The Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup made its debut at Imola last month and now the teams are joined by other GT3 and LMP3 competitors for the first running of the Road To Le Mans.

Every driver wants to race at the 24 Hours of Le Mans and this new event gives the two endurance categories that are not eligible to take part in the famous race the opportunity to showcase their talents in front of 250,000 spectators on the full 13,6km La Sarthe circuit.

The grid of 39 cars is a testament to the draw of Le Mans and we welcome the LMP3 and GT3 teams from around the world.







The Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup is the entry level for anyone competing in the GT category in endurance. The GT3 Le Mans Cup is reserved for cars conforming to the current FIA GT3 homologation regulations such as the Aston Martin V12 Vantage GT3, Audi R8 LMS, Ferrari 458 Italia GT3, plus the new 488 GT3, and Porsche 911 GT3R, though teams can also enter eligible cars from manufacturers such as Bentley, BMW, Lamborghini, Lexus, Dodge, Corvette, Nissan, McLaren and Mercedes Benz. The 2016 Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup will take place over six rounds, with drivers and teams competing for the honour to become the inaugural champion.

Five of the events will be a 2-hour endurance race on the same weekends as the 2016 European Le Mans Series – Imola, Red Bull Ring, Le Castellet, Spa-Francorchamps, Estoril - and this weekend is a special 55-minute race called 'Road to Le Mans' on Saturday morning at the 24 Hours of Le Mans.

The 'Road to Le Mans' will take place at Le Mans on Saturday 18 June ahead of the start of the 84th 24 Heures du Mans. The grid for this race will consist of full season competitors from the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup and LMP3 competitors from the various endurance race series from around the

Driver crews will consist of two drivers with the first driver being classified as bronze and the second as bronze, silver or gold as defined by the FIA driver categorization list.

Prize money is available for each race winner and for the top three competitors at the end of the year. There will also be a special prize for the competitors who received the least number of penalties during the season. In total there will be a prize fund of €300 000.

A small but highly competitive grid of cars travelled to Italy for the first ever Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup. At the end of the two hour race Turkey's Salih Yoluc and Britain's Euan Hankey names were recorded as the first drivers to win in the brand new series for GT3 cars with a dominant victory at

Starting from third on the grid, Yoluc took the lead in the first corner when the nr88 Mentos Racing Porsche of Egidion Perfetti collided with the pole position holder Luigi Lucchini in the no7 BMS Scuderia Italia Ferrari 458, spinning both cars off the track and allowing the Turk to take the lead in the no34 TF Sport Aston Martin V12 Vantage.

The Aston Martin pulled away from the chasing pack, led by Japan's Hiroshi Hamaguchi in the no55 FFF Racing Team by ACM McLaren 650S, before handing over to Hankey who drove the car to the chequered flag ahead of fellow British driver Adrian Quaiffe-Hobbs in the McLaren. The no26 Classic and Modern Racing Ferrari F458 Italia GT3 of Matthieu Vaxiviere and Nicolas Misslin completed the first podium as Vaxiviere took the chequered flag just 3.6s ahead of the charging Francesco Castellacci in the no51 AF Corse Ferrari 488.

The podium belonged to the TF Sport pair of drivers, with Euan Hankey and Salih Yoluc celebrating in traditional style knowing their names will be the first on the roll of honour for the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup.

The Road to Le Mans is a special 55-minute held on the full 13.6km La Sarthe circuit on the morning of the 24 Hours of Le Mans for LMP3 and GT3 cars. The race is also round 2 of the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup and eligible entries will score points in the new for 2016 six round Series.

The Event is reserved exclusively for LMP3 cars in conformity with the ACO LMP3 homologation form according to the 2016 ACO LMP3 technical regulation, and the GT3 cars in conformity with the FIA GT3 homologation

form according to the 2016 FIA GT3 technical regulation. The cars from the LMP3 competitors and their drivers will appear in the classification of the Event but will be transparent in the classifications of the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup.

Michelin is the sole tyre supplier and only one specification of slick and one specification of wet-weather tyres are allowed for each category (LMP3 and GT3). The number of tyres is not limited for the Event.

