




Busiest Months of 2024




Busiest Days of the Week






Annual Business Count





























































































FINANCIAL OUTLOOK

Purchase of Services Agreement with the City of Elgin provides \$169,950 annually for economic development and promotional support services.

The DNA will receive \$50,000 from The Hartford in 2025 and \$50,000 in 2026.




