



The Competitions must also hold a valid FIA International Competition License.

### **4.5.2 Foreign Competitors**

The full entry fee must be paid in CASH at Rally HQ during Administrative Checks THE ENTRY APPLICATION WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IF ACCOMPANIED BY THE TOTAL ENTRY FEE AND **AUTHORISATION FROM THE COMPETITOR'S LOCAL ASN.** 

#### 4.6 Refunds

- 4.6.1 Entry fees will be refunded in full:
  - To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
  - In the case of the rally not taking place.
- 4.6.2 The Organizers may refund 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN), were unable to start the Rally.

### **5. INSURANCE**

- 5.1 Competitors' and drivers' attention is drawn particularly to the fact that
- Tanzanian Law requires all vehicles driven on a public road to be insured against Third Party Risks. It is the Competitor's and/or Driver's responsibility to ensure that they are properly covered.
- 5.2 Competitors and/or drivers take part entirely at their own risk. The Organizer declines liability in any accident caused by or to Competitors and/or Drivers and their vehicles during the whole of the event. The Organizer also declines any liability for breach of Laws and Regulations of the Republic of Tanzania. Competitors and/or Drivers will be entirely responsible for any accident or breach of laws in which they may be involved and will declare in writing to the Organizer particulars of any incident from which liability may arise and will indemnify the Organizer in regard to any liability to any person
- 5.3 The Organizer advises each member of the crew of each competing vehicle to be insured for Personal Accident for a minimum amount of Tanzania Shillings 1,000,000 for the duration of the Rally. Special terms for Personal Accident, Third Party, Fire and Accident Damage insurance are available from the official insurers to the Organizer
- 5.4 Competitors take part entirely at their own risk. The AAT as organizer of this event declines liability whatsoever in any accident caused by the competitors and their vehicles during the whole event.

#### 5.5 Responsibility and Risk

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the event, Competitors agree:

- i) to release AAT, promoters, sponsor organizations, land owners and lessees, organizers of the event, officials, representatives and agents from all liability for any death, personal injury, psychological trauma, loss or damage howsoever arising from their participation in or attendance at the event, except to the extent prohibited by law;
- ii) to attend or participate in the event at own risk. A Competitor and/or Driver will have no claim against the Organizer or owners of private property arising out of any act or default of or by them, their servants or officials, before, during or after the Rally.
- 5.6 Any accident which may give rise to a claim under any of the insurance covers must be reported in detail to the Secretary of the Event in writing within 7 days of the finish of the last Day of the Rally.









- 5.7 Under no circumstances will any competitor, driver, service crew, or official admit any liability or sign any form of paper which may admit or imply liability in any accident or incident which may arise.
- 5.8 The insurance cover will come into effect from the official start of the rally and will cease at the official end of the rally or at the moment of retirement or exclusion of a competitor.
- 5.9 The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates issued by AAT, are not considered as official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owners.

### **6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION**

### 6.1 Advertising

### 6.1.1 Restrictions on Advertising

Competitors are allowed to affix any kind of advertising to the cars, provided that:

- It is authorised by the national laws and the FIA regulations.
- It is not likely to give offence.
- It is not political or religious in nature.
- It respects the regulations on competition numbers.
- It does not interfere with the crew's vision through the windows.
- It complies with the provisions of Article 10.6.2 of the Code.

### 6.1.2 Organiser's Advertising (Appendix 4)

The organiser's optional advertising (if any) which may be affixed to the Competitor's cars will be communicated in a bulletin.

### **6.2** Identification

Competition numbers and rally plates according to the FIA Regional Rallying Sporting Regulations Art.27, will be provided by the organisers. See also Appendix 4.

Numbers and plates must be affixed on the rally car before scrutineering and must be visible throughout the duration of the rally.

### 7. TYRES

7.1 Tyres, quantities specified for use during the rally

Refer to article 13 of FIA Regional Rally Regulations.

7.2 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

Free Tyres for gravel.

7.3 National laws or special requirements

Other than on special stages all National Traffic laws will apply.

