

**Park and Recreation Board Meeting

1. The May minutes will be considered at the September meeting since there was no quorum in attendance. The May minutes will be amended to include Dennis Livrone as present.

2. Board members are advised to email John Davis and/or Dennis Livrone if they are unable to attend a meeting.

3. A feasibility study will be conducted to determine the possibility of a bike trail along Turk Road. It may consist of 10-11 foot lanes, bridges and multiuse paths. If undertaken, it could take 20+ years to complete.

4. Bike/Hike Report, Liz Wyckoff

- An ice cream ride is planned for Sunday, June 9<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 to celebrate Doylestown's Bronze Award as a bike friendly community. It will be held within the Borough borders.
- Work is underway on mountain bike trails next to the pump track. Trails are open to any type of bike with different levels of difficulty.
- The pump track is operating well and is in good condition.
- Discussion occurred regarding requests for doggie bag stations at the Chapman Park. This discussion will be continued at the September meeting.

5. Borough Manager's Report:

- No serious damage occurred in any of the parks as a result of the storm.
- Installation of the Burpee sidewalk and new playground equipment begins next week.
