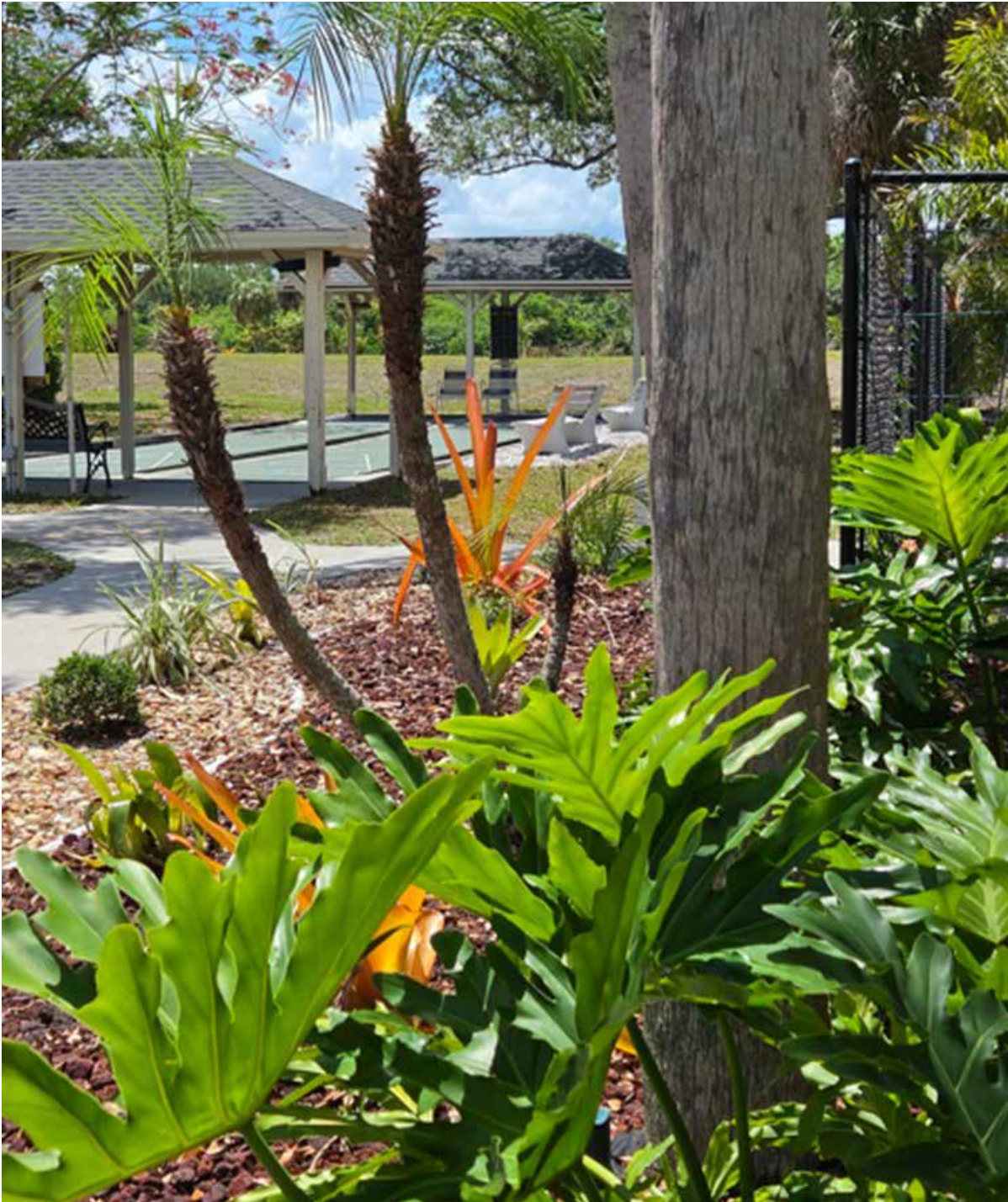

MANAGER'S REPORT

June is here and will hopefully bring us some more rain. Luckily, the plants and flowers planted earlier this year by the Tree Committee are staying watered and looking very nice. June also brings us closer to storm season which are preparing for. I am doing regular inspections and will contact properties that have items that are not secured outside and will ask the owners to remove the items or put them away.

The work on the drainage swales was completed, and the cost came in under budget. The road paving is also completed for one-half of Delamere. We will now be scheduling the road sealing for Arbela, Candace, Danvers, Fulmar, Ratan, Sidi, Tisa and Widness. The road sealing will likely be done in the first week in June. We will notify residents as the schedule progresses.

