Approval of Minutes

Minutes of November 9, 2021 Joint Budget Worksession and Finance & Pension Committee meeting was approved. (Brennan/Margolis)

2022 COLA

Ron Bittner, Girard Pension Services, reviewed information provided by Girard regarding awarding a 6.2% COLA benefit to the non-uniformed pension retirees. The consultant reviews the plan annually compared to the CPI. There is no requirement to award the COLA annually. After discussion surrounding the increased liability to the plan, the committee opted to not award a 2022 COLA. No action necessary.

Prepaid Invoice Authorization

The committee reviewed a draft of Resolution #2022-2 that authorizes the prepayment of certain invoices prior to the regularly scheduled approval at each monthly Council meeting. This is a housekeeping item and will update Resolution #2020-1. The list of invoices was reviewed and discussed and the committee approved passing this item to Council (Margolis/Brennan).

Ms. Brinker reviewed with the Committee items that are known to be included in the monthly meetings. Any additions or corrections will be addressed monthly.

Old/New Business
