The Stewards, having been informed by Clerk of the Course, received a Report from Chief Timekeeper, summoned and heard the Crew. Having considered the matter, the Stewards determine as follows:


Facts: The Report from Chief Timekeeper available to the Stewards shows that at the TC 6B (PF out) the Crew No.43 (Blanda Luděk / Hlávka Jiří) was not the complete Crew. Instead of Jiří Hlávka there was another person onboard.

Offence: Breach Art. 2.5 and Art. 44.2.3 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations 2022

Decision: Disqualification of Crew St. No.43 (Blanda Luděk / Hlávka Jiří)

Reason: The co-driver Jiří Hlávka was not present in the car at the re-start from Overnight Parc Fermé (TC 6B). There was another person, who was not a member of the Crew, in the car. The Timekeepers at TC 6B reported this situation to the Clerk of the Course who referred the matter to the Stewards. According to the 2022 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations (RRSR) art. 44.2.3, there must be the two Crew members and the car in the control area at the entry of the time on the time card. The Crew is defined in article 2.5. of RRSR as two persons onboard each car nominated as driver and co-driver. The Stewards explained to the Crew that they were in breach of RRSR.

The Competitor is reminded of his right to appeal which is stipulated in the 2022 FIA International Sporting Code and in the 2022 FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
