

Privacy Notice: Haxby and Wigginton Area Study

This privacy notice was completed in October 2021 and will be regularly reviewed. It was last reviewed and updated in November 2021. When we use your personal data, CYC complies with data protection legislation and is the registered 'Controller'. Our data protection notification is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) – reference **Z5809563**.

CYC is working with a company called Information by Design to carry out the survey fieldwork. Their ICO registration is **Z6556929**

Why is information being collected?

City of York Council (CYC) wishes to better understand the needs of residents living in Haxby and Wigginton, the traders who work there and the evolving needs and expectations of those who use the area, and how this impacts our understanding of the current shopping area.

There is also a requirement to gather insight as to how Haxby and Wigginton are likely to alter in the wake of unprecedented change, the global pandemic, and to understand the opportunities and challenges these factors present in terms of place-making.

What information will be collected?

Through a series of questions set out in an online or paper survey, we will ask for feedback, opinion and suggestions for Haxby and Wigginton. We will collect:

- your age and gender, to better understand which people most use the area, and identify any gaps for those who do not
- responses to questions about Haxby and Wigginton
- your personal opinions, thoughts, ideas and feedback

In addition, we will ask for your name and contact telephone number in the event we need to clarify the content of your responses. Separately we will ask for your permission to contact you to take part in future Council research. Both elements are voluntary, and you do not have to agree to this.

Participation overall is voluntary and you can choose to not answer any of the questions that you are asked.

You may also choose to enter a prize draw for a voucher. This is voluntary and separate to taking part in the survey and you can choose to not take part in it.

What will we do with the information?

The information you give us is with your consent, and your participation in this exercise is voluntary.

Any presentations, reports and statistics for publication or use outside of the authorised staff, will be anonymised and cannot be linked back to you, your family or individuals. Reports containing anonymous information may also be shared with the general public and other organisations.

We will protect it and make sure nobody has access to it who should not, and we will not keep it for longer than is necessary.

We will not use your personal information for any other purpose than set out in this privacy notice and will not disclose to a third party i.e. other companies or individuals, unless we are required to do so by law for the prevention of crime and detection of fraud, or, in some circumstances, when we feel that you or others are at risk.

How long will we keep the information?

Your information will only be kept for up to nine months and then will be securely and confidentially destroyed.

Where and whenever necessary, we will seek your consent prior to the new processing.
