

Visitors who come to pick fruit should be aware of the following points.

1. Visiting the farm

Please check when the fruit is in season and be sure to make a reservation before visiting the farm.

There is no public transportation, so we recommend renting a car or making your own arrangements.

2. Payment

Please purchase tickets at the reception desk first.

You can pay by cash, credit card, or barcode.

3. Access to fruit-picking areas

No one will be allowed to enter the fruit-picking area without tickets. Violators will be fined.

Before picking the fruit, please purchase tickets at the kiosk. After purchasing the tickets, please go to the fruit-picking area for a briefing on the process.

4. Two types of fruit-picking plans

We offer two types of fruit-picking plans: the first is the Tabehodai Plan, and the second is the Chodogari Plan, which allows you to experience picking a variety of fruit.

Tabehodai Plan

1. Purchase tickets at the reception desk and go to the Tabehodai Fruit Farm.
2. Upon arrival at the Tabehodai farm, a staff member will brief you on fruit-picking.
3. Tools and plates for picking fruit are available for rent.
4. Fruit-picking begins after the briefing. You may consume unlimited amounts of one type of fruit within the time limit. You cannot take any fruit home.
5. Please be sure to pick what you can eat, as you cannot take any fruit home.
6. Customers wishing to purchase gifts may do so at the kiosk or each fruit-picking reception desk.

Chodogari Plan (Aug to Oct only)

1. This is not an all-you-can-pick, all-you-can-eat plan, but allows you to pick a variety of fruits.
2. Please purchase a set of 16 tickets at the reception desk. The tickets can be exchanged for fruit-picking. For example, apples cost two tickets, grapes cost 10 tickets, and peaches cost four tickets.
3. Refer to the map that comes with the tickets and go to the farm to pick the fruit you want.
4. Upon arrival at the farm, a staff member will brief you on fruit-picking.
5. After picking the fruit, please give the number of tickets corresponding to the amount of fruit you picked to the staff.

6. Unlike Tabehodai, you cannot eat the fruit on the farm. After leaving the farm and exchanging tickets for the fruit, please enjoy it on-site or take it home as a souvenir.

7. Please ask our staff to purchase more tickets if you need more.
