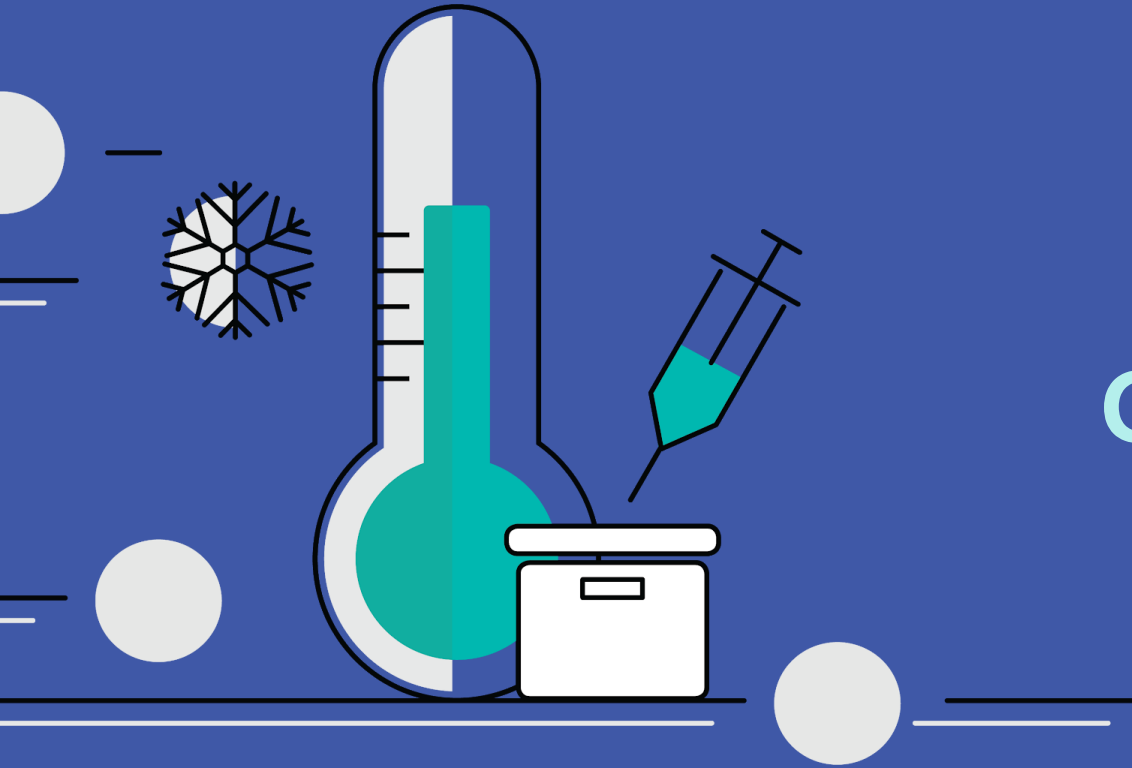

The purpose
of the app

From offline to online

The EVM1 assessment tool was an offline tool, and it was not meant to be used as a routine monitoring tool.

The EVM2 tool allows the location data to be uploaded directly to the national EVM database, allowing assessment teams and EVM Managers (national, and subnational) to directly access the data, in order to quickly identify and diagnose iSC issues.



An essential tool

The EVM app is a tool that supports and enhances the ease, efficiency and accuracy of iSC assessments and the continuous improvement process.

The app can be used to **conduct health facility assessments by completing EVM questionnaires.**



Improved access and collaboration

The app can be used by anyone at any level of involvement in the immunization supply chain, making the iSC assessment process more accessible and collaborative.

The app allows assessors to **download questionnaires they have been assigned** and **upload completed questionnaires**.

