

Our Privacy Notice - What we do with your information

Participation in these groups and activities are voluntary and we will only collect and use the minimum amount of personal information from you, for you to take part in them.

We will not pass on your information to any third parties for marketing, sales or any other commercial purposes or for any other purpose without your consent, except where we have a legal reason for doing so.

We will also use the information we collect from you for reporting, research and statistical purposes. When we do this, it will be anonymised which means the information will be turned into a format that cannot be linked back to you and does not identify individuals.

We will keep your information secure and only those people who are authorised to, will have access to it and when we no longer have a need to keep it, we will destroy it securely. It is however sometimes appropriate or relevant for us to pass on any relevant information to our City Archives when we no longer have a need to keep it.
