

# Doylestown's Snow Emergency Routes

**NO PARKING, AND ONLY VEHICLES WITH SNOW CHAINS, SNOW TIRES, OR 4 WHEEL-DRIVE ALLOWED**

When a Snow Emergency is Declared by the Mayor, the following roads are subject to **No Parking** restrictions. Additionally, only vehicles with Snow Tires, Snow Chains, or 4 wheel drive are permitted:

- Broad St (West side) between State Street and Main Street
- East Ashland St (South side) between Main Street and State Street
- West Ashland St (South side) between Main St and Washington St
- East Court St (North side) between Main Street and Swamp Road
- West Court St (North side) between Main Street and Memorial Drive
- East Oakland Ave (South side) between Main Street and State Street
- West Oakland Ave (South side) between Clinton Street and Main Street
- East State St (North side) between Maple Avenue and Main Street
- West State St (North side) between Main Street and Lafayette Street
- Green St (East side) between Scout Way and Ashland Street
- North Main St (West side) between State Street and Union Street
- South Main St (Both sides) between State Street and Oakland Avenue
- Shewell Ave (Both sides) between the Firehouse and Main Street
- All cul-de-sacs

During snow storms, removing vehicles from the streets assists in snow fighting operations. The lower levels of the Bucks County Parking Garage at Broad and Union Streets is open for parking during storms.

**Please remember that cars parked on the Snow Emergency Routes listed above are subject to ticketing and towing by the Police.**