Backgrounds of the race numbers are purple for LMP3 and white for GT3.

Each competitor can decide to run one or two drivers in each car.

The composition of the LMP3 crews must be either Bronze/Bronze or Bronze/Silver for two drivers and Bronze for 1 driver.

For GT3 the composition is Bronze/Bronze, Bronze/Silver or Bronze/Gold for two driver crews and Bronze for one driver, but anyone running a single driver is not eligible to score points in the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup.

The minimum driving time during the race is 20 minutes. There will be two 60-minute Free Practice Sessions and one 30-minute qualifying session to determine the grid. For GT3 only bronze drivers are eligible to take part in qualifying.

The race will be 55-minutes staring at 11h10 on Saturday 18 June, with a mandatory pit stop of 2 minutes between 22 minutes 00 seconds and 32 minutes 00 seconds of the race.

With a total of 39 entries, 20 LMP3 and 19 GT3, the first running of the Road to Le Mans promises to be full of action and drama.


The Road To Le Mans event will feature a grid of cars from two categories of endurance racing – LMP3 and GT3.

The GT3 grid is for cars in conformity with the FIA GT3 homologation form according to the 2016 FIA GT3 technical regulations. The Road to Le Mans is a round of the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup and the grid will also feature invited cars from other series.

The LMP3 cars are invited from series across the world that conform to the ACO LMP3 homologation form according to the 2016 ACO LMP3 technical regulation.

Competitors are invited from the following Series:

- European Le Mans Series
- Asian Le Mans Series
- Asian Le Mans Sprint Cup
- Weathertech Sportscar Championship

**LMP3:** In order to strengthen the pyramid of endurance racing which was introduced in 1999 by the Automobile Club de l'Ouest, the ACO has launched in 2015 a new category of junior sports-prototype for endurance racing, LMP3.

In the pyramid of «Le Mans Prototypes», LMP3 becomes the first step on the ladder before moving up to the LMP2 and LMP1 classes (the latter in the FIA WEC and 24 Hours of Le Mans).

The thinking behind this car is that there should be the least number of constraints possible, whether those are budgetary, technical, driving or operation. The sale price of the new car, complete, must not exceed €206,000.

The LMP3 is a closed car. The chassis and bodywork of LMP3

can be built by six manufacturers designated by the ACO: Ginetta, Ligier, Adess, Dome, Norma and Riley. They are very close to those of the current LMP2 (closed cockpit, carbon chassis with tubular steel roll cage). The powertrain consists of a 420bhp normally aspirated V8 Nissan engine, and an Xtrac gearbox. It is identical for all chassis, and marketed by the ORECA company which also provides specific assistance to teams.

The driver line up must be made up of at least one «Bronze» rated driver. Platinum drivers are not allowed in the LMP3 driver line-up (see details in Sporting Reg.)

The Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup is reserved for cars conforming to the current FIA GT3 homologation regulations such as the Aston Martin V12 Vantage GT3, Audi R8 LMS, Ferrari 458 Italia GT3, and the new 488 GT3, and Porsche 911 GT3R, though teams can also enter eligible cars from manufacturers such as Bentley, BMW, Lamborghini, Lexus, Dodge, Corvette, Nissan, McLaren and Mercedes Benz.

The car entered by a competitor must conform strictly to its Homologation Form and to the data sheet (FIA GT3 Data Sheet) approved and registered with the FIA for its homologation. Driver crews will consist of two drivers with the first driver being

classified as bronze and the second as bronze, silver or gold as defined by the FIA driver categorization list. The Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup Committee is allowed to balance the performance of the GT3 cars. Adjustments to performance may be applied by the Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup Committee at any moment of the 2016 season. Prize money is available for each race winner and for the top three competitors at the end of the year. There will also be a special prize for the competitors who received the least number of penalties during the season. In total there will be a prize fund of €300 000. The winner of the 2016 Michelin GT3 Le Mans Cup will receive an invitation to take part in the 24 Heures du Mans 2017 in the GTE Am category.
