COMMUNICATION 1 FROM CLERK OF THE COURSE

As a reminder, and for safety reasons, all competitors must strictly follow all regulations concerning the refuelling zone and procedures.

EHRC Sporting Regulations - 61.2 PROCEDURE IN RZ

61.2.1 Only actions inside an RZ directly involved in the refuelling of the competing car are permitted.

61.2.2 In all RZs, a 5kph speed limit will apply.

61.2.3 In order to access the refuelling zone, team personnel must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, a balaclava and gloves.

61.2.4 The fuel supplier or the organizer, whoever is responsible for running the refuel zone, is responsible to protect the ground with an Environmental Mat which shall be composed of an absorbent upper part and an impermeable lower part. The Supplementary Regulations must mention when this requirement is assigned to the Competitor.

61.2.5 The responsibility for refuelling is incumbent on the Competitor alone.

61.2.6 Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation.

61.2.8 Solely for the purpose of assisting with the refuelling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew may access the RZ.

61.2.9 A car may be pushed out of the RZ by the crew, the two team members and/or officials without incurring a penalty.

70RCB EHRC Supplementary Regulations. - 8.4.1 Refuelling in a Refuelling Zone (RZ)

Competitors' cars may be refuelled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew. In order to access the refuelling zone, team personnel must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, a balaclava and gloves.

The organiser will protect the ground providing an Environmental Mat which will be composed of an absorbent upper part and an impermeable lower part.

70RCB EHRC Supplementary Regulations - Bulletin 1

Competitors' cars may be refuelled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew. The relevant personnel must be wearing clothing which will provide adequate protection against fire. **The crew must remain outside the car during the refuelling operations.** The organizer will provide a fuel absorbent mat in the refuelling zones.
