## COVID-19 ACCREDITATION

The organizer of the ORLEN 77th Rally Poland is obliged to fully comply with the regulations on COVID-19 prepared and published by the FIA. The same applies to all Stakeholders that plan to take part in the competition, regardless of the role in which they will come to the rally. The information and instructions published on the rally website in the COVID-19 tab concern, among others: competitors, rally teams, crew members, suppliers of goods and services, journalists, judges, organizer's staff and officials. Anyone who plans to visit the Venue must first perform the activities described below and receive COVID-19 accreditation.

By <u>**12.06.2021**</u>, the following documents should be downloaded, filled in and sent to the address <u>covid@rallypoland.pl</u>:

The first two documents need to be completed by the Stakeholder that plans to visit the Venue. For example - such Stakeholder is the editorial office of a newspaper (fills in the above two documents), a photographer working for this editorial office fills in the third document mentioned above. If the photographer runs his own business, he is obliged to complete all three of the above-mentioned documents.

The list in the .xlsx file should be completed with the data of <u>all persons</u> intending to participate in the competition within the given Stakeholder.

Additionally, persons applying for access to <u>HDZ - High Density Zone</u> (Rally HQ, including eg Rally Office) are obliged to send the current <u>PCR</u> test result to <u>covid@rallypoland.pl</u> before coming to the rally. Upon arrival at the competition, the first thing to do is to accredit at the Covid-19 desk by showing a negative test result up to <u>96 hours earlier</u>.

Accredited persons will receive special wristbands entitling them to stay in the competition area.

Stakeholder and people who do not receive the COVID-19 accreditation (and will not have wristbands) will not be allowed to enter the competition area and will not be able to take part in the competition.
