The Stewards having received a report from the Event Director and, having examined the evidence (the letter), summoned and heard the team Manager Safina Khan (summons No1), have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Fact: The team Manager wrote a letter to the Event Director complaining about the cancellation of the remote refuel at the start of event in reference to bulletin No. 8 dated 22nd July 2022 issued at 19:00 hrs.

The Team Manager falsely accused the Clerk of the course of using underhand manner with no thought of the different classes entered in the event.

The Team Manager also tried to incite other competitors to boycott the event.

Offence: Breach of Articles 12.2.1.c, 12.2.1.f and 12.2.1.l of the 2022 FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision: A fine of € 500 onto the Team Manager Safina Khan and a further fine of € 2500 applied with suspension for the rest of the 2022 of the FIA African Rally Championship.

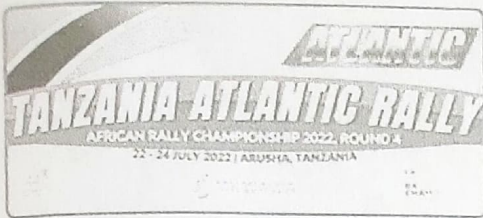
In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the FIA International Sporting Code, fines shall be paid within 48 hours of their notification by means of any mode of payment, electronic included. Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.

Reason: The Stewards amended the Itinerary due to an International Conference at the host hotel and issued bulletin No. 8 of 22nd July 2022, 19:00 hrs.

The Team did not read the bulletin and in the process the 4 FIA / WRC Rally Stars cars did not have enough fuel to complete section 1 of the itinerary.

The Team Manager upon realising the mistake threatened to withdraw the team from participating in the event.


