

Park and Recreation Board
Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, March 3, 2026 – 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The **minutes** from the February 3, 2026, meeting were approved as submitted.

Caitlin briefed the Board on the updated **DAA Volleyball Agreement**. It is simply an update to some of the wording regarding court maintenance expectations and provides a timeline for DAA to supply us with their schedule, as these courts are very high in demand from other groups and organizations. A motion was made to approve the updated lease (Lannon/Crotty).

Caitlin gave an update on **Concerts at the Commons**. Stage United received a grant from Visit Bucks County for marketing expenses. We are currently doing very well with sponsorships, and we are brainstorming how to set up a Venmo account so people can make smaller donations. We have heard from folks who want their food trucks at the concerts. Concerts will be every Thursday in May.

Caitlin gave the **Recreation Director Report**. Pavilion rentals are increasing year over year. Replacement of damaged playground equipment has been ordered. The bike racks have been ordered and should arrive soon. One will be placed at Broad Commons, Burpee, and Chapman near the pump track. Trash and recycling receptacles have been delivered. The flex space attached to Borough Hall has seen good progress. It will be ready for the summer Arts and Crafts program. Caitlin reviewed the sign-up dates for the Easter Egg Hunt and for Arts and Crafts.

Old/New Business: Under the old business section, Caitlin shared an update on the Pavilion renovation concept plans.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 pm.
