

Types of network




Centralized vs Decentralized vs Distributed Network: An Overview




Centralized Network

All the nodes are connected under a single authority



Decentralized Network

No single authority server controls the nodes, they all have individual entity



Distributed Network

Every node is independent and interconnected with each other








Groups enable a community of practice (CoP) to come together in a dedicated space to collaborate more effectively. TechNet members can create their own groups.




Announcing the launch of Immunisation Supply Chain - Community of Practice
