1. Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations of the rally

12.1 Drivers' Safety Briefing

Time for the compulsory safety briefing is changed after the extension of the recce schedule. This briefing will be held on Wednesday 19 May at 20:00 hrs as a videoconference. A link will be sent to the competitors by email. All crews are welcome to join, but the presence drivers/co-drivers stipulated in Bulletin 1 is obligatory (including obligations due to a co-driver change, if applicable).

12.13 Repairs in Parc Fermé

Replace Art. 12.13 of the Supplementary Regulations and Bulletin 1 with:

Article 63.5 of the 2021 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations will not apply in the regroupings between

- Sections 1 and 2 (TC3A and TC3B)
- Sections 6 and 7 (TC19A and TC19B)

12.14 Team personnel and Service restrictions

Replace Art. 12.14 of the Supplementary Regulations and Bulletin 1 with:

There are no media zones in Arganil nor in Fafe.


Article 56.2.2 of 2021 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations will not apply:

- in the regrouping between Sections 1 and 2 (TC 3A and TC 3B)
- in the regrouping between Sections 6 and 7 (TC 19A and TC 19B). However,
 - team personnel that travel to Arganil for the TFZ, may hand over food to the crews while they are in the Regroup.
- in the Tyre Fitting Zone in Arganil. However,
 - the one team personnel that is allowed in the TFZ may also bring drinks for the crews (either in bottles to fill in the camel bags, or new replacement camel bags)
