#### **Ordinances, Amendments & Resolutions**

 Authorization to Advertise Ordinance Adding Lighting Regulations to the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance – This proposed ordinance will set maximum lighting levels for certain uses and types, as well as color regulation and glare. The Bucks County Planning Commission suggested this be adopted into the Bode Code of Zoning Ordinances, however Borough Staff disagrees as it would be difficult to regulate and enforce through the Borough Zoning Ordinance.

The Committee members agreed to forward this to Borough Council.
