The Stewards, having received a report from FIA Technical Delegate (Doc. 6.2) having summoned and heard the representative Competitor RALLYE TEAM SPAIN Victor Perez (summons No 2) have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Fact: Roll cage of this car is not complying with the homologation form A-5780

Offence: Breach of Article 260.901-a1 FIA ISC Appendix J

Decision: No further action

Reason: This car with the same Competitor and the same Crew participated in WRC Rally Portugal on May 20th, 2021. The same offence was discovered for this car and several other cars of the same model. The Stewards of WRC Rally Portugal decided there would be no penalty for the concerned Competitors but penalized the car manufacturer PSA Motorsport as they were considered as fully responsible for this case.

It is a pure administrative problem without any safety aspects.

After WRC Rally Portugal PSA Motorsport informed their customers that they will fix the problem with the FIA.

According to the FIA Technical Delegate of Rally Poland, PSA Motorsport submitted a proposal to fix the problem to the FIA that was rejected shortly before Rally Poland. As this matter is still pending between PSA Motorsport and FIA, no correction can be made for Rally Poland.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
