The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course (CoC Decision N. 6, 7 and 8), summoned and heard the drivers Ken Torn and Kauri Pannas and team representative Jakub Zelek (summons No. 2), have considered the following matter, determine the following:


- Fact:** Repeated Speeding during Reconnaissance
- Offence:** Breach of Article 12.2.1.c of the FIA International Sporting Code regulations
- Decision:** In accordance with Article 11.9, 12.3 and 12.4.1.n of the FIA International Sporting Code, a suspension of one ERC event on the driver, Mr Ken Torn and codriver Kauri Pannas. This penalty is applied with a suspension of sentence, subject to no further breach of similar nature – multiple, significant speeding during Reconnaissance – at any ERC event within 12 months from today.
- Reason:** The driver was measured three times in significant speeding during the Recces. This behaviour is potentially very damaging for the image of the Rally in the population and towards the local authorities.
- During the hearing the codriver stated that he misunderstood the Supplementary Regulations and Bulletin No. 1 and gave wrong driving instructions.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
