The **Minutes** from the April 16, 2021 meeting were approved. (Frederick-West)

Given the Governor's relaxed COVID restrictions in PA, all in attendance agreed that it's time to remove the Curbside Pickup locations. In accordance with the Mayor's resolution, permission for outdoor dining tents and table setups would expire on June 30th, unless a resolution is passed to extend the original resolution. John suggested extending the outdoor dining through at least Labor Day, although after some discussion, most agree to allow it through the end of the year. This will be brought to the next Community and Government Affairs Committee meeting.

In response to questions from Noni, the group discussed legislature regarding Zoom meetings. Current rules do allow for Zoom meetings to continue and some municipalities are moving toward the return of in-person meetings. Before meetings are again in-person, parameters will need to be set and will be discussed with other Committees.

The Memorial Day Parade will go ahead, which will be announced today, although it will be smaller than in previous years. The 5K is on schedule, as well as the car show, and the bike fest. The Art Show is undecided at this point.

A Penn State Creamery franchisee is possibly interested in opening a location in Doylestown and was shown several possible locations.
