DRAC and the Cégep de Drummondville are pleased to announce *Portrait(s)*, *reflets et mémoire*, the annual group exhibition unveiling the work of the **20** graduating students of the Cégep de Drummondville's visual arts program. The exhibition will be presented from June 1st to June 16, 2024.

Presented annually at DRAC since 2007, the exhibition allows visitors to discover the work of the graduating students of the visual arts program at Cégep de Drummondville. Presenting works made in a wide variety of mediums, the group exhibition brings together singular practices that reflect the concerns of these artists at the beginning of their professional careers. *Portrait(s), reflets et mémoire* is a fitting representation of these rather personal, even introspective pieces, which reflect the path they have taken during their professional formation.

- "The works presented at DRAC are the result of technical and conceptual learning acquired within their DEC in Visual Arts. As part of their final project assessment, the students were tasked with putting together a portfolio, writing up an artistic approach, drawing up a work plan and budget, and presenting a miniature model in front of the centre's team. The realization and presentation of their work in a professional venue are therefore the culmination of their journey. We are fortunate to be able to count on DRAC's expertise to accompany our students in this important step that is the dissemination of their work. The 2024 cohort exhibition will highlight works in diverse mediums such as painting, silkscreen, printmaking, watercolour, digital art, sculpture, installation, drawing, photography and video art.