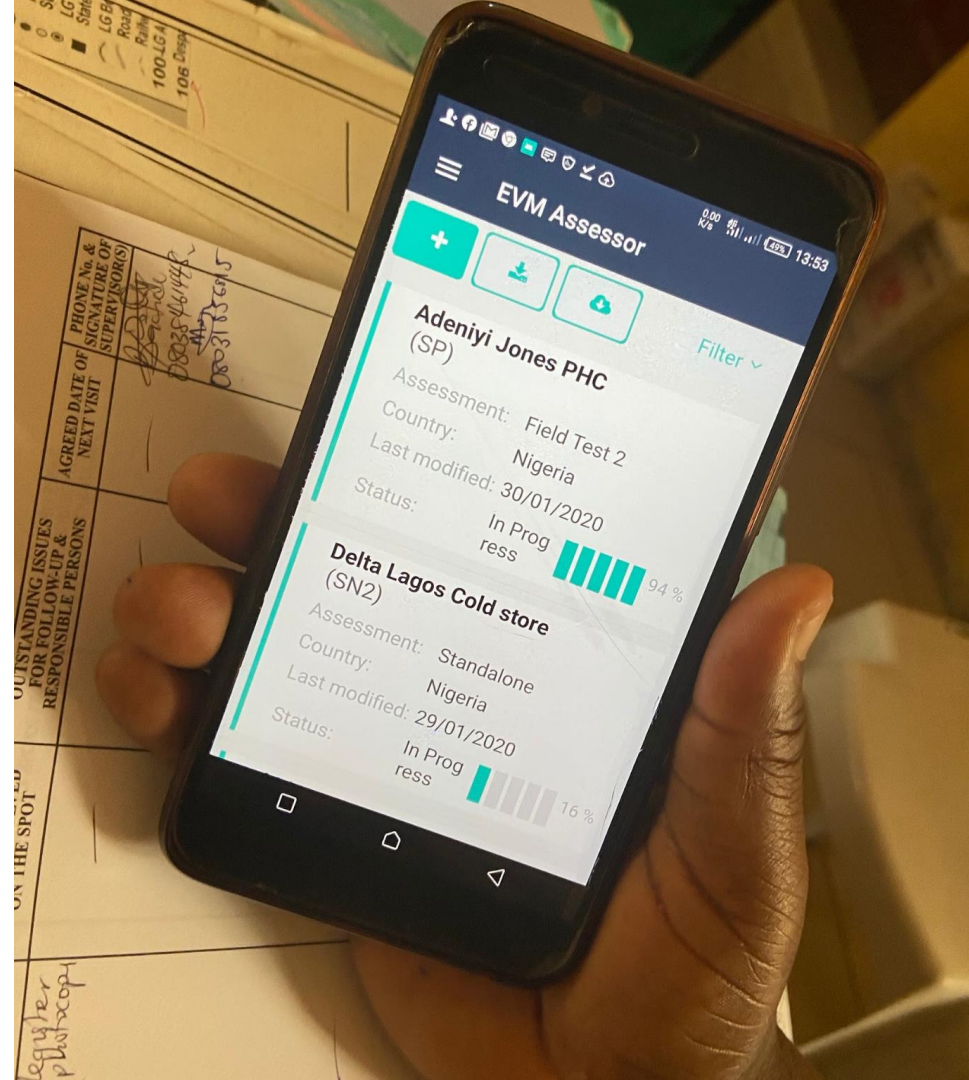


The purpose of the app

Transparent scoring

During the assessment, assessors observe, inspect and conduct interviews in response to questions prompted by the app. These answers generate insightful data and charts that you will be introduced to in module 6.

The app can be used to **analyze health facility performance based on assessment scores.**

