

DOYLESTOWN BOROUGH 2025 LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE




eaf collection season will soon arrive. The map below shows the LEAF COLLECTION AREAS SCHEDULE.

PLEASE RETAIN THIS MAP and schedule and post in a prominent location in your home. By observing the following simple rules, Borough residents can help ensure that collection is timely and thorough.

Residents may not place leaves out for collection until the weekend prior to the scheduled collection date. Leaves placed out too early impede drainage and parking, and can become wet and frozen, seriously slowing collection. Residents placing leaves out for collection prior to the scheduled time are subject to possible citation and fines. Further, if leaves are not placed out for collection by 7:00 am on the Monday of the scheduled week, collection cannot always be provided.

- Leaves should be placed on top of the curb and not in the gutter, where possible. Leaves placed in the gutter become wet and frozen, seriously slowing collection.
- Residents who cannot comply with the above or to whom the new schedule is inconvenient, may dispose of BAGGED leaves only at the Doylestown Borough Maintenance Complex, located at the northern end of Harvey Avenue, Monday through Friday, from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm, until January 1. Leaves may not be disposed of at this location after January 1, 2026.

- ONCE SCHEDULED COLLECTIONS ARE COMPLETED NO FURTHER COLLECTIONS WILL TAKE PLACE.
- LEAVES MUST BE PLACED OUT BY 7:00 AM ON THE MONDAY OF THE COLLECTION WEEK.
- CURB-SIDE LEAF COLLECTION IS A PUBLIC SERVICE PROVIDED TO DOYLESTOWN BOROUGH RESI-DENTS FREE OF CHARGE.

Please adhere to the following these simple rules:

RULE #1. Only put LEAVES out for collection. NO STICKS AND NO DEBRIS

Many times people seem to confuse "Leaf Collection" for "branch pickup" (which we do in the spring). Leaf collection is **only for leaves** that can be vacuumed up by our leaf machines. We have had rocks and bricks thrown into these piles and they get sucked up into the machines and damage them and place our workers at risk.

RULE #2. Pile leaves atop the curb in your yard.

Place leaves at the curb edge, but not in the street and gutter (when possible). Leaves in the street and gutter get wet, block gutter flow, and wash into storm drains. When there is room, put the leaves atop the curb and NOT in the street.

RULE # 3. Leaves should be placed out MONDAY morning of your scheduled weeks.

The schedule and map is on the following page. Each service district in the Borough has two collections.

NOTE: If you miss your weeks, you can drop off your bagged leaves at our 300 Harvey Avenue facility.
