



WHY HPV VACCINE?

Cervical Cancer

- Cervical cancer is a very common cancer in Zimbabwe
- Many women die from cervical cancer each year
- HPV is the leading cause of cervical cancer

HPV vaccine

- Reduces your chance of developing cervical cancer

Who gets the HPV vaccine?

- Girls 10 - 14 years

Who should not get the HPV vaccine?

- Girls under 9 years
- Girls who had a recent severe illness or are very ill on the day of the vaccination
- A pregnant woman
- A woman who has already had all the HPV vaccinations

How is it given?

- Provided as an onsite service at schools, clinics and outreach sites
- Two injections, the second injection will be given 6 - 15 months after 1st dose