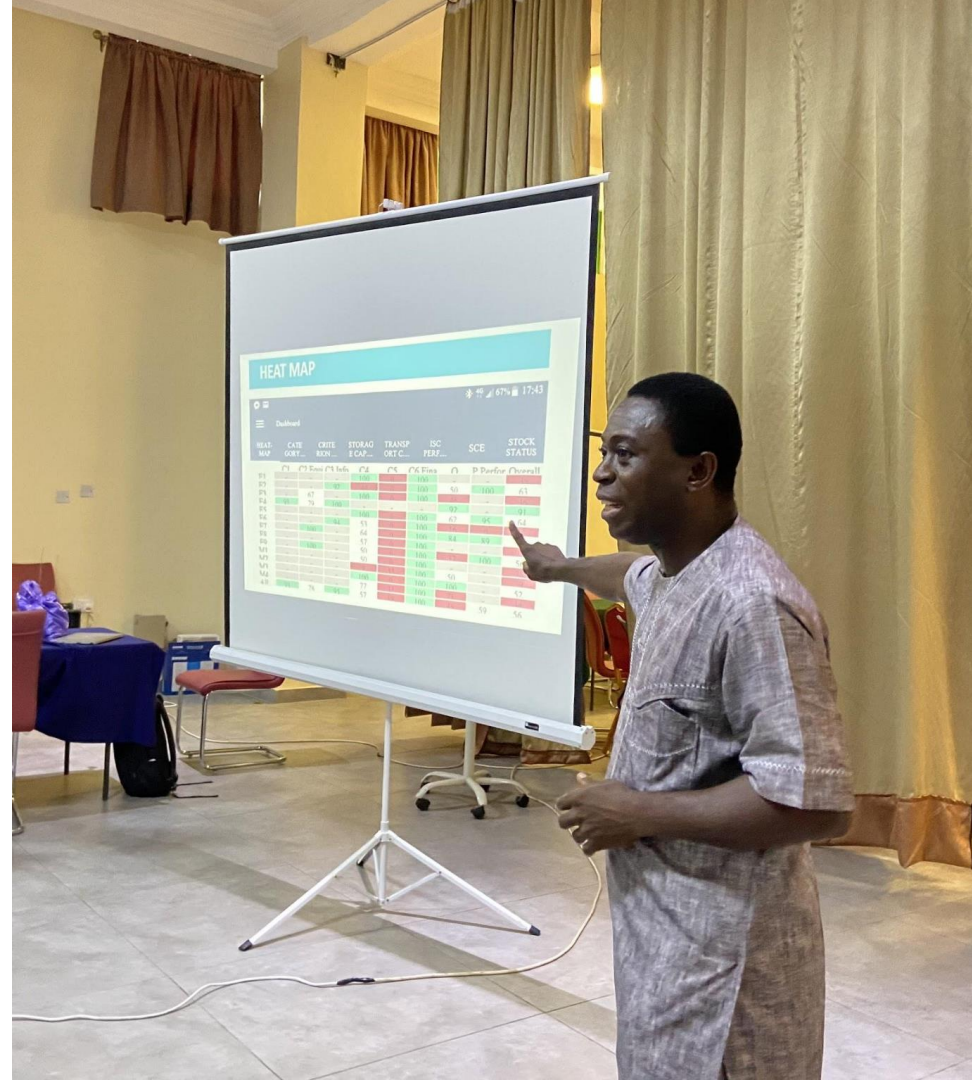


The purpose of the app

A professional growth opportunity

Learning how to use the app is an essential step in becoming part of EVM and provides opportunities for career advancement through the acquisition of new skills.

The app can be used to **create standalone EVM questionnaires for self-assessment or training purposes.**



Be prepared with your device

Before getting started, refer to the 'EVM Assessor – User Guide' to ensure your device meets the minimum system requirements and to get step by step instructions for a successful installation and usage process.

2. Installing

The EVM Assessor app is available on Android, Windows and Apple devices. Whichever device you choose, we recommended using a device with a screen size of at least six inches. In other words, using a tablet or laptop rather than a mobile phone is recommended.

Anyone can download and install the app, and once installed you can use it to create questionnaires. However, to download and upload questionnaires that are part of an EVM assessment, you must have an EVM account. Refer to 'Creating an EVM account' for details.

To install the app, please follow the instructions below for your device. Note that during the installation, an internet connection is required. This is only required during the installation process. Once the installation has completed, the app will function without an internet connection.

Android

System requirements

Before installing the app, please ensure that your device meets the requirements listed below.

Table 4. EVM system requirements for Android

Requirement	Minimum	Description
Android OS	Version 6	Although the app may work on earlier versions, this is not recommended as not all functionality will be supported.
Internal hard disk	8GB	16GB or higher is recommended.
RAM	2GB	4GB or higher is recommended.
CPU	1.5 GHz / quad-core	
Battery	4000mAh	

Downloading and installing

To install the app:

1. On the Android device, click the following link
https://install.appcenter.ms/orgs/evm2/apps/prd-vm-for-android/distribution_groups/public

2. Next to the most recent version displayed, click DOWNLOAD.
3. Once the install file has been downloaded, click the file to begin the installation. Note that your device must allow installation of "unknown apps" (apps not downloaded from the Android Play Store).
4. Once the app has been installed, open the app. The app will check to see if any content updates are available. If an internet connection is available and content updates are found, they will be downloaded, and a success message will be displayed.