We've hired a new employee, James (Jim) Hickey. Jim was hired to supervise the maintenance team. He will work with the other employees to improve how we maintain the community as well as implement new pool cleaning policies by doing more pool maintenance in-house with the hopes of eventually lowering our overall pool maintenance costs. They have a list of projects to complete over the summer including painting and making repairs to mailboxes as necessary, painting the pickleball courts and making repairs to other recreation courts.

We are still waiting for confirmed dates for the boat dock expansion project to proceed. We are also waiting for dates for the installation of the covered seating project at the pool area. As soon as we know more, we'll share it with everyone.

We still have too many vehicles that do not have a VHL parking sticker ID on their cars, trucks and golf carts. The stickers are also mandatory in the storage area. Please stop at the office or call us and we'll get a sticker ready for you. It's important we know who does not belong in the community. This is especially helpful in the summertime at the waterfront/boat dock area. There are people that do not reside in VHL coming in only to use the boat ramp. If you see this occurring, please contact the office. If the office is closed, please get a description and a license plate number if possible.

JUNE RECIPE

Celebrate the peak of early summer with a vibrant **Grilled Peach and Burrata Salad**. The ultimate June recipe, it combines smoky grilled peaches with creamy burrata, fresh basil, and a sweet balsamic drizzle. It takes just 15 minutes to prepare and is perfect for backyard barbecues or a light seasonal dinner.

Ingredients

- 4 fresh peaches, pitted and halved
- 1 ball of fresh burrata cheese (approx. 4-8 oz)
- 1 tbsp olive oil (for brushing peaches)
- 2 cups fresh arugula
- 1/4 cup fresh basil leaves, torn
- 2 tbsp balsamic glaze
- Flaky sea salt and freshly cracked black pepper (to taste)



Instructions

1. Prep the Peaches

Preheat your grill or a grill pan to medium-high heat. Lightly brush the peach halves with olive oil.

2. Grill

Place the peaches cut-side down on the grill. Cook for 3 to 4 minutes until distinct grill marks form and the peaches are slightly softened. Remove from the grill and let cool for a few minutes.

3. Assemble the Salad

On a large platter, create a bed of fresh arugula. Place the warm grilled peaches on top, arranging them aesthetically.

4. Add Cheese and Herbs

Tear the ball of burrata open slightly to expose the creamy center and place it in the center of (or scattered across) the platter. Scatter the torn basil leaves over the peaches and cheese.

5. Garnish and Serve

Drizzle the entire salad with the balsamic glaze and a pinch of flaky sea salt and black pepper. Serve immediately while the peaches are still warm.

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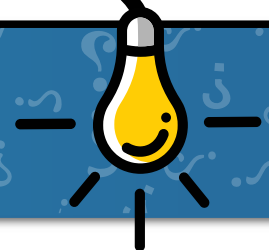

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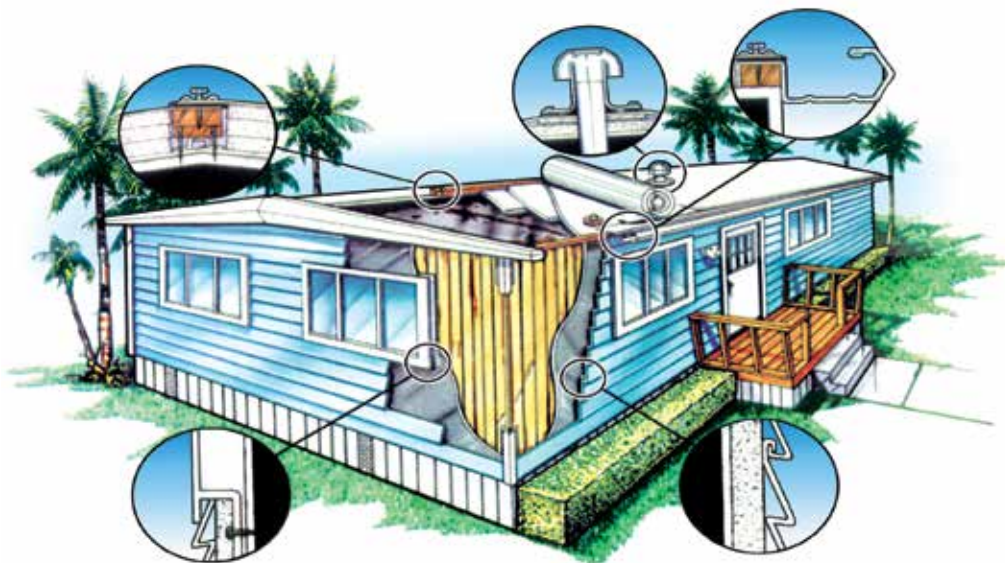


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
