

## **Privacy Notice for City Centre Access Arrangements**

This privacy notice was completed in July 2021 and will be regularly reviewed. When we use your personal data, CYC complies with data protection legislation and is the registered 'Controller'. Our data protection notification is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) – reference **Z5809563**.

### **Why is information being collected?**

This consultation is conducted in line with the Decision of the Executive Member for Transport (22<sup>nd</sup> June 2021) to undertake the statutory consultation to advertise the removal of the exemption on vehicles which display a valid Disabled Person's Badge from proceeding within certain streets within the pedestrian area during the pedestrian hours. The consultation also looking at proposed additional Blue Badge Parking on the edges of the pedestrian area.

The consultation documents present the proposals for the amendments the City of York Council Traffic Regulation Orders. ### **What information will be collected?**

We are collecting your name opinions, thoughts and feedback on the proposed changes to the Traffic Regulation Orders, to help aid the future decision on the proposed changes.

Participation is voluntary and you can choose to not take part.

### **What will we do with the information?**

We are using the information you give us with your consent. You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting [highway.regulation@york.gov.uk](mailto:highway.regulation@york.gov.uk).

The information we collect will be included in presentations, statistics and reports. Any presentations, reports and statistics for publication or use outside of the authorised council staff, will be anonymised and cannot be linked back to you, your family or individuals. Reports containing anonymous information may also be shared with the general public and other organisations.

We will protect it and make sure nobody has access to it who shouldn't and we will not keep it for longer than is necessary.

You can respond by email or in writing. If you send us a printed letter in response to this consultation, we will transfer the information you have given onto the Council's

secure network drive and then securely destroy the paper copy once the transfer is complete.

We will not use the information for any other purpose than set out in this privacy notice and will not disclose to a third party i.e. other companies or individuals, unless we are required to do so by law for the prevention of crime and detection of fraud, or, in some circumstances, when we feel that you or others are at risk.

### **Storage of information**

We will keep the information you give us in CYC's secure network drive and make sure it can only be accessed by authorised staff.

### **How long will we keep the information?**

We will keep the information you give us for up to three years and then will securely and confidentially destroy it.

### **Further processing**

If we wish to use your personal information for a new purpose, not covered by this Privacy Notice, we will provide you with a new notice explaining the purpose prior to commencing the processing and the processing conditions. Where and whenever necessary, we will seek your consent prior to the new processing.
