Having heard from various Officials including the CoC, have considered the following matter, the Stewards determine the following:

Addressed to: Demoporto, Organizer of the event

Fact: Non-respect of event official program (Prize-giving ceremony occurred one hour before schedule)

Offence: Breach of article 19.1, of FIA RRSR 2022, and Article 3.2 of the Supplementary Regulations

Decision: Warning to the Organizer.

Reason for the decision: At the end of first Leg there was a prize-giving ceremony exclusively related to the Portuguese National Championship. Due to a some misunderstanding the authorities of the counties concerned by the Rally had to wait more than one hour for the beginning of the ceremony.

At the end of the ERC Rally the Clerk of Course was busy in a meeting with FIA Delegates and somebody from the organization decided to advance the prize-giving ceremony (16:45 instead of 17:50) to avoid the problem of the preceding day, without informing the Stewards, the FIA Delegates and the Promoter. Fortunately, all competitors concerned by the prize-giving ceremony were able to attend.

This is a clear non-respect of the official program, but without any influence on the sporting results of the event. This is the reason why the Stewards decide to give a warning to the organizer.

The decision is based on Art. 11.9.1, 11.9.3.a, 11.9.3.f, 12.3.1, 12.4.1.a of the FIA ISC 2022.

The organizer is reminded that he has the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
