1. Changes to the road book

- Page 19, map of SS 2: Medical Point is in the incorrect location. The correct location is with the next Radio Point. In the page 21, the Medical Point is in the correct location.

- Page 26, boxes 37-28: tech. zone 10 min + service **45 min**

2. Rally car safety scrutineering

- Deviating from the Supplementary Regulations, the tyre bar code form should be returned at the latest on 17.6.2022 at 18:30.

- Deviating from the Supplementary Regulations, only drivers in classes 1-11 need to return the tyre bar code form.

- Deviating from the Supplementary Regulations, the rally car safety scrutineering starts on Friday 17.6.2022 at 11:30.

- Classes 6-31: After the validity of the standard for the seat and seat belts (expiry date or year), the seat and / or seat belts may be used nationally for a maximum of (5) years.

3. Itinerary

- Changes have been made to the distances in the itinerary, in addition some clarifications have been made for the times. New itinerary is available at the official notice board.

4. Classes

- According to the notification published on 27.4.:

In the supplementary regulations Art 4.3.3, it is incorrectly stated that classes 20-31 are for Seniors, General and Juniors. The classes are specifically meant for drives in General and Junior classes without the restriction to Seniors.

Corrected heading for classes 20-26:

~~Seniors~~, General and Juniors (Reconnaissance allowed)

Corrected heading for classes 27-31:

~~Seniors~~, General and Juniors (Reconnaissance not allowed)
