

Park and Recreation Board Meeting

Tuesday, December 1, 2020 - 7:00 p.m.

The meeting of the Doylestown Borough Parks and Recreation Board was held via Zoom on the above date at the above time with the following members attendance: Gary Harris, James Lannon, Dennis Livrone, Barbara Healy, Elizabeth Wyckoff, Pat Keppler, and Bob Huether. Also in attendance were Council President Jack O'Brien, Councilperson Wendy Margolis, Mayor Ron Strouse, and Borough Manager John Davis.

The Board voted unanimously to approve the **October 6, 2020 Meeting Minutes**.

John provided an update on the construction of **Broad Street Park**. Construction is essentially finished for 2020, although the building contractor will be installing some stormwater facilities that service the park over the next month. Staff is currently working on detailed plans and bid specifications for the sidewalks, walkways, hardscape Civic Plaza, and furnishings with a goal of bidding the work in early 2021. Drawings will be circulated to the Board no later than the January meeting.

Bike and Hike Report: Liz reported on the upcoming Witches Holiday Bike Ride and the pump track. The pump track is now closed for the winter after a very successful season. John updated the Board on the upcoming virtual town meeting for the Poole's Corner Bike Hike Trail connector.

Gary reported on a very successful **2020 tennis season**. Extra sessions were added and revenues nearly doubled from 2019.

John reported that the **Mercer Avenue Park sign** had finally been installed. It is hoped that it will give the park more visibility and attract more users.