#### 8. FUEL

- 8.1 The use of FIA approved Race Fuel, commercial pump fuel and AVGAS are permitted.
- All competitors who require AVGAS from Puma Tanzania must place the fuel order & pay by 11<sup>th</sup> July 2022. Collection will be on the 14<sup>th</sup> of July. (Order Form will be available on Sportity)
- 8.2 Competitors are solely responsible for providing and distributing their own fuel during the event.
- 8.3 All refueling will be carried out in designated refueling zones outside the service parks during the allocated liaison section times.
- 8.3.1 To access refueling zones, team personnel must wear long trousers, long sleeved tops, closed shoes, a balaclava & gloves.
- 8.3.2 Drivers and co-drivers must vacate their car when it is being refulled.









#### 9. RECONNAISSANCE

### 9.1 Procedure for Registration

Reconnaissance registration will take place at Rally HQ at the same time as Administrative Checks on Wednesday, 20th July 2022 from 14:00 – 18:00

#### 9.2 Time Schedule for Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance will be held according to the schedule specified in Appendix 2 of these Supplementary Regulations. The schedule of Reconnaissance must be fully respected by crews.

#### 9.3 Reconnaissance Rules and Special Restrictions

#### 9.3.1 General

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of FIA RRSR.

#### 9.3.2 Reconnaissance cars

Reconnaissance cars allowed in accordance with Art.35.1 of FIA RRSR.

Reconnaissance cars must have the insurance policy according to Tanzanian Traffic Law regulations.

The Organiser accepts no responsibility on this matter.

More than one crew may share a car during reconnaissance.

### 9.3.3 Identification Numbers

The Reconnaissance number supplied during registration must be affixed onto the Reconnaissance car on the top of the front windscreen (Co-driver's side).

It must be visible for the duration of the Reconnaissance period.

#### 9.3.4 Number of passes

Competitors are permitted only TWO (2) passes over each special stage during Reconnaissance. All stages driven more than once in the rally will be considered as one stage for Reconnaissance purposes.

### 9.3.5 Driving Direction

Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic.

Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish.

The special stages will be open for normal use during Reconnaissance, therefore safety and rights of other users must be respected.

### 9.3.6 Reconnaissance Control Card

Reconnaissance Control Card will be issued to the crews at registration and must be carried in the car for the duration of the Reconnaissance.

This card will be signed appropriately recording every run on each special stage.

Failure to produce this card will result in refusal to participate in the Reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance Control Card must be returned after the completion of Reconnaissance.

#### 9.3.7. Illegal Reconnaissance

Any member of the crew taking part or intending to take part in the rally who is found on the route of any special stage outside of the listed Reconnaissance dates and times will be deemed to be performing illegal Reconnaissance.

Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

### 9.3.8 Speed limits

Competitors must fully respect the Tanzanian Traffic Law regulations, including use of seatbelts and speed limits. The maximum speed allowed on special stages during reconnaissance is 80 km/h.


At Scrutineering competitors must produce all items of protective clothing, underwear, helmets and a FIA approved head restraint (FHR) intended to be used.

Compliance with FIA ISC Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

#### 11.5 Noise Levels

Noise level may be checked.

The maximum noise level admitted is 94dB (A) to 103dB (A) as per FIA ISC Appendix J Article 252.3.6









#### 11.6 Special National Requirements

All Left Hand Drive Vehicles must display a LHD sticker on rear left of the vehicle

### 11.7 Installation of Safety Tracking devices

- All cars must be fitted with the safety tracking system provided by the Organiser.
- Competitors must make provision in their cars (brackets correctly secured) for the installation of a Safety Tracking System. Operating instructions will be given during installation.
- The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at scrutineering and any competing car without properly functioning unit will not be authorized to start the rally.
- Each crew is materially responsible for the safety tracking system installed in their car.
- Crews are instructed to arrive at scrutineering THIRTY (30) minutes earlier than their allocated scrutineering time to allow for the installation of the Safety Tracking device.

Any car reporting late for tracking device installation shall incur a penalty of TZS 50,000/-

#### **12. OTHER PROCEDURES**

#### 12.1 Electronic Start Procedures

Rallytime clocks are in use.

