

Privacy Notice for Volunteering During the Coronavirus Outbreak

We will keep this privacy notice under regular review; it was last updated in March 2020. When we use your personal data, City of York Council (CYC) complies with data protection legislation, and is the registered 'Controller'. Our data protection notification is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) – reference Z5809563.

Why is information being collected?

The recent coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak presents an unprecedented challenge to existing services. We are working with the voluntary and community sector in York to boost the number of volunteers in York and target support to where it is most needed and effective.

Therefore we are asking people to register their interest in volunteering and collect details which will help us match skills and availability to suitable volunteering opportunities.

This means we need to tell you what we will do with the personal data we collect and get your consent for this. We only use your personal data with your explicit and informed consent for the purposes described in this privacy notice.

What information will be collected?

When recruiting volunteers we ask for the following personal information:

- Name
- Email
- Postcode
- Contact number
- Age
- Driving license
- Health status
- DBS
- Availability to volunteer

What will we do with the information?

The information we collect will be used to help us match skills and availability to suitable volunteering opportunities

We will not use the data for any other purpose than stated and will not disclose to a third party ie other companies or individuals, unless we are required to do so by law for the prevention of crime and detection of fraud, etc.

Where will the information be kept?

We will keep the information you give us and your personal data in the council's secure network drive and make sure it can only be accessed by authorised staff at City of York Council.

How long will we keep the information?

We will keep the information you give us and your personal data for up to one year and then will securely destroy it.

Further processing

If we wish to use your personal data for a new purpose, not covered by this Privacy Notice, then we will provide you with a new notice explaining this new use prior to commencing the processing and setting out the relevant purposes and processing conditions. Where and whenever necessary, we will seek your prior consent to the new processing, if we start to use your personal data for a purpose not mentioned in this Privacy Notice.
