

SERVICE PARK - GENERAL RULES



Article 57 of the Sporting Regulations Rally of the Belgian Championship will be strictly applied.

Location Service Park:

Service area: Avenue Delchambre and Quai d'Arona

"AUXILIARY" parking: Parking zone "near parc fermé" Athénée High School – Cité Emile Vierset – Huy

Parking Trailers: Avenue Godin Parnajon – Huy and Parking de l' Europe (Europ bridge)

Access to the service park for installation:

Thursday 4/11/21 from 08:00 to 19:00.

Friday 5/11/ 2021 from 08:00 to 11:00 (SERVICE or AUXILIARY)

Access to the service park for dismantling: Sunday 7 November 2021, from 22:00.

Traffic :

Access to the service park is only allowed with the "SERVICE or AUXILIARY" pass.

From Friday 5/11/21 at 12:00 until Sunday 7 November at 22:00, the service park will no longer be accessible

The circulation of service vehicles is forbidden during the passage of the competitors. However, in the event of abandonment or disqualification, the "SERVICE" vehicles concerned may leave the service park after authorisation by the service park manager. They may not - under any circumstances - constitute a hindrance to competitors still racing.

Reservation of assistance pitches:

Requests to reserve pitches will only be registered via the website www.condrozrally.be

"Competitors" "Service park", by November 1st at 12:00.

Dimensions:

Each competitor will be allocated a pitch with a frontage of 8 metres.

If a "team" provides assistance to several cars, it will benefit from an additional space of 5 metres per additional vehicle (i.e.: 13 metres for 2 cars, 18 metres for 3 cars, ...).

Location: The organiser shall mark out and number the service areas

The organiser will inform each competitor of the location of his "assistance site" when the material and documents are distributed on 30 October 2021:

Location: Local of the Royal Football Club de Huy asbl - Terrain LEGRAND

Address: Rue Legrand, - 4500 Huy

Any installation that does not respect the dimensions and location of assistance assigned by the organisation will be dismantled and removed at the competitor's expense.

Access to the service park :

- to the rally cars ;

- Assistance vehicles with a "SERVICE" plate to settle permanently for the period of the rally in the designated area and only 1 Auxiliary vehicle per team;

Any unauthorised vehicle parked in the service park during the night of Friday 5th to Saturday 6th November 2021 will be removed at the owner's expense.

All vehicles, trailers or installed structures must be removed and the waste evacuated by Monday 8th November 2021 at 12:00, in the whole of the service park

COVID-19

The rules of the COVID-19 protocol that may be in force concerning the service park will apply without any derogation.

Any person admitted in a bubble linked to a car not respecting the whole COVID-19 protocol provided by the Organiser will be excluded from the service park and will be asked to leave on the orders of an official of the event, the security staff or the police. In addition, they will not be allowed to re-enter the service park area under any circumstances.

In case of refusal or repetition, the car to which the offender is linked will be IMMEDIATELY disqualified from the "Rallye du Condroz - Huy 2021" and disciplinary sanctions will be requested from the RACB Sport Court.

The rules of the COVID-19 protocol are listed in annex 6 of these regulations.

Cleanliness

In the service park, it is compulsory to use the bins and containers provided for this purpose by the organisation. It is forbidden to throw tyres or pieces of glass into them.

Fire prevention

In accordance with the provisions of the municipal fire prevention regulations:

- It is forbidden to use heating installations and cooking appliances with "live flames". This includes "campingaz", barbecues, ...
- the use of gas cylinders is PROHIBITED

Music broadcasting

The organisation will in no way be held responsible for the broadcasting of music - on a private basis - in the service park. The broadcasting of music for private use is subject to the same timetable as that of the organisation's marquee in accordance with the police order in force. Each competitor must comply with Belgian legislation (SABAM, "equitable remuneration", etc.) regarding the broadcasting of music in a place accessible to the public.

Electricity

The organisation does not foresee any electricity supply or earthing in the service park.
