- 1. Council Chairman Joe Flood brought the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.
- 2. Move to approve Minutes by Joe Flood, seconded by Larry Browne.
- Staff presented the 2021 Road Materials Recommendation. Chairperson Flood moved to approve low bid from Eureka Stone Quarry to proceed to Council for final approval. Seconded by Councilman Ben Bell. Carried with a unanimous vote.
- 4. Discussed Landscape Bid Memorandum to discard previously received bids due to problematic advertising. New Request for Proposals to be opened April 9, 2021.

## New business:

- 1. Mr Ehlinger alerted the committee to the COVID-19 case discovered within the Public Works department and the proper handling of the remaining staff. All were quarantined and scheduled for rapid testing following the CDC guidelines. Running the department with one staff member who was not potentially exposed.