- The control official will enter the SS time into the clock which will then display by means of a digital read out counting down from 59 seconds with the competitor starting on zero seconds.
- Should Rallytime clocks not be in use, or fail before the SS time, a backup manual timing system will be used and the control official will count the competitor down by appropriate hand signals to indicate the start.
- Results for special stages will be measured to the tenth of a second.
- Jump Start beams will operate at all starts.

#### 12.1.1 Official Start of the Rally

The official Start of the rally will take place at the TC 0 (Mount Meru Hotel) on Saturday, 23rd July 2022 at 07:00

The Starting Order for Leg 1 (Section 1) will be published on Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 at 18:30 on the Official Notice board and on the rally website rally.co.tz

All competitors must report to Rally Start Holding area at Mount Meru Hotel latest by 06:30

### 12.1.2 RE- START after retirement

#### 12.1.2.1 General

- Any crew which has failed to complete a section may be assumed to re-start the rally from the start of the next section following the overnight regroup unless they confirm otherwise with the Clerk of the Course by completing of the form located in the rear of the road book ('final retirement') and lodging it with the organiser as soon as possible and, if feasible, before the publication of the re-start list.
- After the Clerk of the Course has been informed of a retirement, the crew must hand in their time card. When retirement is on a special stage or at a stop control, that stage time will not be recorded and Art. 12.3.2.2 shall be applied.







- In the case of exceeding the maximum permitted lateness, the competitor concerned will be allowed to re-start after the next overnight regroup. The time penalty will be applied as per Art.12.3.2.2 from the TC at which the competitor concerned has exceeded the maximum permitted lateness.
- Any crew which has retired from a section on the last day of the rally will not be classified.
- Any crew which deliberately retires with the perceived intention of gaining an advantage will be judged by the Stewards, who may not permit the crew to re-start. The Stewards may apply sanctions against the Competitor and/or crew concerned in accordance with Article 11.9 of the Code

#### **12.1.2.2** Penalties

- For all crews which re-start a time penalty will be applied. For every stage or super special stage missed, this time penalty will be 10 minutes.
- This time penalty will be added to the fastest time of the drivers' class for each missed stage, which shall include the special stage or super special stage on which the crew has retired.
- Should retirement occur after the last special stage or super special stage before an overnight regroup, the crew will nonetheless be deemed to have retired on that last special stage or super special stage.
- If a crew such affected has set the fastest time of its class on that last stage, its own time will be taken into consideration for the application of the time penalty.

#### 12.1.2.3 Repairs prior to a RE-START

### 12.1.2.3.1 Service location and Time allowed

Any car which fails to finish a leg in accordance with the above may be repaired at the competitor's discretion. However, the car must report to the overnight regroup prior to the next Leg, no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start of the first car.

#### 12.1.2.3.2 Scrutineering of repaired cars

The car must retain its original body shell, engine block as marked at pre-rally scrutineering an all sealed parts. The competitor must be represented during this re-scrutineering at a time to be advised by the organisers.

#### 12.2 Finish Procedure

The competition part of the rally ends at TC 10A (Parc Ferme IN)

The ceremonial PODIUM will take place at Mount Meru Hotel on Sunday, 24th July 2022 at 14:45 First three crews of the rally will be awarded on the podium. Other prizes according to the Art. 14.2 of the Supplementary Regulations will be over-given on the finish ramp.

#### 12.3 Permitted early Check-In

Crews are authorized to check-in early without incurring time penalty at:

- TC PF (Parc Ferme IN at the end of Qualifying Stage)
- TC 6C (Parc Ferme IN at the end of Leg 1)
- TC 10A (Parc Ferme IN at the end of Leg 2)

Crews must nominate their correct clock-in time on the time cards.









#### 12.4 Free Practice / QUALIFYING Stage

All competitors to report at qualifying stage holding area latest by 09:00.

#### **12.4.1** General

- A free practice/qualifying stage will be organized for all competitors in order to establish the rally start order for Day 1
- The results of the Qualify Stage will only be used to establish the Start Order for Leg 1 and will not form part of the rally results.
- All competitors, who passed Administrative Checks and Scrutineering, must participate in the **Qualifying Stage.**
- It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal rally Special Stage.

