of
 the place and time at which the offense took place.

The facts alleged not to be susceptible to interpretation.

There are no restrictions for tyres used during reconnaissance.

Art. 10.3 Collection of speed control checking devices

All reconnaissance cars must be equipped with a speed control checking devise. This devise can be collected according the programme in chronological order (SR Art. 3).

The fee for the GPS device is included in the registration fee and is of 300 Lei for CNRB, CNRB / Gravel, CNRVIB crew and 300 Lei for CNR2B.

11. Administrative checks

Art. 11.1 Documents to be presented:

For the administrative checks to be done on time, make sure to send through the platform https://inscrieri.racing the following documents:

Driver and co-driver license



- Driver / co-driver ID cards / passports
- Valid driving licenses (or valid replacement evidence) for driver and codriver
- ASN authorization for foreign competitors (if required)
- Application form completed in full
- Car documents
- Declaration with the consent of the owner of the car for its use
- Periodic Technical Inspection of the car
- Mandatory Insurance of the competition car

Both members of the crew must be present during the physical Administrative Checks according to Art. 3 Programme, holding their drivers' licenses, in order to sign the entry form in original.

Art. 11.2 Timetable

12. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking Art. 12.1 Scrutineering, venue and time

Location: Piața Mică

Program: Art. 3 in the Supplementary Regulations

The cars can be presented at the initial scrutineering by a team representative. At the initial scrutineering, the GPS monitoring system for the competition cars will be verified.

Art. 12.2 Mandatory documents

- Approval form;
- SOS / OK panels in A3 format;
- FRAS technical passport;
- Fuel tank and the rollcage declarations of conformity.

Art. 12.4 Protective equipment for competitors

The equipment must comply with the International Sporting Code – Appendix L - Chap. III. The equipment will be checked during the rally. It will not be necessary to present the equipment at the initial scrutineering.

Art. 12.5 Noise level

According to the CNRB Regulation 2022.



Art. 12.6 Special national provisions

All epidemiological prevention measures must be followed by all participants.

Art. 12.7 Installing the GPS monitoring system

The GPS monitoring system must be located on all cars. Each crew must install the system before the initial scrutineering, according to the instructions received from the GPS representative.

The disassembly of the GPS system for One Event licensed crews will be performed in the technical area before the last entry into the service park by the GPS representative.

Both One Event crews and annual licensed crews must return the GPS device to the HQ no later than Friday, 15.07.2022, at 21:00. Loss, non-delivery or damage to the equipment will result in a fine of 2500 Lei, paid to FRAS.

13. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 13.1 Procedures and festive start order

The official photo will be taken before the crews parade.

The participation during the crews' parade is mandatory for all CNRB, CNRB / Gravel, CNRVIB crews and optional for CNR2B crews. Not attending will be analised and penalised by the Clerk of the Course.

The route for the parade is: Piaţa Mare – Nicolae Bălcescu – Tribunei – Mitropoliei – Piaţa Albert Huet – Piaţa Mică.

For the Festive Start the crews will pass under Turnul Sfatului, will climb on the ramp, will go under Podul Minciunilor and will return to the Service Park following the roadbook. The festive start list will be established and announced by the organizer.

Art. 13.2 Procedures for the Super Special Stage

- The position at Start SS 10 CNRB and CNRVIB / SS 5 CNR2B: pairs of two competitors will be formed according to the order of check-in in TC 10 (TC 5 CNR2B(. The first competitor who will check in from the two will occupy the Lane 1. The second competitor in the pair will occupy Lane 2.
- The competitor on Lane 1 (on the right, on the route direction) will first pass under the bridge. The competitor on Lane 2 (on the left) will pass first over the bridge;
- At Start SS 10 CNRB and CRNVIB / SS 5 CNR2B a Start Clock will be located, composed of two green and red led matrices;
- An optical detection device for start (photo cells) will be located at 50 cm after the start lane. Initially, the start clock will show a matrix of red leds;
- After positioning both competitors on the start lane, the officials will initialise a countdown, starting from the "15" second down to "0";



- When the countdown reaches 0, the red panel will shut down and will light up the green panel; the competitor may start at this moment;
- The green panel will remain powered on for 5 seconds, after which the clock will return to the original state, with the red panel;
- The start time will be written in the timecard at the STOP;
- The Finish will be located on the same lane, 25 meters before the Start lane;
- SS 10 CNRB and CNRVIB / SS 5 CNR1B is considered to be finished after the competitors will cross the finish lane located on the same lane where they ran the stage (a single pass);
- After running the stage, the competitors will be stopped using a red flag by an official to leave the circuit on the first exit after the Start lane;
- For a faster exit of the stage, a total time of 8 minutes will be allocated;
- For running an additional run, a penalty of 3 minutes will be added to the stage time:
- If a competitor misses the route, the officials will show the red flag. The competitor who missed the route will be sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course with minimum 10 minutes of penalty, up to the disqualification;
- In case a competitor stops on the stage, but may be overpassed, the other competitor in the pair will be shown a yellow flag, by the final intermediate official before the incident;
- In case a competitor stops and blocks the route, his pair will be shown a red flag;
- The competitor affected will receive a fair time applied by the Clerk of the Course;
- The competitor who blocked the route / remained suspended may be placed back on trach by the spectators under the supervision of marshals or the stage commander. In case the competitor may drive on his own means to finish and the next TC, he will be considered to have finished the stage. The effective time will be recorded at the Finish. Any other penalties will be applied according to the regulations. If getting back on track also requests the towing car, the competitor will be considered Retired.

