

Privacy Notice for Provider Survey

We keep our privacy notice under regular review and it was last reviewed and updated in September 2022.

City of York Council (CYC) are the “Controller” for this information unless we specifically state otherwise in this privacy notice. We are registered with the Information Commissioner’s Office (ICO) (UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018) – reference Z5809563.

Why is information being collected?

The Local Authority has a duty to ensure there are sufficient, high quality early years and childcare places to meet the needs of our families in York. This survey has been developed by the local authority to help better understand the recruitment and retention issues that early years and childcare providers are currently experiencing and the impact this is having on childcare places being offered to families in York.

Participation in this survey is voluntary however the information provided will help inform our workforce strategy and the support that the local authority can offer.

Why do we need personal information from you?

We only use your personal information with your explicit and informed consent for the purposes described/as set out in this Privacy Notice, in order to gain further information on the recruitment and retention issues currently being experienced by the early years and childcare sector in the City of York area.

What information will be collected?

We will collect information about your setting, including provision type, information on current workforce demographic, how this is impacting on the number of places you are able to offer and whether you are able to meet the childcare needs of all your families.

What will we do with the information?

The data we receive from this survey will be analysed and the results used to identify the scale of the issue across the city, identify how the local authority can support the sector and further inform the early years workforce strategy. Data will be anonymised and will not identify individuals. We will not use the data for any other purpose than stated and will not disclose to a third party i.e. other companies or individuals, unless we are

required to do so by law for the prevention of crime and detection of fraud, etc. Online data will be collected using SurveyMonkey.
