Sidewalk/Curb/Apron

Background:

The Borough of Doylestown requires that prior to any new sidewalk construction or repair that involves removal of existing surface down to the base; the property owner shall acquire a Sidewalk/Curb/Apron Permit from the Department of Building and Zoning, located at 10 Doyle Street. There is a \$25 fee for this permit plus a \$4.50 state fee. All construction/repair work shall be done according to the Borough of Doylestown City Sidewalk Ordinance specifications.

Sidewalk Requirements:

- Sidewalks shall be constructed of three thousand (3,000) pound per square inch Portland cement concrete poured over a six (6) inch thick layer of stone on a compacted base. Sidewalks shall be four (4) feet in width and allow for a four-foot planting strip between the curb and the sidewalk; provided, however, that the Borough of Doylestown may approve a greater or lesser width for the purpose of conformity of new or replacement sidewalks with existing connecting sidewalks.
- Sidewalks shall have a scored joint at 4-foot intervals and a ½ inch expansion joint every 24 lineal feet.

Driveway Requirements:

- Curb cuts are required. Flared cuts should be used to gradual transition between the sidewalk and the ramp. Returned curbs should only be used in areas that pedestrians would not normally travel such as planting strips.
- Driveways and aprons shall be constructed of six (6) inch thick, three thousand five hundred (3,500) pound per square inch Portland cement concrete poured on a compacted base.
 Number 4 reinforcing bars shall be laid in the curb cut. Use 4 bars in two rows of 2 bars each.
- Curb cut ramps shall be at least 12 foot wide for single car drives, 24 foot wide for double car drives.
- Sidewalks shall be four (4) feet in width and allow for a four foot planting strip between the curb and the sidewalk; provided however, that the Borough of Doylestown may approve a greater or lesser width for the purpose of conformity of new or replacement sidewalks with existing connecting sidewalks.

The Borough of Doylestown may, upon the recommendation of an engineer and a finding of unique or special circumstances with respect to a particular sidewalk or portion thereof, may alter or add to said specifications as deemed necessary for proper construction, reconstruction, replacement or repair.

- Prepour (forms in place before concrete is poured)



Sidewalk Requirements:

- Sidewalks shall be constructed of six (6) inch thick, three thousand (3,000) pound per square inch Portland cement concrete poured coal compacted base. Sidewalks shall be four (4) feet in width and allow for a four foot planting strip between the curb and the sidewalk; provided however, that the Borough of Doylestown may approve a greater or lesser width for the purpose of conformity of new or replacement sidewalks with existing connecting sidewalks.
- Sidewalks shall have a scored joint at 4 foot intervals and a ½ inch expansion joint every 24 lineal feet.

Driveway Requirements:


- Curb cuts are required. Flared cuts should be used to gradual transition between the sidewalk and the ramp. Returned curbs should only be used in areas that pedestrians would not normally travel such as planting strips.

 cement concrete poured on a compacted base. Number 4 reinforcing bars shall be laid in the curb cut. Use 4 bars in two rows of 2 bars
 each.
- Curb cut ramps shall be at least 12 foot wide for single car drives, 24 foot wide for double car drives.
- Sidewalks shall be four (4) feet in width and allow for a four foot planting strip between the curb and the sidewalk; provided however, that the Borough of Doylestown may approve a greater or lesser width for the purpose of conformity of new or replacement sidewalks with existing connecting sidewalks.

Sidewalk Requirements:

- Sidewalks shall be constructed of six (6) inch thick, three thousand (3,000) pound per square inch Portland cement concrete poured on compacted base. Sidewalks shall be four (4)feet in width and allow for a four foot planting strip between the curb and the sidewalk; provided however, that the Borough of Doylestown may approve a greater or lesser width for the purpose of conformity of new or replacement sidewalks with existing connecting sidewalks.
- Sidewalks shall have a scored joint at 4 foot intervals and a Y, inch expansion joint every 24 lineal feet.


Driveway Requirements:

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- Curb cut ramps shall be at least 12 foot wide for single car drives, 24 foot wide for double car drives.
- Sidewalks shall be four (4) feet in width and allow for a four foot planting strip between the curb and the sidewalk; provided however, that the Borough of Doylestown may approve a greater or lesser width for the purpose of conformity of new or replacement sidewalks with existing connecting sidewalks.

Driveway Requirements:


- Curb cuts are required. Flared cuts should be used to gradual transition between the sidewalk and the ramp. Returned curbs should only be used in areas that pedestrians would not normally travel such as planting strips.
- Driveways and aprons shall be constructed of six (6) inch thick, three thousand five hundred (3,500) pound per square inch Portland cement concrete poured on a compacted base. Number 4 reinforcing bars shall be laid in the curb cut. Use 4 bars in two rows of 2 bars each.
- Curb cut ramps shall be at least 12 foot wide for single car drives, 24 foot wide for double car drives.
- 24 inch curb tapers shall be painted yellow with oil based paint.
