



Times for mandatory pit stops for Race 1 on 09-04-2022

The test in pitlane has shown that entering, stopping and exiting the pit lane can be executed within the time span of 12 seconds.

This results in a total sum of **1 minute 12 seconds** in between the two timed-loops in the pitlane. Added success and refueling seconds are showed below.

The position of the timing loop at the beginning of the pit lane is indicated by the 60 kph sign and the SC Cone. The time loop at the pit exit is indicated with the end of 60 kph sign and SC Cone.

Please have a look where lines before you start the race!

The pits stop has to be between **the 25th and 35th minutes in the race.**

During the stop the team is allowed to work on the car.