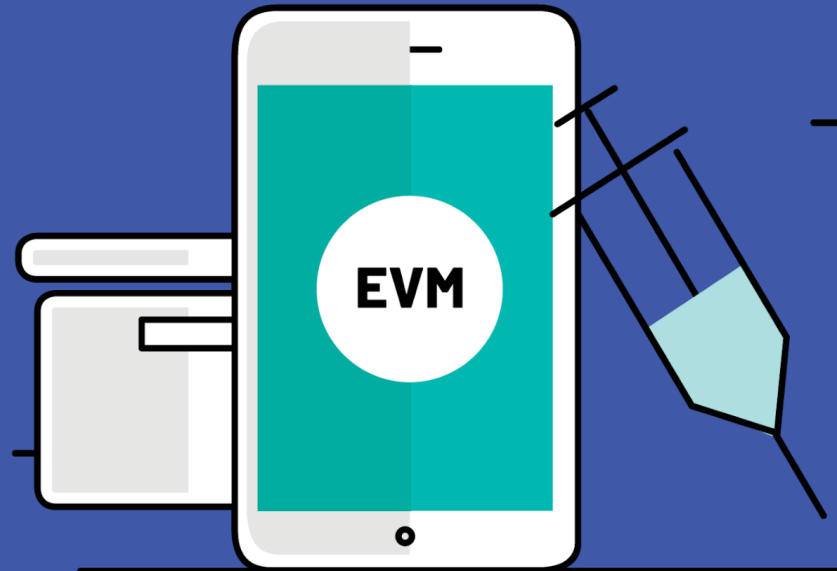

Becoming an EVM assessor can be accomplished in 3 easy steps

1. Download and install the app
2. Create an account on the EVM website
3. Request permission for the role you want

Download and install the app

- The EVM app is available on Android, Windows and Apple devices.

1. Open the Microsoft Store
2. Make sure you are signed in
3. Open the menu
4. Click World Health Organization
5. Click EVM Assessor
6. Find the most recent version
7. Click Download

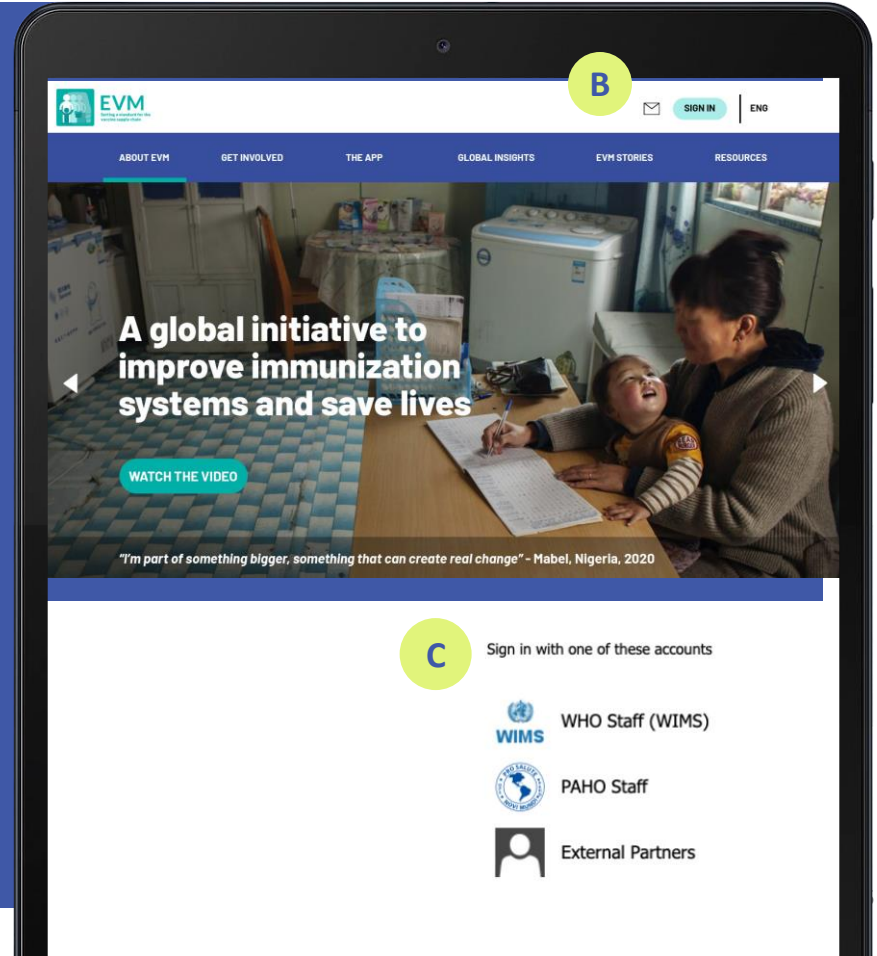


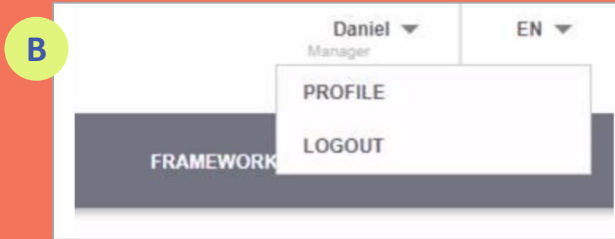
