



Tabernacle Alcohol and Tobacco Use Policy

Purpose:

Possession of open alcoholic beverage containers, the active consumption of alcohol, and smoking are not permitted in the public area of the Tabernacle.

Policy Detail:

1. The term 'open alcoholic beverage container' means any bottle, can, or other receptacle that contains any amount of alcoholic beverage, and that is open, has a broken seal, or the contents of which are partially removed.
2. The term 'smoking' is the use of tobacco (including but not limited to cigarettes, pipes, cigars, snuff, chewing tobacco, and vaping). Vaping refers to the use of electronic nicotine delivery systems or electronic smoking devices. These are commonly called e-cigarettes, e-pipes, e-hookahs, and e-cigars.
3. The term 'public area of the Tabernacle' is defined as the Tabernacle building itself and the streets historically referred to as "the circle" surrounding and directly adjacent to the Tabernacle building. This policy does NOT apply to the cottage porches within that "circle."
