

Human Relations Commission

A meeting of the Doylestown Borough Human Relations Commission was held on the above date with the following members in attendance: Vice Chairperson, Linda Quinn, Secretary, Doreen Stratton, Sharyn Brauns, Maxine Katz and Nancy Reilly. Also in attendance was Borough Manager, John Davis. Absent were Chairperson Fred Stanczak and John Fraser.

- 1. Approval of Minutes:** The February 27, 2019 minutes were approved.

- 2. Upstander Training**
Borough Council has given their approval to hold a training session for the Human Relations Commission and members of the community on Monday, April 29, 2019 from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm. The registration fee is \$5.00 per person with a maximum of 30 attendees. John Davis will send out a D-Mail notification of the training session; the information will also be available via social media.

- 3. Pride Month Update-** John Davis
Doylestown Pride Committee has been meeting regularly and is reviewing films for the festival. John Davis will email the most recent Pride Committee minutes to the HRC so they may review the film selections also. A Doylestown Pride website has been set up and a logo approved. The event is scheduled to begin at 6:00 pm on June 20, 2019 with cocktails at the Zen Den on E. State Street. A street festival located on E. State Street between Pine and Main Streets is scheduled for Saturday, June 22 from 1:00 pm-5:00 pm. HRC will have an informational table and will hand out window clings. Two tents, 20 vendor spaces and about one dozen musicians will round out the day. Films will be shown at the County Theater on Saturday and Sunday at 1:00 pm. Area churches have asked to be involved and several corporate donations have been received.

Linda will provide a mock-up of the window cling for the April 24, 2019 HRC meeting.

- 5. Farmer's Market**
The HRC will have an informational table at the May 11 and June 8, 2019 Farmer's Market from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. This will allow us to promote the Doylestown Pride event. On those Saturdays, Sharyn Brauns and Linda Quinn will open the table from 8:00 am – 10:00 am and Doreen Stratton and Maxine Katz will take over until 1:00 pm. Pending her schedule, Nancy Reilly will also be available to help.