Art. 13.3 Festive finish

The Festive finish consists in awarding the first three crews in FIA General and PowerStage Classifications. The festivity will be located after the final stage (SS 10).

Art. 13.4 Advance entry and handing in / changing timecards

The competitors can check in in advance without penalty in the following time controls: TC 5A, 10C (TC 5C CNR2B).



The timecards will be handed/changed in the following time controls: TC 0, 2B, 4B, 5A, 5B, 7B, 10C (TC 0, 2B, 5C CNR2B).

Art.13.5 Shakedown

13.5.1 Participants:

Only crews who have passed the administrative checks and the initial scrutineering are allowed. Participation is possible only in compliance with all the rules provided for special stages (publicity and complete identification, all approved clothing, etc.).

13.5.2 Passages

A maximum of 5 passages will be allowed

Anyone (except the driver and co-driver) wishing to participate in Shakedown must sign a declaration on their own responsibility (Appendix 6 to the Supplementary Regulations). These forms will be returned at the TC of the Shakedown.

Art. 13.6 Special procedures for the service park

13.6.1 Location: Piata Mare

Access in the service park will be done STRICTLY with the competition cars and only one single licensed Service / Team car. Reconnaissance cars and other cars that are not adequate for technical assistance will not be allowed. The competition cars will be taken down from the trailers in the Trailer Park area in Piaţa 1 Decembrie 1918, the Central Railway Station and will run the 650 m to the Service Park on wheels (see the appendix for indications and GPS coordinates).

ATTENTION! The registration numbers of cars requesting access (competition car + service car) will be mentioned in the registration form.

The competition cars will be able to leave the final parc ferme only after the prize-giving ceremony has finished, following the roadbook to the trailers location (it is strictly forbidden to enter the service park with the trailers).

13.6.3 Allocation of service space:

In the main service park, an area of $40~\text{m}^2$ will be provided by the organizer for each crew. The allocation of additional space is made according to the available space at a cost of 100~Lei/square meter. Acknowledgement of crossing the allocated space will be done by the organizer and sanctioned with a fee of 200~Lei/square meter. The placement of the crews in the service park will be done according to a displayed plan published on the Digital Notice Board and following the instructions of the organizer.

It is forbidden to park the platforms inside the service park or in any other location that could confuse traffic in the area. The organizer may propose to the Clerk of the Course the sanctioning of crews who do not comply with this rule.

13.6.4 Speed limit

According to the provisions of Art. 57.4 of the CNRB regulation

13.6.5 Behaviour

Mandatory requirements:

- to use the **protection cloth** of the environment and the deterioration of the quality of the services provided by the Parc Service and the Parc Ferme;
- to refuel only in the special refuelling area;
- to have at least one fire extinguisher;
- to keep it clean and to remove any garbage and any liquids that were used;
- to stop working on the cars after 21:00;

At the end of the event, each crew will turn in the allocated space to the organizing representative – chief of service park.

Not following these rules will be sanctioned with fees between 1000 and 2500 Lei (depending on the cleaning expenses).

In the event that the service is needed after 21:00, the CRO (Mihai Lăcătuș) will be contacted to have the service relocated in another place outside the Service Park.

Art. 13.7 Power Stage

Power Stage is SS 9 and for CNR2B is SS 4.

Art. 13.8 Special national procedures

13.8.1 Availability of participants

Competitors who entered their cars in Parc Fermé at the end of the rally must remain available on the phone (mobile) until the final results are displayed.

13.8.3 Remote Service Area (tires & lights):

The CNRB 2022 Regulations apply.

Art. 13.9 Start Procedure in Special Stages

At the start of each special stage a clock with a digital LED display will be showing the hour, minute, second and two arrays of green and red LEDs. The display will be connected to a GPS / GSM equipment, with satellite connection, to synchronize all time equipment on the special stages.



APPENDIX IV: COMPETITION NUMBERS



- 1) On the front doors: 2 panels 67 cm long / 17 cm high, with the number in front. The top of the panel should be placed 7 to 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. Under these panels will be applied a sticker with the same length and 8 cm wide, with the logo of the CNRB 2022 championship, according to the regulations.
- 2) On the rear windows: 2 numbers with a height of 20 cm and a thickness of 25 mm in fluorescent orange (PMS 804). These numbers will be placed at the top of the side rear windows near the driver's name.
- 3) On the hood: The competition logo in a rectangle with a height of 21.5 cm and a length of 43 cm. In the middle of the logo will be inscribed no. competition, with character (font) HELVETICA, the height of the figure being 8 cm.
- 4) On the rear window: a panel at the top, at least 90 cm long and 10 cm high, reserved for the FRAS. An adjacent surface of 15 cm containing the competition number with a height of 14 cm fluorescent orange (PMS 804) on a clean background. This number can be reflective or fluorescent and must be visible from behind at eye level.
- 5) On the roof: A rectangular panel 50 cm long / 52 cm high, facing the front of the car. The matte black competition number 5 cm wide by 28 cm high will be displayed on a matte white background of 50 cm wide and 38 cm high.



APPENDIX V: EXTRACT FROM THE APPENDIX L, FIA ISC 2022

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8858-2002 or 8858-2010 (Technical List N°41),
- 8859-2015 (Technical List N°49),
- 8860-2010 (Technical List N°33), or
- 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List N°69)

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, Article 53.1.

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing or metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start. **RELATED LINKS:**
