Event Descriptions

Anglers cast their lines into the water and try to reel in the largest or most fish to win prizes. It's a friendly competition where fishing fans of all ages come together to have fun and enjoy the excitement of catching fish.

Race Night/Derby Party (All Ages)

A simulcast race night is a fun event where people watch horse races from different places on big screens. You can bet on the races and feel the excitement. It's like being at the track but in a private setting. Attendees have the opportunity to place bets on the races, adding an element of competition and anticipation to the evening.

Queen of Hearts (18+)

In a Queen of Hearts raffle, participants purchase tickets for a chance to win a cash jackpot. The raffle revolves around a deck of cards, with each card representing a ticket number.