#### 12.4.2 Running of Free Practice

A Free Practice stage will be organised with the purpose of being both a media and promotional opportunity and for competitors to trial their cars. The drivers may complete a maximum of 2 passages of practice within the timeframe specified by the organisers.

#### 12.54.3 Breakdown during Free Practice

A competitor whose car is unable to complete the Free Practice stage will be required to wait for the organisers to transport the car to the end of the stage after the Free Practice session has finished. 12.4.4 Disclaimer

Any passenger on board the car during Free Practice who is not entered for the rally is NOT permitted. 12.4.5 Running of the QUALIFYING Stage

After the 2 passages allowed for practice, all drivers will start the Qualifying stage in the order of the current African Rally Championship for Drivers with a 3-minute interval between each car.

The driver and co-driver entered must be on board the car throughout the Qualifying stage. The Stewards shall decide the order of drivers who are not been classified in the African Rally Championship for Drivers.

In the event of a dead heat in Qualifying, the competitors concerned will be classified in the order of their start positions in the Qualifying Stage.

#### 12.4.6 Non – participation or breakdown during QUALIFYING Stage

- Any car which breaks down during the Qualifying stage or during the following road section will be transported to the parc fermé by the organisers once the Qualifying stage has finished.
- Any ARC eligible driver who does not participate or does not correctly complete the Qualifying stage will be seeded last on the start list, amongst the ARC eligible drivers.
- All other non-ARC eligible driver who does not participate or start at the scheduled time or does not correctly complete the Qualifying Stage will be seeded in the Start List for Leg 1 as determined by the Clerk of the Course.
- If more than one driver does not complete the stage, start positions will be chosen in the order of the starting list for the Qualifying stage.







#### 12.4.7 Attribution of Starting Positions

- ARC Eligible competitors (TOP 5 FASTEST ONLY) will choose their start position for the rally according to the results of the Qualifying stage. The fastest driver will choose his position first, then the second, followed by the third etc. Any driver who did not does not arrive on time to choose his position will automatically choose his position last.
- All other Non-ARC eligible competitors following the ARC Starting Order will be determined according to the qualifying stage results and upon discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

### 12.4.8 Late or early Check-In

Any late or early check-in to the time control preceding the start of the Qualifying stage (TCQS) will be considered as an incorrect participation and Art. 37.6.2 of V2 - FIA African Rally Championship, under the 2022 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations

#### 12.4.9 False Start

Any false start during the Qualifying stage, particularly one made before the signal has been given, will be considered as an incorrect participation and Art. 37.6.2 of V2 - FIA African Rally Championship, under the 2022 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations

#### 12.4.10 Service

From the beginning of the timetable for Free Practice until the individual start time of the Qualifying stage, service may only be carried out in the main service park or the service park designated by the organiser for this purpose.

#### 12.4.11 Technical Requirements

For applicable cars, the engine, the complete transmission and the mechanical parts mentioned in the Regional Rally Championship's Sporting Regulations must be sealed.

### 12.5 Official Time

The Official time will be GMT+3 as per GPS Standard Time

#### 13. IDENTIFICATION OF OFFICIALS

All Officials, Organizers, Sponsors, Team managers, service crews and Competitors will be issued with either and/or ID Cards and Passes for the event as per article 1.12 in the FIA Rally Safety Guidlines.






























# **APPENDIX 4 Decals and positioning of supplementary advertising**

The first initial(s) and surname of both driver and co-driver, followed by the national flags of the country of the ASN from which they have obtained their licenses, must appear on the rear side window on both sides of the car, adjacent to the competition number. The names must be:

- In white Helvetica
- In upper case for the initial(s) and first letter of each name with the remainder in lower case
- 6 cm high and with a stroke width of 1.0 cm.

The driver's name shall be the upper name on both sides of the car.







#### APPENDIX 5 – EXTRACTS FROM FIA Appendix L & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment

### Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8858-2002 or 8858-2010
- 8859-2015
- 8860-2004 or 8860-2010
- 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List N°41) (Technical List N°49) (Technical List N°33) (Technical List N°69)

Priority 1 drivers and their co-drivers must wear helmets according to the FIA standard 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP.

### Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

#### Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N°74).

