

Public Safety Committee
Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, May 3, 2023 6:00 p.m.

Present: Larry Browne, and Curtis Cowgill. Also in attendance were CBRPD Police Chief Karl Knott, Fire Marshal Scott Fleischer, Mayor Noni West, and Borough Manager John Davis.

The **Minutes** of the April meeting could not be approved without a quorum.

Harvey Avenue Permit Parking Study (Union to Doyle). Ordinance notices were mailed to the residents in the area affected, notifying them of the pending change. The ordinance would prohibit non-resident parking between the hours of 9am and 5pm, Monday through Friday. John did not receive any responses and no one attended the meeting to share their views. Borough Council will vote on the ordinance at their May meeting.

Doyle Street Parking (Main to Broad Commons). Ordinance notices were also mailed to affected residents, with no response or attendance at the meeting. The ordinance would limit parking to a two-hour maximum between 9am and 5pm, Monday through Friday, on Doyle Street between Broad Commons Park and the internal alley closest to Main Street, as well as prohibit parking at all times between that alley and Main Street. Borough Council will vote on the ordinance at their May meeting.

CERT Team. Larry had nothing new to report.

Public Events. Chief Knott shared information on approved event permits including a Memorial Day Block Party on Church Street and the annual Memorial Day Parade.

CBRPC Report (Mayor). Mayor West updated the Committee on ongoing SRO discussions with Central Bucks School District.

Old/New Business. Resident Joan Merkel shared her concerns with pedestrian safety on West State Street at McCaffrey's Simply Fresh and would like the Borough to add some additional signage.
