The Stewards, having received pictures and video evidence from the FIA Sporting Delegate and the CoC, having heard the driver Miko MARCZYK and co-driver Szymon GOSPODARCZYK, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

**Fact:** Dangerous driving just after podium ceremony which endangered a cameraman (donuts)

**Offence:** Breach of Article 34.1.2 FIA RRSR as well as of article 12.2.1.h of ISC

**Decision:**

- 1) According to art 12.5 of International Sporting Code to levy fine of 2000 EUR on driver Miko MARCZYK
- 2) To pay all cleaning costs resulting from these donuts that will be invoiced by the organisation of Rally Poland

The payment of the fine will have to be done on the following address:

In accordance with Article 12.7 of the FIA International Sporting Code, fines shall be paid within 48 hours of their notification. Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.

**Reason:** The donuts were not allowed by the Supplementary Regulations.

The driver said that he asked for the permission of the CoC who didn't say either "yes" nor "no" and the driver thought that this meant that he was allowed to do this. He said also that he asked for the permission of the speaker who said "yes" but he is aware that this person has no authority to allow this.

During these donuts a cameraman was endangered.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
