The CoC received a report from the GPS provider who states that the following competitors exceeded the maximum speed of during the SS2 and SS4.

The speeding records show the following infringement pulses:

According art. 27.3.1 of the Cross Country Rally Sporting Regulations, it is a crew's responsibility to abide by the limit, with a tolerance of 3 kph.

The tolerance is applied only for the first two pulse signals with excessive speed within 10 minutes. Any exceeding of the maximum speed during the event will be penalized according to Article 37.2.7

Consequently, the Clerk of the Course decide to penalize the infringements as follows:

Competitor 203: 10 seconds in SS2

Competitor 214: 4 x 10 seconds (40 seconds in SS2)

Competitor 400: 10 seconds in SS2

Competitor 215: 1 minute in SS2 and 50 Euros penalty.

Competitor 203: 2 x 10 seconds in SS4

Competitor 203: 10 seconds in SS6
