








Ferdinand Habsburg made his
European Le Mans Series debut last
month in Barcelona at the wheel
of the n°24 Algarve Pro Racing
Oreca 07. As an Austrian driver, he
will be racing at home next week for
the 4 Hours of the Red Bull Ring and
we had a quick chat with Ferdinand
to get to know him better.



WHO ARE YOU?

Tell us a little bit about yourself and your career so far. My name is Ferdinand Habsburg, I have been a racing driver for 12 years, three years professionally. I work best when I follow all my interests.

WHAT ARE YOUR FIRST IMPRESSIONS OF THE ELMS AFTER THE FIRST RACE IN SPAIN?

After one round in the European Le Mans Series, it's clear it provides exciting racing. It's extremely competitive and enjoyable to compete in the ELMS, and I'm looking forward to racing on home soil at the Red Bull Ring.

CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT YOUR PROJECT DRIVE FAST, ACT FASTER AND GREEN FUTURE PROJECT?

Mine and Algarve Pro Racing's 'Drive Fast, Act Faster' campaign has been launched to encourage the motorsport community to embrace more sustainable ways of working, and also provide a chance for teams and drivers to help expand a rainforest reserve in Ecuador that has one of the highest biodiversity in the world. When I was racing in the Asian Le Mans Series this winter with Algarve Pro Racing, I quickly realised that Stewart and Samantha Cox share the same values as I do and that they would like to make changes in the way the team operates to reduce their impact on the environment. This realisation led me to Green Future Project, a platform that champions change-makers, bridging individuals and businesses to the most effective climate solutions.

WHAT ARE THE ACTIONS THAT YOU HAVE IMPLEMENTED IN YOUR TEAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PROJECT?

A lot of logistical changes in the way the car is transported have reduced the mileage of the trucks dramatically. We have eradicated single-use plastics and set up recycling bins in the garage and in hospitality.

YOU WILL BE RACING AT HOME, AT THE RED BULL RING. HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW THE TRACK AND HOW DO YOU THINK IT IS SUITED TO THE ORECA 07?

I believe the Algarve Pro Racing ORECA 07 should work well at the Red Bull Ring, and I really can't wait to have a home race again.

WHAT IS YOUR FAVOURITE CORNER AT THE RED BULL RING AND WHY?

The second to last corner at the Red Bull Ring, as it's all about confidence and it's very high-speed. It's extremely exciting.

Endurance Racing: a technological lab since the 20s'

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1925

The aerodynamics of the bodywork

Very early on, engineers understood the value of a streamlined body. In 1925, the Chenard & Walker Tank laid the first foundations for aerodynamic research. A quest for the best coefficient of air penetration (Cx) which will give birth to iconoclastic vehicles. Like "the Monster", a recarrossed Cadillac Coupé DeVille registered for the test of 1950. In the 70s, Porsche will line up a racing car cut like an airplane wing, the 917 "kurz Heck" (short tail) which will take down moreover the distance record in 1971 with 5,335.31 km. It was not until 2010 that Audi broke this record!

Advances in racing car performance reveal a new imperative: to improve braking efficiency and endurance. Jaguar will find the solution by equipping its Type Cs with a real technological revolution: disc brakes, a solution originally developed for planes landing on aircraft carriers! The English brand will score a double in the 1953 race. The idea will be taken up by Citroën on the revolutionary DS and equip, even today, all production cars!



lodine headlights

Of the 24-hour race, about eight take place in the pitch black night, most of the circuit being bordered by forest. Lighting is therefore a parameter that can make the difference.

In 1962, Ferrari installed additional halogen headlights for the first time, using iodine vapor, on the 330 TRI / LM. The test is conclusive - they double the range of the light beam - and these headlights are generalized on all cars from 1965.





"The horses pull the plow, they don't push it," said Enzo Ferrari. Irony of history, a Ferrari 250 P will be the first rear-engine car to win at Le Mans in 1963. But this was not the first of its kind to take the start of the Le Mans race. The primeur goes to a... Renault 4 CV, prepared and hired by a private pilot, Camille Hardy, against the advice of the management which considered this unsuitable car. Unfortunately, she had to resign themselves to abandonment due to an engine problem.

The slick tire

It was Michelin who brought a major innovation to the racing world by inventing the slick tire, that is to say with a smooth tread, guaranteeing better grip on dry ground. The results were not long in coming, as the # 46 Vinatier / Bianchi Alpine A210 signed for the first time a lap in less than four minutes in its category and at the same time clinched the victory in the 1,600cc.

The turbine engine

In 1957, in a constant desire to promote innovation, a new category reserved for cars equipped with a turbine engine was created. As a result, 25,000 francs as a reward for the one who will be able to exceed 3,600 km. In 1963, BRM lined up a strange racing car equipped with a turbine engine and a 220-liter kerosene tank. He puts on the show with the sound of a teapot but, not in accordance with the regulations, he runs out of classification. He managed the feat of finishing in seventh place ... unofficial. And the attempts applied to the series do not succeed ...

Aerodynamic appendages

How to increase the aerodynamic downforce essential for stability at high speeds other than by working on the design of the body? The answer to this question came from Chapparal, who introduced, with his prototype 2F, the first rear wing. High perched and as wide as the car, it gave it an almost cartoonish air. Chapparal had also planned a system allowing, via a pedal, to modify the inclination according to the portions of the circuit! The first mobile wing was born in the category and at the same time won the 1,600 cm3 victory.

The hybrid engine


The idea of a hybrid powertrain combining a thermal block with an electric motor came from the American Don Panoz. Its Esperante GTR-1 Q9 is powered by an original Ford 6.0 I supported by an electric motor whose batteries are recharged while recovering braking energy. Despite this technology, the Panoz Q9 will fail to qualify for the event. However, hybrid technology will prevail in 2012 with the Audi R18 e-tron quattro.