### 53. Competitor Safety

### 53.1 Equipment of the Crews

Whenever a car is in motion on any type of special stage and until the stop control, the crew must wear homologated crash helmets, all required safety clothing and equipment in compliance with Appendix L Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment as intended by the equipment manufacturer and have their safety belts correctly fastened. Any infringement will be penalized by the Stewards.


#### 53.2 Equipment of the Cars

53.2.1 In case a Safety Emergency console (Tracking System) is provided by the organiser, the system must be easily accessible for the driver and co-driver when seated with their harnesses fastened.
53.2.2 "SOS/OK" sign Each competing car shall carry a red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42 cm x 29.7 cm (A3). The sign must be placed in the car and be readily accessible for both drivers.

**53.2.3** Each competing car must carry a red reflective triangle.

#### 53.3 Incident on a Special Stage

53.3.1 In the case of an accident where urgent medical attention is required, the following applies: - The SOS switch on the emergency console must be activated as soon as possible (if applicable). - When possible, the red "SOS" sign should immediately be displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. - As soon as possible, the red reflective triangle must be placed in a conspicuous position on the same side of the road as the car at least 50 metres before the car's position, in order to warn following drivers, even if the car is off the road.









53.3.2 Any crew which has the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has suffered an accident, and the OK sign is not shown, shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance. All following cars shall also stop. The second car at the scene shall proceed to inform the next radio point. Subsequent cars shall leave a clear route for emergency vehicles. All crews stopped by this procedure will be allocated a time according to Art. 52.

53.3.3 In the case of an accident where immediate medical intervention is not required, or of a car stopping for any other reason on or beside a special stage, whether temporarily or permanently, the following applies: - The OK switch on the emergency console must be activated within one minute (if applicable) - The green "OK" sign must immediately be displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. If the crew leaves the vehicle, the "OK" sign must be displayed so that it is clearly visible to all other competitors. - The red triangle must be placed in a conspicuous position on the same side of the road as the car by a member of the crew at least 50 metres before the car's position, in order to warn following drivers, even if the car is off the road.

53.3.4 Should it not be possible, for whatever reason, to display the OK/SOS board in any of the above situations, this may be replaced by an evident and clearly understandable sign language shown by the crew outside of the car: - an arm and thumb up to indicate "OK"

- crossed arms above the head to indicate "SOS".



53.3.5 Any crew which is able but fails to comply with the above rules will be reported by the clerk of the course to the Stewards.

**53.3.6** The road book shall contain a page giving the accident procedure.

53.3.7 Any crew retiring from a rally must report such final retirement to the organisers as soon as possible, save in a case of force majeure. Any crew failing to comply will be subject to a penalty at the Stewards' discretion.





#### 53.4 INCIDENT ON A SPECIAL STAGE INVOLVING A PERSON WHO IS NOT A CREW MEMBER

If a crew is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the car must stop immediately, and the procedure as laid down in Article 53.3.1 must be followed.

#### 53.5 RED FLAGS

#### 53.5.1 Red Flags at radio points

The Red Flag will be displayed to crews only on the instruction of the clerk of the course. The flags may only be displayed at radio points marked in the road book and by a marshal wearing a distinctive jacket of the color stipulated in Appendix III, Article 5.2.6 and on which is marked the radio point symbol. Flags will be displayed at all radio points preceding the incident. A Red Flag must be available at each stage radio point (situated at approximately 5 km intervals). No flag other than the Red Flag may be deployed at any point in a special stage.

#### 53.5.2 Meanings of a Red Flag


On passing a displayed Red Flag and/or receiving an electronic Red Flag, whichever happens first,, the driver must immediately reduce speed, maintain this reduced speed until the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

53.5.3 A crew which has been shown the Red Flag will be given a notional time for the stage as in according to Art. 39.

53.5.4 If a stage is interrupted or stopped and the crews are required to pass through the special stage, a Red Flag must be displayed at the start to inform the drivers how they must proceed.

#### 53.5.5 Red Flag points during reconnaissance

During reconnaissance, a sign bearing the radio post symbol must be displayed at the location of each radio point. This sign may be smaller than that used in the rally but must be clearly visible to crews performing reconnaissance in order that the locations may be noted.