LED then laser headlights

Increasingly common in production vehicles, LED (Light Emitting Diode) headlights were introduced in 2011 on the Audi R18 TDI. In addition to the quality of the lighting, this process consumes less electricity, is less heavy and takes up less space, which leaves more freedom to design the front part of the body. Finally, it brings a unique light signature at night. In 2014, the Ingolstadt firm reached a new level with the arrival of laser lights, an even more powerful technology.

A month after the opening round at the Barcelona-Catalunya circuit and for the first time in the Ligier European Series, the Ligier JS2 Rs and Ligier JS P4s will meet up in Austria at the Red Bull Ring.





M RACING AND ORHÈS RACING IN CLOSE COMBAT

Will this weekend be synonymous with another success for Natan Bihel, driver of the #53 M Racing Ligier JS2 R? The Frenchman has started the season on a high note by winning the first two races in Spain. However, the task will not be easy. Several drivers are lying in wait to flip the script in Austria. One such crew is Mathieu Martins and Olivier Pernaut, drivers of the #24 Orhès Racing JS2 R that claimed a pole position and two podiums in Barcelona. Will Ligier European Series newcomers Orhès Racing score their first victory at Spielberg?

Laurent Millara is another driver to keep an eye on. The gentleman driver in the #69 M Racing Ligier JS2 R, has two podiums to his credit and is second in the provisional general classification, tied with the #24 Orhès Racing.

TWO LIGIER JS2Rs FOR COOL RACING

The Swiss team will be bringing an additional Ligier JS2 R at the Red Bull Ring, the #13 with Maurice Smith at the wheel. The American gentleman driver finished 5th in the Michelin Le Mans Cup with Cool Racing Ligier JS P320.





WHO WILL TAKE THE LEAD IN LIGIER JS P4?

In the Ligier JS P4 category, the battle promises to be close between Les Deux Arbres and HP Racing by MonzaGarage. The French team and its Italian rival shared the spoils in Barcelona. Will one of them get the upper hand in round two at Spielberg?

FRENCH FORMULA 1 COMMENTATOR JULIEN FÉBREAU TO TRY HIS HAND

After Arnaud Tsamere in Barcelona, another celebrity will make his debut in the Ligier European Series. Known by French Formula 1 fans for his fiery commentary, Julien Fébreau will be in the #25 Orhès Racing Ligier JS2 R at the Red Bull Ring. The specialist of sideways motor racing has already won several races in Rallycross.

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The best season to date







The speech is repeated every year and sounds like an advertising slogan. "This season is shaping up to be the best of our championship! « Advertising? Really? In the case of the Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux, nothing is less true: this 2021 edition is simply exceptional!

On the eve of its ninth season, the fastest one-make series of the Benelux continues to gain momentum. It is not by chance that Porsche has made the Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux one of the five national or regional series (with Germany, France, Asia and North America) which will race the brand new Porsche 911 GT3 Cup type 992 this year. With 510 horsepower and developments in many areas, it is the most efficient cup car ever offered by the manufacturer of Weissach. The success has exceeded all expectations and no less than 21 cars are registered for the season. But next to quantity, the entry list ensures quality with an ideal mix between professional drivers, very enlightened amateurs

(in the Pro-Am class) or true gentlemen drivers (entered in Am). A coincidence? Certainly not! By developing its single-make cups, Porsche has succeeded in seducing young drivers, who know that the pyramid set up is often a launching pad for an international career. Likewise, lovers, eager for thrills at the wheel of a high-performance car, choose Porsche. Everyone knows that, in racing with equal cars against their opponents, it is the talent of the driver and his team that will make the difference. Because if motorsport - by definition - gives pride of place to mechanics, it is always the human aspect that must be the key to success.

Place your bets!

Titled last year, the very young Loek Hartog hopes to develop internationally now. But the fight for his succession promises to be exciting! Two former champions are back: Dylan Derdaele (Belgium Racing), crowned in 2016, and his successor Xavier Maassen (TeamPGZ by Redant Racing). The Belgian and the Dutch face a young generation ready to shake up the hierarchy. We find the revenant Glenn van Parijs (NGT), the ex-singleseater driver Ghislain Cordeel (GP Elite), the revelation of 2020 Huub Van Eijndhoven (PGZ-JW Race) or even Thierry Vermeulen (GP Elite), champion of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux in Clubsport Division and who will go from the Porsche 718 Cayman GT4 Clubsport to the GT3 Cup this year. Less experienced, will Steven van Rhee (GP Elite) and Sebastian Freymuth (PG Motorsport) be able to surprise? Let's see during the season.

In Pro-Am too, the fight is very open with several specialists of the Porsche Carrera Cup, including the 2020 Pro-Am champion Michael Cool (NGT). But the defending vice-champion Nicolas Vandierendonck (Q1-EMG), the 2019 vice-champion Nicolas Saelens (Belgium), Filip Teunkens (Q1-EMG), Floris Dullaart (GP Elite) or Ziad Geris (GP Elite) also race for the highest step of the podium.

Let's not forget the Am class either, a category successfully introduced in 2020. Whether their names are Jan Lauryssen (Q1-EMG), Jeroen Kreeft (Parker Revs Racing), Ad Geerts (PGZ-Redant) or Luc Vanderfeesten (PGZ-Redant), they are all impatient to discover the 911 GT3 Cup type 992 in the fastest one-make series of the Benelux. With four countries visited (Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany and Austria), six different circuits and twelve races over six prestigious meetings (as part of FIA WEC, ELMS, ADAC GT Masters and DTM), the Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux begins in 2021 the best season in its history. And this is not an advertising slogan!
